✠ From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Parishioners of Sacred Heart,

A couple of items made the news recently that you may have missed. In the state of Washington there is a new law stating that priests are bound to report child sexual abuse to the authorities even if it is learned within the context of going to confession. As you know, everything that is shared between the penitent and the priest is protected by the seal of confession. A priest may never under any circumstances reveal to anyone the contents of a person's sacramental confession. If this is done, then the priest is automatically excommunicated from the Church and obviously cannot serve as a priest until the Church deems him worthy to return. What is troubling about the law in Washington is not only the attack on the freedom of religion but also the exemption of other professionals such as teachers and therapists from the same standard of reporting. The good news is that the Bishops in Washington have filed a lawsuit and many civil libertarians agree that the law will be struck down soon.

Another piece of news has to do with churches' involvement with political issues particularly endorsements of candidates. The IRS stated recently that a church could endorse a candidate without jeopardizing their tax-exempt status. The U. S. Bishops were quick to respond by saying that it is important to encourage participation in the political process, the Catholic Church forbids priests and parishes from endorsing a candidate. This action would lead to a further division in the parish. As a priest friend of mine said, no political candidate can ever measure up to the standard of the Gospel and our mission is to preach and live the Kingdom of God and not help someone get into office. May the Lord give all politicians the grace to make sound and holy decisions.

Del Escritorio del Párroco ✠

Queridos Parroquianos del Sagrado Corazón,

Un par de noticias recientes que quizás no hayas visto. En el estado de Washington, existe una nueva ley que establece que los sacerdotes están obligados a denunciar el abuso sexual infantil a las autoridades, incluso si se enteran durante una confesión. Como sabes, todo lo que se comparte entre el penitente y el sacerdote está protegido por el secreto de confesión. Un sacerdote nunca, bajo ninguna circunstancia, puede revelar a nadie el contenido de la confesión sacramental de una persona. Si lo hace, el sacerdote queda automáticamente excomulgado de la Iglesia y, obviamente, no puede ejercer como sacerdote hasta que la Iglesia lo considere digno de regresar. Lo preocupante de la ley en Washington no es solo el ataque a la libertad religiosa, sino también la exención de otros profesionales, como maestros y terapeutas, del mismo estándar de denuncia. La buena noticia es que los obispos de Washington han presentado una demanda y muchos defensores de las libertades civiles coinciden en que la ley será derogada pronto.

Otra noticia tiene que ver con la participación de las iglesias en asuntos políticos, en particular el respaldo a candidatos. El IRS declaró recientemente que una iglesia podía respaldar a un candidato sin comprometer su estatus de exención de impuestos. Los obispos estadounidenses respondieron rápidamente, afirmando que es fundamental fomentar la participación en el proceso político; la Iglesia Católica prohíbe a los sacerdotes y parroquias respaldar a un candidato. Esta acción generaría una mayor división en la parroquia. Como dijo un sacerdote amigo mío, ningún candidato político puede jamás estar a la altura del Evangelio, y nuestra misión es predicar y vivir el Reino de Dios, no ayudar a nadie a llegar a un cargo. Que el Señor conceda a todos los políticos la gracia de tomar decisiones sensatas y santas.

Dear friends,

As you may know, devastating floods in over twenty counties in Texas have brought enormous destruction and a great loss of life. The floods have killed 121 people with the expectation that number could increase. More than 160 people are still missing. The Guadalupe River rose some 26 feet in 45 minutes and resulted in the deaths of at least 27 children and camp counselors from Camp Mystic, a girls' summer camp. This was part of a large weather system that impacted most severely Texas as well as the southwest.

Recognizing the immediate and growing needs, Catholic Charities USA is seeking assistance for relief efforts in response to the floods. In the spirit of solidarity, Archbishop Henning is asking pastors to voluntarily consider a special collection to support Catholic Charities relief efforts. Parishes may determine other ways to lend support along with prayers and special intentions for overcoming this immense challenge. We are encouraged to hold the collection at our discretion during July and August 2025. For Sacred Heart Parish, we will hold our 2nd collection on the weekend of Sunday, **August 3, 2025**.

If you would like to contribute, please address your checks to **SACRED HEART PARISH** with "**Texas Flood Relief**" in the memo. One check will be sent from the parish, payable to the Archdiocese of Boston. The Archdiocese will then send 100% of your donations to Catholic Charities USA.

The people are suffering in Texas. It is anticipated that local Catholic Charities will experience a strain on their resources. We appreciate your prayers and any contribution you are able to make towards this relief effort.

Queridos Amigos,

Como ya saben, las devastadoras inundaciones en más de veinte condados de Texas han provocado una enorme destrucción y una gran pérdida de vidas. Las inundaciones han causado la muerte de 121 personas y se prevé que la cifra podría aumentar. Más de 160 personas siguen desaparecidas. El río Guadalupe creció unos 8 metros en 45 minutos y causó la muerte de al menos 27 niños y monitores de Camp Mystic, un campamento de verano para niñas. Esto formó parte de un gran sistema meteorológico que afectó gravemente a Texas y al suroeste.

Reconociendo las necesidades inmediatas y crecientes, Catholic Charities USA solicita ayuda para las labores de socorro en respuesta a las inundaciones. En solidaridad, el arzobispo Henning pide a los párrocos que consideren voluntariamente una colecta especial para apoyar las labores de socorro de Catholic Charities. Las parroquias pueden determinar otras maneras de brindar apoyo, junto con oraciones e intenciones especiales para superar este inmenso desafío. Se nos anima a realizar la colecta a nuestra discreción durante julio y agosto de 2025. Para la Parroquia del Sagrado Corazón realizaremos nuestra 2^a colecta el fin de semana de domingo, **3 de agosto de 2025**.

DISEASE UPDATE FROM THE PARISH HEALTH MINISTRY: JULY 2025: MEASLES OUTBREAK

As of July 9, 2025 there are 1,288 confirmed cases of Measles across 39 states. 92 % of the cases were in unvaccinated individuals or those with an unknown vaccine status . 4% of cases had 1 Measles, Mumps Rubella (MMR) vaccine and 4% had 2 MMR vaccines. These cases resulted in 162 hospitalizations and 3 deaths.

Measles is a highly contagious disease in which symptoms appear 7-14 days after exposure. Symptoms include a high fever (up to 104); cough; runny nose; red, watery eyes; tiny white spots in the mouth (day 2-3). Between day 3-5 a rash appears as flat red spots on the face/hairline that eventually raise and spread to the neck, trunk, arms, legs and feet.

Measles can cause severe complications particularly for those most at risk of contracting the disease including kids under 5 years; adults over 20; pregnant women; individuals with conditions such as HIV or leukemia which causes a weakened immune systems.

If you are unvaccinated, the best way to prevent measles is with a series of shots 28 days apart for adults. Children are eligible for the first vaccine at 12-15 months and the second between 4-6 years old. 2 doses of the MMR vaccine are 97% effective at preventing illness. If you or someone you know is exposed to the measles contact your healthcare provider right away.

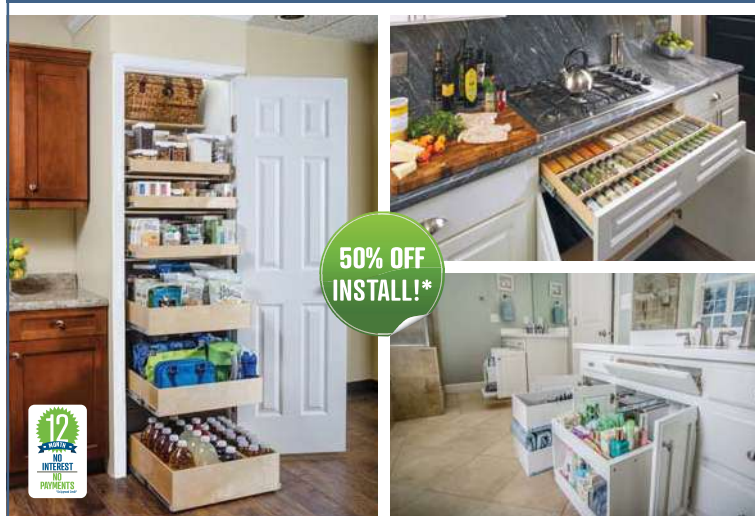

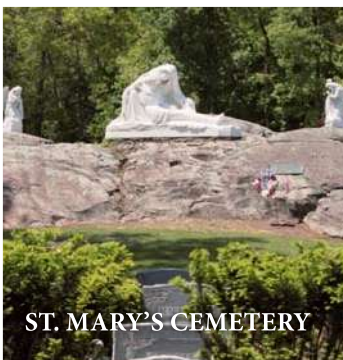
