**20TH SUNDAY
IN ORDINARY TIME (YEAR A)**

Most of us are the foreigners, the non-Israelites, about whom today's First Reading prophesies.

Coming to worship the God of Israel, we stand in the line of faith epitomized by the Canaanite woman in today's Gospel. Calling to Jesus as Lord and Son of David, this foreigner shows her great faith in God's covenant with Israel.

Jesus tests her faith three times. He refuses to answer her cry. Then, He tells her His mission is only to Israelites. Finally, he uses "dog," an epithet used to disparage non-Israelites (see Matthew 7:6). Yet she persists, believing that He alone offers salvation.

In this family drama, we see fulfilled Isaiah's prophecy and the promise we sing of in today's Psalm. In Jesus, God makes known among all the nations His way and His salvation (see John 14:6).

At the start of salvation history, God called Abraham (see Genesis 12:2). He chose his offspring, Israel, from all the nations on the face of the earth, to build His covenant kingdom (see Deuteronomy 7:6-8; Isaiah 41:8).

In God's plan, Abraham was to be the father of many nations (see Romans 4:16-17). Israel was to be the firstborn of a worldwide family of God, made up of all who believe what the Canaanite professes - that Jesus is Lord (see Exodus 4:22-23; Romans 5:13-24).

Jesus came first to restore the kingdom to Israel (see Acts 1:6; 13:46). But His ultimate mission was the reconciliation of the world, as Paul declares in today's Epistle.

In the Mass we join all peoples in doing Him homage. As Isaiah foretold, we come to His holy mountain, the heavenly Jerusalem, to offer sacrifice at His altar (see Hebrews 12:22-24, 28). With the Canaanite, we take our place at the Master's table, to be fed as His children.

Contrato de Arrendamiento del Estacionamiento

La parroquia inició un contrato de arrendamiento con Commodore Construction el 1 de agosto para que utilicen nuestro estacionamiento inferior hasta el 31 de julio de 2027. La empresa está llevando a cabo importantes obras de renovación en la escuela Brooke Charter School y necesitaba espacio de estacionamiento para sus contratistas. Es posible que haya notado dos barreras que los dirigen a sus lugares asignados; no tienen permitido estacionarse en nuestro estacionamiento superior. En caso de funerales u otros eventos parroquiales, se les indicará que se estacionen en otro lugar. Tampoco se estacionarán allí durante las misas de fin de semana. Al igual que en el contrato anterior con Brooke —que permitía a los padres de los alumnos utilizar el espacio para dejar y recoger a sus hijos—, la empresa ha acordado compensar a la parroquia. Aunque se trata de una suma pequeña, nos ayudará a trabajar para reducir nuestro déficit.

La mayoría de nosotros somos los extranjeros, los no israelitas, sobre quienes profetiza la Primera Lectura de hoy.

Al acudir a adorar al Dios de Israel, nos situamos en la misma línea de fe que ejemplifica la mujer cananea en el Evangelio de hoy. Al invocar a Jesús como Señor e Hijo de David, esta extranjera demuestra su gran fe en la alianza de Dios con Israel.

Jesús pone a prueba su fe en tres ocasiones. Se niega a responder a su clamor. Luego, le dice que su misión se limita a los israelitas. Finalmente, utiliza la palabra "perro", un epíteto empleado para menospreciar a los no israelitas (véase Mateo 7, 6). Sin embargo, ella persiste, convencida de que solo Él ofrece la salvación.

En este drama familiar vemos cumplirse la profecía de Isaías y la promesa que cantamos en el Salmo de hoy. En Jesús, Dios da a conocer su camino y su salvación entre todas las naciones (véase Juan 14, 6).

Al comienzo de la historia de la salvación, Dios llamó a Abraham (véase Génesis 12, 2). Eligió a su descendencia, Israel, de entre todas las naciones de la tierra, para edificar su reino de alianza (véase Deuteronomio 7, 6-8; Isaías 41, 8).

En el plan de Dios, Abraham debía ser padre de muchas naciones (véase Romanos 4, 16-17). Israel había de ser el primogénito de una familia universal de Dios, compuesta por todos aquellos que creen lo que la cananea profesa: que Jesús es el Señor (véase Éxodo 4, 22-23; Romanos 5, 13-24).

Jesús vino primero para restaurar el reino de Israel (véase Hechos 1, 6; 13, 46). Pero su misión definitiva era la reconciliación del mundo, tal como declara Pablo en la Epístola de hoy.

En la Misa nos unimos a todos los pueblos para rendirle homenaje. Como predijo Isaías, acudimos a su monte santo, la Jerusalén celestial, para ofrecer sacrificio en su altar (véase Hebreos 12, 22-24, 28). Junto a la cananea, ocupamos nuestro lugar en la mesa del Maestro para ser alimentados como hijos suyos.

Parking Lot Lease

The parish began a lease with Commodore Construction on August 1st for them to use our lower parking lot until July 31, 2027. They are doing major renovations at the Brooke Charter School and they were in need of parking for their contractors. You may have noticed two barriers that direct them to their proper spots and are not allowed to park in our upper lot. In the event of a funeral or other parish event they will be instructed to park elsewhere. They will not be parking there during weekend Masses. As was the case with the prior lease with Brooke for students' parents to use it as a drop off and pick up point they have agreed to compensate the parish. While a small sum, it will help us to work towards reducing our deficit.

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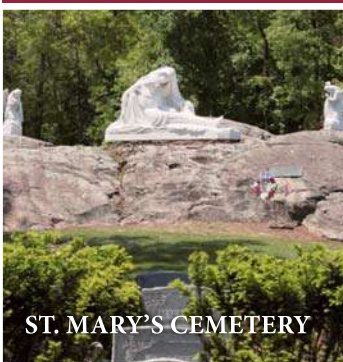


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ST. MARY'S CEMETERY
