

Dear Parishioners of Sacred Heart,

Our parish school has officially re-opened for the academic year but we do so mindful of the tragic mass shooting at the Annunciation Parish in Minneapolis, MN. The first response for all of our faculty, staff, and community was to raise our prayers to God which is what believers do at all moments of life from the greatest joys to the most heartbreaking sorrows. The actions we have been taking over the years included installing an updated lock system and having an "Active Shooter" workshop two years ago. Faculty and staff were instructed on what should be done in the event that such an event were to ever happen at Sacred Heart School. I will be coordinating with the new Head of Campus, Caitlin Sullivan, and her assistant, Kathleen Paulino, to arrange another training since we have several new faculty members who joined us in recent weeks. I am also going to be addressing this concern with our new Pastoral Council so we can develop our own Parish Safety Plan which would include hosting a similar workshop for ushers and ministers. We are meeting Monday night, September 8th from 6:30-8:00 pm in the Murray Room and you are always welcome to attend.

Please pray for an end to violence in all of its forms. I ask that the government pass laws preventing the sale of assault-style firearms, enact enforceable gun control measures, including universal background checks and waiting periods.


Queridos Parroquianos del Sagrado Corazón,

Nuestra escuela parroquial reabrió oficialmente sus puertas para el año académico, pero lo hacemos conscientes del trágico tiroteo masivo ocurrido en la Parroquia de la Anunciación en Minneapolis, Minnesota. La primera reacción de todo nuestro profesorado, personal y comunidad fue elevar nuestras oraciones a Dios, como lo hacen los creyentes en todos los momentos de la vida, desde las mayores alegrías hasta las más dolorosas tristezas. Las medidas que hemos estado tomando a lo largo de los años incluyen la instalación de un sistema de cerraduras actualizado y la celebración de un taller sobre "Tiradores Activos" hace dos años. Se instruyó al profesorado y al personal sobre qué hacer en caso de que un incidente de este tipo ocurriera en la Escuela del Sagrado Corazón. Me coordinaré con la nueva directora del campus, Caitlin Sullivan, y su asistente, Kathleen Paulino, para organizar otra capacitación, ya que se han incorporado varios profesores nuevos en las últimas semanas. También abordaré esta preocupación con nuestro nuevo Consejo Pastoral para que podamos desarrollar nuestro propio Plan de Seguridad Parroquial, que incluiría la organización de un taller similar para acomodadores y ministros. Nos reuniremos el lunes 8 de septiembre por la noche, de 6:30 a 8:00 pm, en la Sala Murray. Les invitamos a asistir.

Por favor, oren por el fin de la violencia en todas sus formas. Pido que el gobierno apruebe leyes que impidan la venta de armas de fuego de asalto y promulgue medidas de control de armas que sean ejecutables, incluyendo la verificación universal de antecedentes y los períodos de espera.




