From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Parishioners of Sacred Heart,

Archbishop Henning has appointed me to serve as Vicar Forane for Vicariate I of the Central Region. I am honored that he has asked me to serve in this capacity. The Archdiocese of Boston is broken up into several regions: Merrimack, North, South, West and Central, which is where we are located. Each region is overseen by an Auxiliary Bishop or Episcopal Vicar who assist the Archbishop in his pastoral and spiritual care of the over 250 parishes within the Archdiocese. Regions contain territories of several parishes called vicariates and our particular one encompasses Roslindale, Hyde Park, Readville, Jamaica Plain, West Roxbury, Brookline and some parts of Roxbury and Milton. For the next three years I will work with my brother priests to collaborate in our common mission and ministry of the Church. We gather every other month for priestly fraternity and discuss whatever concerns may be on our minds. Our regional Bishop Cristiano Barbosa also communicates to me directly on behalf of the Archbishop about pastoral planning and how this will impact parish life. It will be my role to ensure that priests feel supported in their day to day work. On occasion, the Vicar brings concerns to their attention which may have had been brought to light and have had a negative consequences for the pastoral and spiritual life of their parish. I pray that these moments are few! Please pray for me as this part of my priestly works begins while continuing to serve here as your pastor.




