FOR BIBLICAL THEOLOGY IN ORDINARY TIME (YEAR A)

"Oh, the depth of the riches and wisdom and knowledge of God!" Paul exclaims in today's Epistle. Today's Psalm, too, takes up the triumphant note of joy and thanksgiving. Why? Because in the Gospel, the heavenly Father reveals the mystery of His kingdom to Peter.

With Peter, we rejoice that Jesus is the anointed son promised to David, the one prophesied to build God's temple and reign over an everlasting kingdom (see 2 Samuel 7).

What Jesus calls "my Church" is the kingdom promised to David's son (see Isaiah 9:1-7). As we hear in today's First Reading, Isaiah foretold that the keys to David's kingdom would be given to a new master, who would rule as father to God's people.

Jesus, the root and offspring of David, alone holds the kingdom's keys (see Revelation 1:18; 3:7; 22:16). In giving those keys to Peter, Jesus fulfills that prophecy, establishing Peter - and all who succeed him - as holy father of His Church.

His Church, too, is the new house of God - the spiritual temple founded on the "rock" of Peter, and built up out of the living stones of individual believers (see 1 Peter 2:5).

Abraham was called "the rock" from which the children of Israel were hewn (see Isaiah 51:1-2). And Peter becomes the rock from which God raises up new children of God (see Matthew 3:9).

The word Jesus uses - "church" (ekklesia in Greek) - was used in the Greek translation of the Old Testament for the "assembly" of God's children after the exodus (see Deuteronomy 18:16; 31:30).

His Church is the "assembly of the firstborn" (see Hebrews 12:23; Exodus 4:23-24), established by Jesus' exodus (see Luke 9:31). Like the Israelites, we are baptized in water, led by the Rock, and fed with spiritual food (see 1 Corinthians 10:1-5).

Gathered at His altar, in the presence of angels, we sing His praise and give thanks to His holy name.

*He said to them, "But who do you say that I am?"
Simon Peter said in reply,*

"You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God."

Matthew 16:15-16

ST. PAUL CENTER XXI DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO
FOR BIBLICAL THEOLOGY ORDINARIO (CICLO A)

«¡Oh, profundidad de las riquezas, de la sabiduría y de la ciencia de Dios!», exclama san Pablo en la Epístola de hoy. También el Salmo de hoy se hace eco de esa nota triunfal de alegría y acción de gracias. ¿Por qué? Porque en el Evangelio, el Padre celestial revela el misterio de su Reino a Pedro.

Nos alegramos junto con Pedro de que Jesús sea el hijo ungido prometido a David, aquel de quien se profetizó que construiría el templo de Dios y reinaría sobre un reino eterno (véase 2 Samuel 7).

Lo que Jesús llama «mi Iglesia» es el reino prometido al hijo de David (véase Isaías 9:1-7). Como escuchamos en la Primera Lectura de hoy, Isaías predijo que las llaves del reino de David serían entregadas a un nuevo administrador, quien gobernaría como padre del pueblo de Dios.

Jesús, la raíz y el descendiente de David, es el único que posee las llaves del Reino (véase Apocalipsis 1:18; 3:7; 22:16). Al entregar esas llaves a Pedro, Jesús cumple dicha profecía, estableciendo a Pedro —y a todos sus sucesores— como padre santo de su Iglesia.

Su Iglesia es también la nueva casa de Dios: el templo espiritual fundado sobre la «roca» de Pedro y edificado con las piedras vivas de los creyentes (véase 1 Pedro 2:5).

A Abraham se le llamó «la roca» de la cual fueron tallados los hijos de Israel (véase Isaías 51:1-2). Y Pedro se convierte en la roca de la cual Dios suscita nuevos hijos de Dios (véase Mateo 3:9).

La palabra que utiliza Jesús —«iglesia» (*ekklesia* en griego) — se empleaba en la traducción griega del Antiguo Testamento para referirse a la «asamblea» de los hijos de Dios tras el Éxodo (véase Deuteronomio 18:16; 31:30).

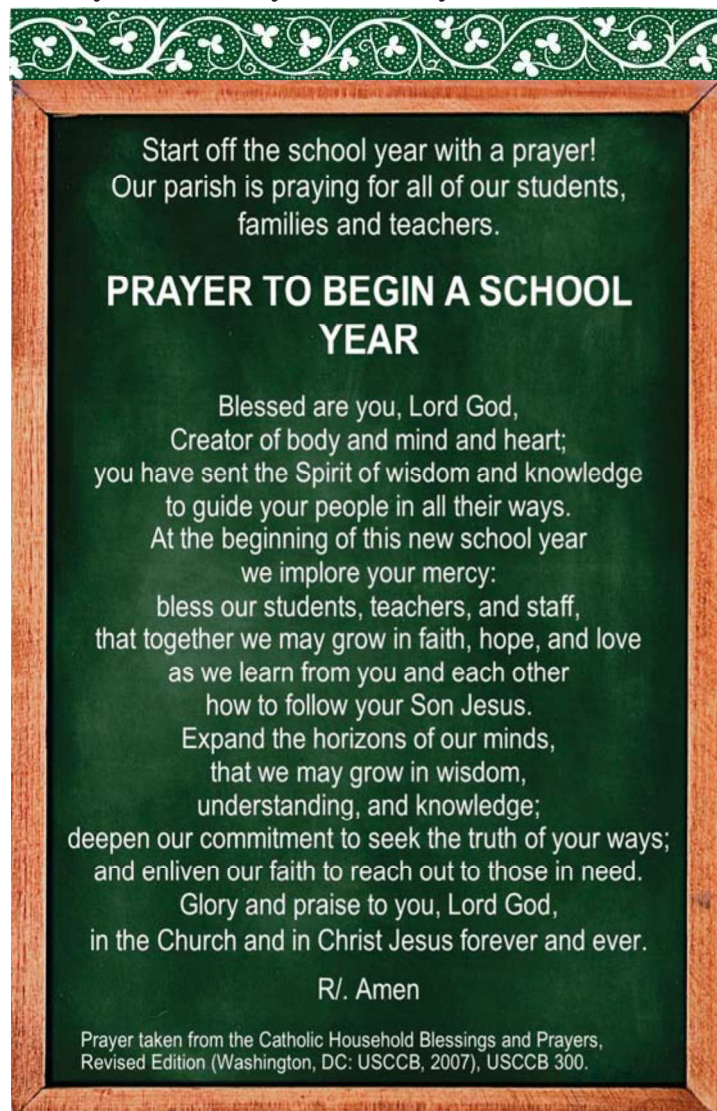
Su Iglesia es la «asamblea de los primogénitos» (véase Hebreos 12:23; Éxodo 4:23-24), establecida mediante el éxodo de Jesús (véase Lucas 9:31). Al igual que los israelitas, somos bautizados en agua, guiados por la Roca y alimentados con alimento espiritual (véase 1 Corintios 10:1-5). Reunidos ante su altar, en presencia de los ángeles, cantamos sus alabanzas y damos gracias a su santo nombre.

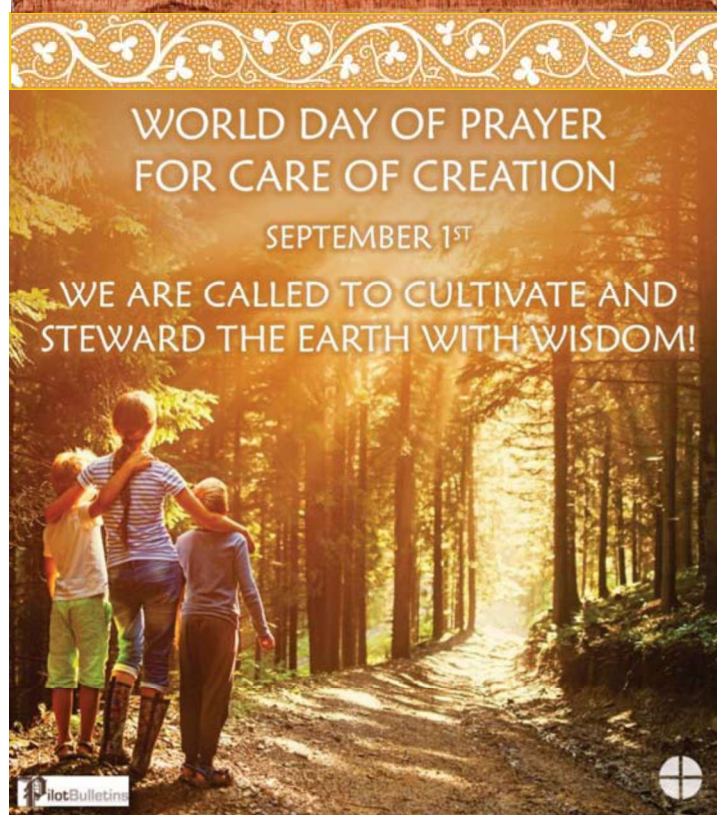

Contrato de Arrendamiento del Estacionamiento

La parroquia inició un contrato de arrendamiento con Commodore Construction el 1 de agosto para que utilicen nuestro estacionamiento inferior hasta el 31 de julio de 2027. La empresa está llevando a cabo importantes obras de renovación en la escuela Brooke Charter School y necesitaba espacio de estacionamiento para sus contratistas. Es posible que haya notado dos barreras que los dirigen a sus lugares asignados; no tienen permitido estacionarse en nuestro estacionamiento superior. En caso de funerales u otros eventos parroquiales, se les indicará que se estacionen en otro lugar. Tampoco se estacionarán allí durante las misas de fin de semana. Al igual que en el contrato anterior con Brooke —que permitía a los padres de los alumnos utilizar el espacio para dejar y recoger a sus hijos—, la empresa ha acordado compensar a la parroquia. Aunque se trata de una suma pequeña, nos ayudará a trabajar para reducir nuestro déficit.

Parking Lot Lease

The parish began a lease with Commodore Construction on August 1st for them to use our lower parking lot until July 31, 2027. They are doing major renovations at the Brooke Charter School and they were in need of parking for their contractors. You may have noticed two barriers that direct them to their proper spots and are not allowed to park in our upper lot. In the event of a funeral or other parish event they will be instructed to park elsewhere. They will not be parking there during weekend Masses. As was the case with the prior lease with Brooke for students' parents to use it as a drop off and pick up point they have agreed to compensate the parish. While a small sum, it will help us to work towards reducing our deficit.
