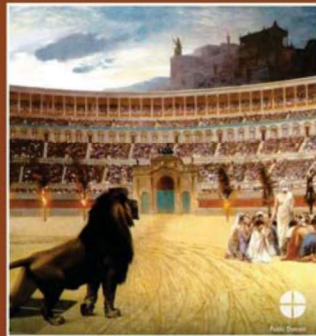

## The First Martyrs of Rome

DIED 64-68  
FEAST DAY: JUNE 30

After a raging fire destroyed two-thirds of Rome in 64, Emperor Nero blamed Rome's Christians to divert suspicion from himself. Those acknowledging their Christianity were arrested and executed. Some were covered in wax and set afire as torches; some were sewn into animal skins and cast into the arena with wild animals; others were crucified. Sts. Peter and Paul died in the same persecution. The feast of these earliest martyrs of the Roman church is celebrated a day after the joint feast of Peter and Paul. The Roman historian Tacitus said the protomartyrs were to be pitied "for it was felt that they were being sacrificed to one man's brutality."

## Apostles Peter and Paul

FIRST CENTURY  
FEAST DAY: JUNE 29

These apostles share a feast as founders of the church in Rome. Peter, a Galilean fisherman chosen by Christ as one of the Twelve Apostles, became the undisputed leader of the fledgling church after Pentecost. Paul, a Pharisee and Roman citizen who had persecuted Christians, became after his dramatic conversion the church's greatest missionary, its "apostle of the gentiles." By tradition both were martyred in Rome. Their adventures are recounted in the Acts of the Apostles, and letters from them are included in the New Testament.

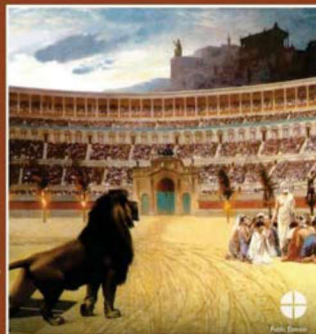

## Los Primeros Mártires de Roma

FALLECIERON EN LOS AÑOS 64-68  
DÍA DE FIESTA—30 DE JUNIO

Luego de un fuego arrasador que destruyó las dos terceras partes de Roma en el año 64, el emperador Nerón culpó a los cristianos romanos a fin de desviar la atención de sí mismo. Aquellos que decían ser cristianos fueron arrestados y ejecutados. A algunos los cubrieron con cera y les prendieron fuego como antorchas; a otros los cubrieron con pieles de animales y los echaron al ruedo con animales salvajes; otros fueron crucificados. Los santos Pedro y Pablo fallecieron durante esa misma persecución. La fiesta de estos primeros mártires de la Iglesia Católica se celebra un día después de la fiesta de san Pedro y san Pablo. El historiador romano Tácito dijo que los protomártires eran dignos de lástima "porque se sentía que estaban siendo sacrificados por la brutalidad de un solo hombre".

Estos apóstoles comparten una fiesta como fundadores de la iglesia en Roma. Pedro, un pescador galileo, escogido por Cristo como uno de los Doce Apóstoles, se convirtió en el indiscutible líder de la naciente iglesia después de Pentecostés. Pablo, quien era fariseo y ciudadano romano y que había perseguido a los cristianos, luego de su dramática conversión se convirtió en el más grande misionero de la iglesia, en el "apóstol de los gentiles". Por tradición, ambos fueron martirizados en Roma. Sus aventuras están narradas en los Hechos de los Apóstoles y, en el Nuevo Testamento, se incluyen cartas escritas por ellos.

### FINAL NOTICE FOR INSPIRING HOPE PLEDGES

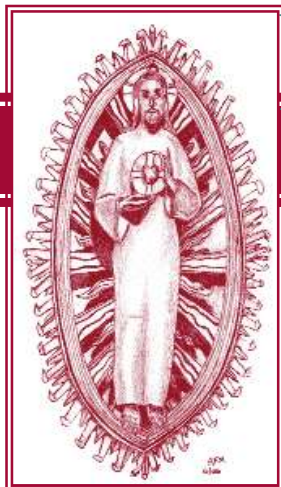

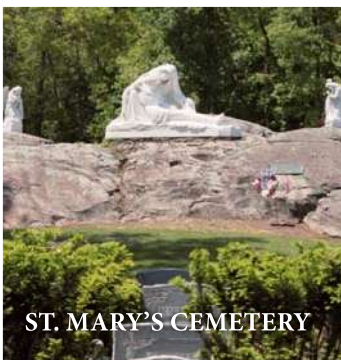
