**19TH SUNDAY
IN ORDINARY TIME (YEAR A)**

How do we find God in the storms and struggles of our lives, in the trials we encounter in trying to do His will?

God commands Elijah in today's First Reading to stand on the mountain and await His passing by. And in the Gospel, Jesus makes the disciples set out across the waters to meet Him.

In each case, the Lord makes himself present amid frightening tumult - heavy winds and high waves, fire and earthquakes.

Elijah hides his face. Perhaps he remembers Moses, who met God on the same mountain, also amid fire, thunder, and smoke (see Deuteronomy 4:10-15; Exodus 19:17-19). God told Moses no one could see His face and live, and He sheltered Moses in the hollow of a rock, as He shelters Elijah in a cave (see Exodus 33:18-23).

The disciples, likewise, are too terrified to look on the face of God. Today's Gospel is a revelation of Jesus' divine identity. Only God treads across the crest of the sea (see Job 9:8) and rules the raging waters (see Psalm 89:9-10). And the words of assurance that Jesus speaks - "It is I" - are those God used to identify himself to Moses (see Exodus 3:14; Isaiah 43:10).

Even Peter is too overcome by fear to imitate his Lord. His fears, Jesus tells him, are a sign of his lack of faith. And so it often is with us. Our fears make us doubt, make it hard to see His glory dwelling in our midst.

Yet, we should know, as we sing in today's psalm, that His salvation is near to those who hope in Him. By faith we should know, as Paul asserts in today's Epistle, that we are heirs to the promises made to His children, Israel.

We must trust that He whispers to us in the trials of our lives - that He who has called us to walk along the way of His steps, will save us whenever we begin to sink.

Contrato de Arrendamiento del Estacionamiento

La parroquia inició un contrato de arrendamiento con Commodore Construction el 1 de agosto para que utilicen nuestro estacionamiento inferior hasta el 31 de julio de 2027. La empresa está llevando a cabo importantes obras de renovación en la escuela Brooke Charter School y necesitaba espacio de estacionamiento para sus contratistas. Es posible que haya notado dos barreras que los dirigen a sus lugares asignados; no tienen permitido estacionarse en nuestro estacionamiento superior. En caso de funerales u otros eventos parroquiales, se les indicará que se estacionen en otro lugar. Tampoco se estacionarán allí durante las misas de fin de semana. Al igual que en el contrato anterior con Brooke —que permitía a los padres de los alumnos utilizar el espacio para dejar y recoger a sus hijos—, la empresa ha acordado compensar a la parroquia. Aunque se trata de una suma pequeña, nos ayudará a trabajar para reducir nuestro déficit.

**XVIX DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO
ORDINARIO (CICLO A)**

¿Cómo encontramos a Dios en las tormentas y luchas de nuestra vida, en las pruebas que afrontamos al tratar de cumplir su voluntad?

En la primera lectura de hoy, Dios ordena a Elías que se sitúe en la montaña y aguarde su paso. Y en el Evangelio, Jesús hace que los discípulos se lancen a atravesar las aguas para encontrarse con Él.

En ambos casos, el Señor se hace presente en medio de un tumulto aterrador: vientos fuertes y olas enormes, fuego y terremotos.

Elías se cubre el rostro. Quizás recuerda a Moisés, quien se encontró con Dios en esa misma montaña, también entre fuego, truenos y humo (véanse Deuteronomio 4, 10-15; Éxodo 19, 17-19). Dios le había dicho a Moisés que nadie podía ver su rostro y seguir con vida, y lo protegió en la hendidura de una roca, tal como protege a Elías en una cueva (véase Éxodo 33, 18-23).

Del mismo modo, los discípulos están demasiado asustados para contemplar el rostro de Dios. El Evangelio de hoy es una revelación de la identidad divina de Jesús. Solo Dios camina sobre las crestas del mar (véase Job 9, 8) y domina las aguas agitadas (véase Salmo 89, 9-10). Y las palabras tranquilizadoras que pronuncia Jesús —«Soy yo»— son las mismas que Dios utilizó para identificarse ante Moisés (véanse Éxodo 3, 14; Isaías 43, 10).

Incluso Pedro se deja dominar tanto por el miedo que no logra imitar a su Señor. Jesús le dice que sus temores son señal de su falta de fe. Y a menudo nos sucede lo mismo a nosotros: nuestros miedos nos hacen dudar y dificultan que veamos su gloria habitando entre nosotros.

Sin embargo, debemos saber —como cantamos en el salmo de hoy— que su salvación está cerca de quienes ponen su esperanza en Él. Por la fe debemos saber —como afirma Pablo en la epístola de hoy— que somos herederos de las promesas hechas a sus hijos, Israel.

Debemos confiar en que Él nos habla al susurro en las pruebas de nuestra vida, y en que Aquel que nos ha llamado a seguir sus pasos nos salvará siempre que empecemos a hundirnos.

Parking Lot Lease

The parish began a lease with Commodore Construction on August 1st for them to use our lower parking lot until July 31, 2027. They are doing major renovations at the Brooke Charter School and they were in need of parking for their contractors. You may have noticed two barriers that direct them to their proper spots and are not allowed to park in our upper lot. In the event of a funeral or other parish event they will be instructed to park elsewhere. They will not be parking there during weekend Masses. As was the case with the prior lease with Brooke for students' parents to use it as a drop off and pick up point they have agreed to compensate the parish. While a small sum, it will help us to work towards reducing our deficit.

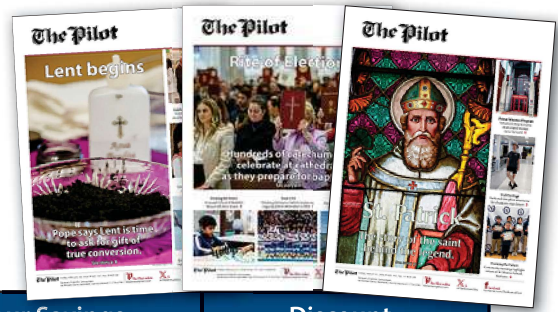

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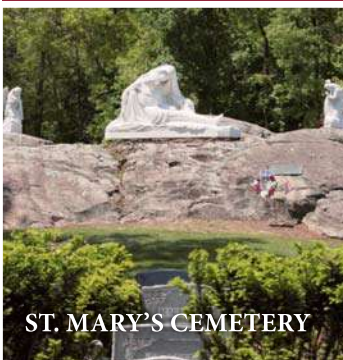


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ST. MARY'S CEMETERY
