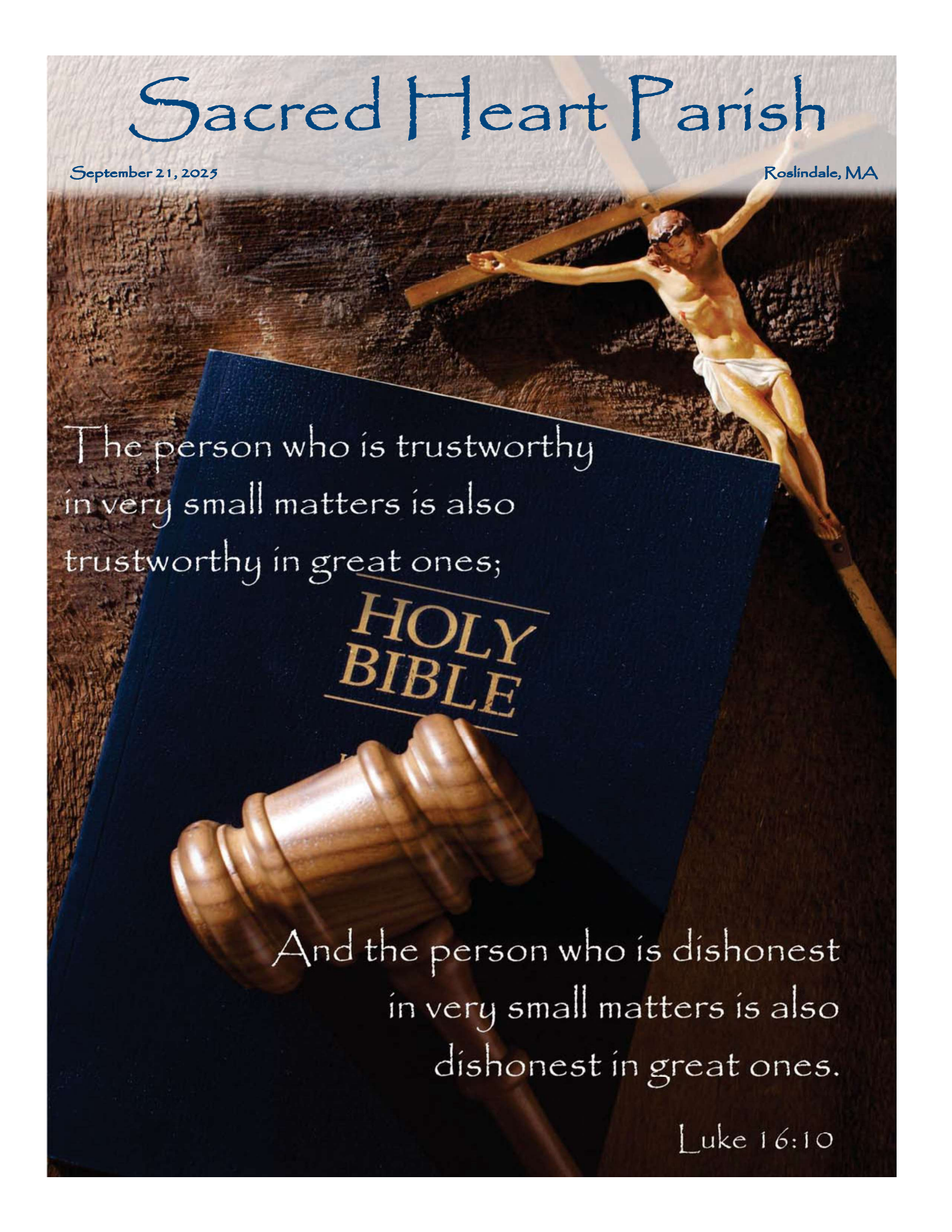

Dear Parishioners of Sacred Heart,

Our newly formed parish council convened on Monday, September 8th with nearly all members present. Along with myself and Father Succes, here are the men and women who have discerned that they have been called by the Lord to serve as my consultants to help guide our parish: Serving for 1 final year; Peter Buck, Edward Ngobidi, Mélida Arredondo; Serving for two years; Amaka Duegbunam, Maria Hernandez; New Members serving for three years, Sister Mary Henrietta Domingo, Jesse Keane, Justine Crenshaw, Connie Caruso, Kenny Ifih, Yashin Cerritos II, Peter Walsh, Charles Vernon, Phil Brunis and Chris Kennedy.

Among the topics we discussed during our time together included the concerns surrounding the possibility of ICE agents coming to the church or the school, what safety protocols are recommended for an active shooter, how we continue the faith formation process of those who have been newly confirmed, the nominees for the Chevrus Award from the Archdiocese, the possibility of rejoining the GBIO, our weekend Mass schedule, what are the options given if a priest were not available to celebrate Mass or to preside at Eucharistic Adoration and plans for fundraising such as a parish golf tournament.

Remember that the Council meets on the first Monday of the month at 6:30 in the Murray Room and is open to all parishioners. You can also speak to one of the members to raise a concern. (I cannot publish their email addresses or give out their cell phone numbers because scammers will get a hold of their information and try to solicit them for money or gift cards by impersonating me. Believe me, it has happened at nearly all of the parishes that I have been assigned).

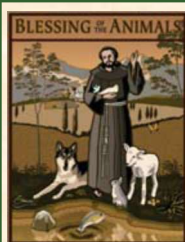

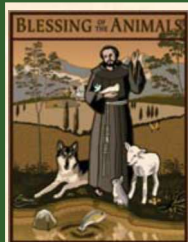

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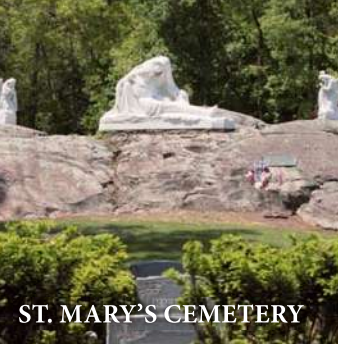
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 **ST. MARY'S CEMETERY**
