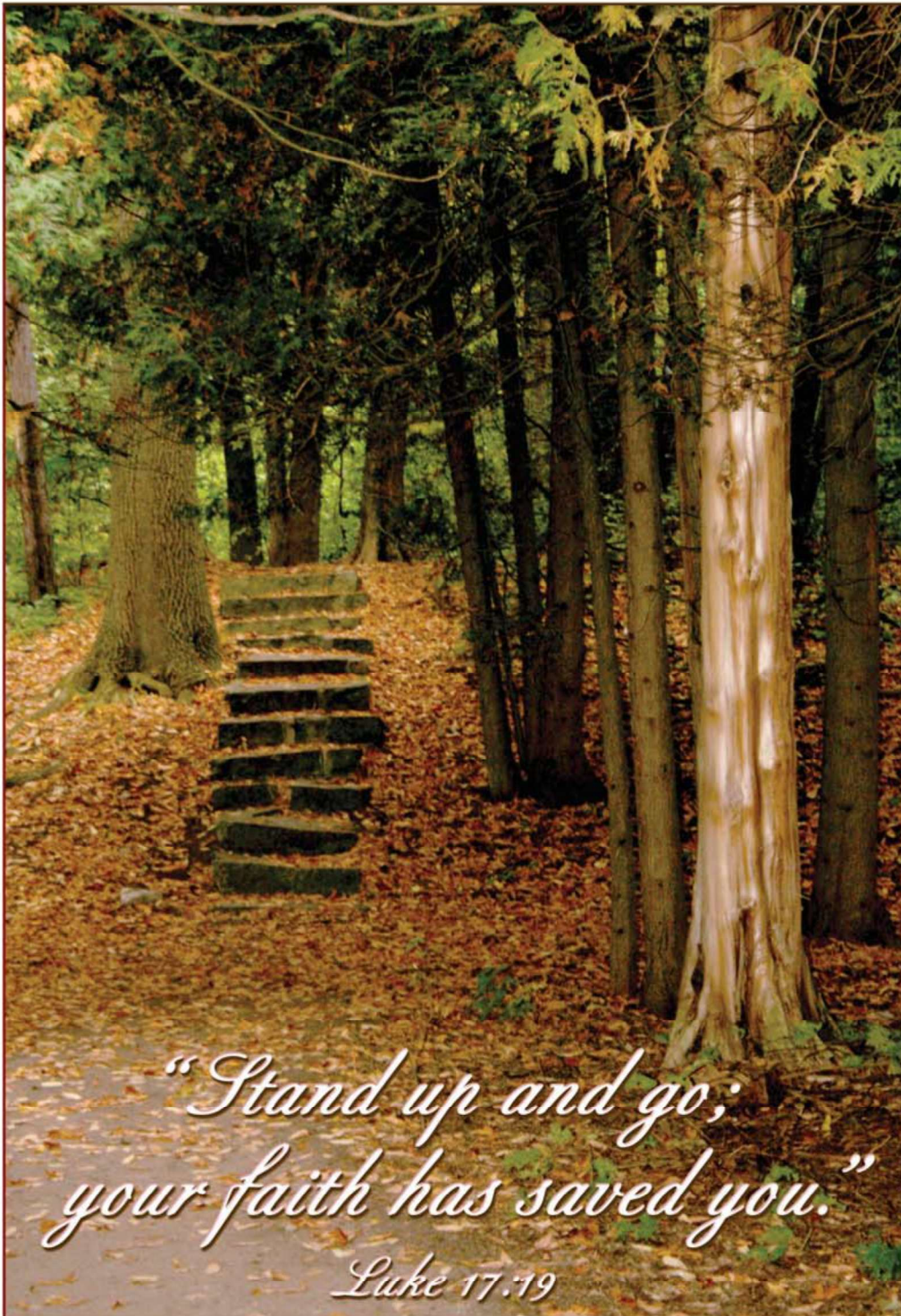

Dear Parishioners of Sacred Heart,

Every once in a while it serves us well as a community to be reminded of church etiquette and common sense tips. The following is in response to many phone calls, emails, texts and conversations that parishioners have had with me about how we treat the sacred space and church grounds.

When using the bathroom please remember to flush and in doing so do not overload it or flush anything that is not toilet paper. This has happened on a number of occasions and it is unacceptable. It makes the efforts of our janitor and parish volunteer all the more difficult. (I have chosen not to show you a photo of what the bathroom looks like after such unfortunate incidents. Yes, staff and parishioners have no qualms about texting me evidence like that.)

The elevator is only for those who are in genuine need such as elderly or people who use crutches, cane, walker or wheelchair. I have noticed several able bodied people making a habit of using it. Please do not overload the lift as the signs indicate.

Finally, only park in designated areas and do not block your fellow parishioners in their spots.

THE ORDER OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION (OCIA)

The Order Of Christian Initiation (OCIA) is a process for those who have been baptized in another denomination or have never been baptized seek to be welcomed into the Catholic Church by being baptized, receive first holy communion and confirmation. Adult Confirmation is recommended for baptized Catholics who have not received this final sacrament of initiation. We offer an opportunity to be fully initiated into the Church following instruction by our OCIA Team and prayerful discernment. Dificulta aún más los esfuerzos de nuestro conserje y voluntario parroquial. (He decidido no mostrarles una foto del aspecto del baño después de estos desafortunados incidentes. Sí, el personal y los feligreses no tienen reparos en enviarme mensajes de texto con pruebas como esa).

El ascensor es solo para quienes tienen una necesidad real, como ancianos o personas que usan muletas, bastón, andador o silla de ruedas. He notado que varias personas sin discapacidades lo usan habitualmente. Por favor, no sobrecargue el ascensor como indican las señales.

Por último, estacione solo en las áreas designadas y no obstruya a los demás feligreses en sus lugares.

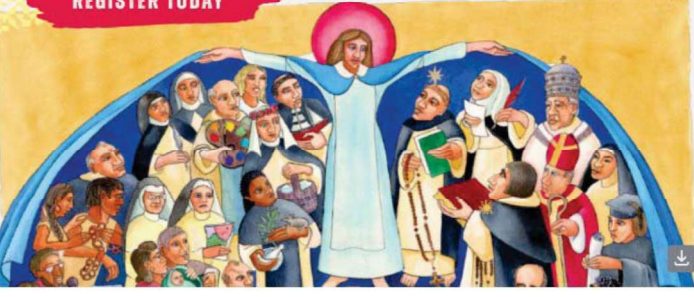

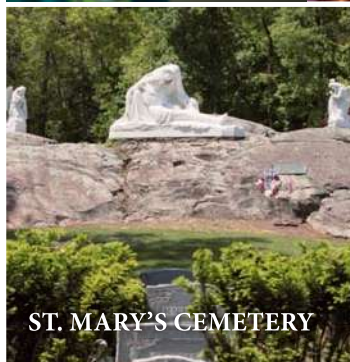
