Dear Parishioners of Sacred Heart,

Some of you may have heard of the Greater Boston Interfaith Organization (GBIO) which is a broad-based organization founded in 1998 who work for the common good in training people from many denominations and non-profits. Many years ago, Sacred Heart was a member but the relationship had waned and at this time, GBIO has very few Catholic parishes as dues paying members. For the past year, members and leadership have been reaching out to me asking if I would consider joining. I have attended a clergy meeting and most recently a Mayoral Candidate Forum at the Bethel AME Church in Forest Hills, which used to be Saint Andrew Church. There were over five hundred in attendance who wanted to ask the candidates the following questions: Would they commit to funding renovations for Madison Park Tech? Where do they stand on immigration? How would they address housing situation in the community? If elected would they be willing to meet with GBIO during their first hundred days of office? It was an informative and spiritual evening to be sure. I am still discerning whether or not we should be formal members at this point. They have much to offer us but so many of you are quite involved already with parish activities and meetings. I will keep you informed as always.

Algunos de ustedes quizá hayan oído hablar de la Organización Interreligiosa del Gran Boston (GBIO), una organización de base amplia fundada en 1998 que trabaja por el bien común capacitando a personas de diversas denominaciones y organizaciones sin fines de lucro. Hace muchos años, Sacred Heart era miembro, pero la relación se había deteriorado y, actualmente, la GBIO cuenta con muy pocas parroquias católicas como miembros que pagan cuotas. Durante el último año, miembros y líderes me han estado contactando para preguntarme si consideraría unirme. Asistí a una reunión del clero y, más recientemente, a un Foro de Candidatos a la Alcaldía en la Iglesia Metodista Episcopal Africana Bethel en Forest Hills, que antes era la Iglesia de San Andrés. Asistieron más de quinientas personas que querían hacerles las siguientes preguntas a los candidatos: ¿Se comprometerían a financiar las renovaciones de Madison Park Tech? ¿Cuál es su postura sobre inmigración? ¿Cómo abordarían la situación de la vivienda en la comunidad? De ser elegidos, ¿estarían dispuestos a reunirse con la GBIO durante sus primeros cien días de mandato? Fue una reunión informativa y espiritual, sin duda. Todavía estoy discerniendo si deberíamos ser miembros formales. Tienen mucho que ofrecernos, pero muchos de ustedes ya participan activamente en las actividades y reuniones parroquiales. Los mantendré informados como siempre.

ELEVATOR UPDATE AND USE

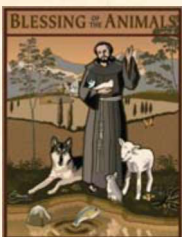

Exaltation of the Cross

Canterbury Street Bridge Rehabilitation

What is happening?

MassDOT will host a live, in-person design public hearing to provide community members with an opportunity to become fully acquainted with the proposed rehabilitation of the Canterbury Street Bridge which carries its namesake roadway over Amtrak's Northeast Corridor in the Roslindale neighborhood of Boston, Massachusetts. While the existing bridge remains safe for all users, critical components of the structure must be replaced to ensure that it can continue to provide a safe, multimodal crossing of the railroad line.

How will this affect you?

The proposed project consists of replacing the superstructure and roadway deck, as well as making sidewalk repairs to the bridge carrying Canterbury Street over Amtrak's Northeast Corridor. The rehabilitation will require the full and/or partial shutdown of the bridge and a detour of traffic to other neighborhood roadways. A discussion of the potential impacts of these closures will be provided at the hearing along with a timeline for the rehabilitation and how community members can stay informed during construction.

MassDOT encourages all interested members of the community to attend and learn more about this project.

Rehabilitación del puente de la Calle Canterbury

¿Lo que está sucediendo?

MassDOT organizará una audiencia pública de diseño en persona y en vivo para brindarles a los miembros de la comunidad la oportunidad de familiarizarse completamente con la rehabilitación propuesta del puente de la Calle Canterbury, que lleva Calle Canterbury sobre el corredor noreste de Amtrak en el vecindario de Roslindale de Boston, Massachusetts. Si bien el puente existente sigue siendo seguro para todos los usuarios, es necesario reemplazar componentes críticos de la estructura para garantizar que siga ofreciendo un cruce seguro y multimodal de la línea ferroviaria.

¿Cómo te afectará esto?

El proyecto propuesto consiste en reemplazar la superestructura y la plataforma de la calzada, así como reparar las aceras del puente que cruza la Calle Canterbury sobre el Corredor Noreste de Amtrak. La rehabilitación requerirá el cierre total o parcial del puente y el desvío del tráfico hacia otras vías del vecindario. En la audiencia se discutirán los posibles impactos de estos cierres, junto con un cronograma de la rehabilitación y cómo los miembros de la comunidad pueden mantenerse informados durante la construcción.

MassDOT alienta a todos los miembros interesados de la comunidad a asistir y aprender más sobre este proyecto.

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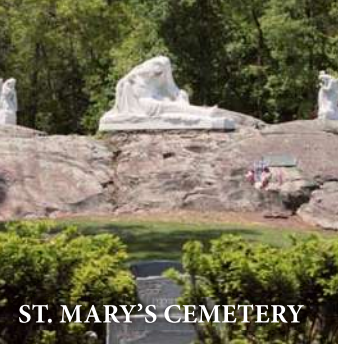
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 **ST. MARY'S CEMETERY**
