✠ From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Parishioners of Sacred Heart,

A few weeks ago, we received the 2025 Boston Catholic Directory which contains a plethora of information. It includes a listing of all parishes, offices, schools and ministries within the Archdiocese along with the priests, religious and deacons who serve the local Church. Each parish is asked to provide a sacramental statistical report for a specific time period which in the case of the latest directory covers July 1, 2023 to June 30, 2024. Sacred Heart celebrated 54 baptisms, 14 confirmations, 46 first communions, 9 Weddings and 55 funerals. The average attendance at our six weekend Mass is 145 (the highest attended Mass is the Sunday Noon Mass which regularly draws around 400 people while the 5:15 Sunday Mass has roughly 60 in attendance). What is not included in this report is the amount of times that the sacrament of the sick was administered to ill parishioners. I know that from my own experience and what Fr. Succes shares with me is that this moment of healing is occurring quite regularly at area hospitals, nursing homes, homes and within our church. We are a parish that is there for people at the beginning of their faith journey and at every moment until the Lord calls them home. We are trending upwards in all areas except for weddings which needs to be addressed in homilies and pastoral moments. I would like to see the average Mass attendance to grow to 167 which would mean we would have at least 1000 people at the weekend Masses on a regular basis.

The one way that numbers can grow is by your personal invitation to family, friends and neighbors to be a part of parish life. By joining us they welcome all the graces and blessings that only the Lord can bestow upon them.

Del Escritorio del Párroco ✠

Queridos Parroquianos del Sagrado Corazón,

Hace unas semanas, recibimos el Directorio Católico de Boston 2025, que contiene una gran cantidad de información. Incluye una lista de todas las parroquias, oficinas, escuelas y ministerios de la Arquidiócesis, junto con los sacerdotes, religiosos y diáconos que sirven a la Iglesia local. Se solicita a cada parroquia que proporcione un informe estadístico sacramental para un período específico que, en el caso del directorio más reciente, abarca del 1 de julio de 2023 al 30 de junio de 2024. El Sagrado Corazón celebró 54 bautismos, 14 confirmaciones, 46 primeras comuniones, 9 bodas y 55 funerales. La asistencia promedio a nuestras seis Misas de fin de semana es de 145 personas (la Misa con mayor asistencia es la del mediodía del domingo, que suele reunir a unas 400 personas, mientras que la misa dominical de las 5:15 tiene aproximadamente 60 asistentes). Lo que no se incluye en este informe es la cantidad de veces que se administró el sacramento de la unción a feligreses enfermos. Lo sé por experiencia propia y por lo que el P. Succes me cuenta que este momento de sanación ocurre con bastante frecuencia en hospitales, residencias de ancianos, hogares y en nuestra iglesia. Somos una parroquia que acompaña a las personas en sus inicios de fe y en todo momento hasta que el Señor las llame a casa. Estamos mejorando en todos los aspectos, excepto en las bodas, que deben abordarse en las homilias y momentos pastorales. Me gustaría que la asistencia promedio a Misa aumentara a 167 personas, lo que significaría que tendríamos al menos 1000 personas en las Misas de fin de semana con regularidad.

La única manera de que la feligresía crezca es invitando personalmente a familiares, amigos y vecinos a formar parte de la vida parroquial. Al unirse a nosotros, acogen con satisfacción todas las gracias y bendiciones que solo el Señor puede concederles.

Saint Bernard Abbot and Doctor of the Church

1090 - 1153

FEAST DAY: AUGUST 20

Known as Bernard of Clairvaux, this French abbot and doctor of the church is considered the second founder of the Cistercians. He entered the relatively new monastery at Citeaux in 1113 with four of his own brothers and 27 friends, and later founded the monastery at Clairvaux, which gave birth to 68 other communities. Despite poor health and his devotion to personal mortification, Bernard was an early Western European rock star: He was consulted by popes and kings, battled heresies, and supported the Second Crusade. The sick and maimed lined the roads he traveled, hoping for a miracle. Dante chose Bernard as his final guide in "Paradiso," at the end of "The Divine Comedy." He is the patron of Gibraltar.

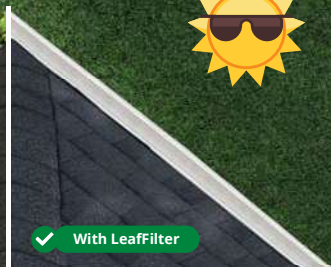


