✠ From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Parishioners of Sacred Heart,

Here are some highlights of the last Pastoral Council meeting which took place on Monday evening October 6th. Following faith sharing and reflections about the Gospel for the 28th Sunday of Ordinary Time, we welcomed three new members who could not attend our first meeting. A handout about how to conduct a "one to one meeting" was handed out, and all members were advised to set up a meeting with another member prior to our next council gathering. This will help our work as a Council, and expanding this to all parishioners, we were able to see our brothers and sisters at a deeper and more personal level.

It was proposed that at all Masses, the offering of the Precious Blood become a regular practice. Once the pandemic regulations ended, parishes were given the option, at the discretion of the Pastor, for the reception of the Precious Blood to return. The Sunday 10:00 am Mass began the practice but, after several months, it was discontinued because of the lack of extraordinary ministers available at the English speaking Masses. The Spanish speaking Masses have many more active volunteers who could serve in this capacity. The recommendation from the Archdiocese is that there should be enough ministers offering holy communion under both species to allow for the Masses not to be unnecessarily prolonged. It was decided that more Eucharistic ministers will be recruited and trained by me (Fr. Clary) by the first Sunday of Advent and to serve at the English speaking Masses. We reached a consensus that any reintroduction should be done during special occasions and then gradually for the Sunday Masses. Because cold, flu and Covid season will soon be returning, now might not be the right time. (As a footnote, please stay home from church if you are feeling ill.) If you are sick, you are not committing a sin by missing Mass.

There was a conversation about the school and the financial condition of the parish. Both boards will be meeting within the next few weeks to share details about their work.

Several members requested that fresh flowers be purchased or donated by parishioners to enhance the beauty of our sacred spaces. A couple of parishioners are willing to undertake this project but more details have to be finalized such as who would be responsible to maintaining the arrangements and what their budget would be.

The next meeting will be Monday November 3rd at 6:30 pm in the Murray Room and it is open to all parishioners to observe our work or to bring a concern to our attention. I am grateful for the guidance and advice they have given me thus far.

Del Escritorio del Párroco ✠

Queridos Parroquianos del Sagrado Corazón,

A continuación, se presentan algunos momentos destacados de la última reunión del Consejo Pastoral, celebrada el lunes 6 de octubre por la noche. Tras compartir la fe y reflexionar sobre el Evangelio del 28.º Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario, dimos la bienvenida a tres nuevos miembros que no pudieron asistir a nuestra primera reunión. Se distribuyó un folleto sobre cómo llevar a cabo una reunión individual y se recomendó a todos los miembros que programaran una reunión con otro miembro antes de nuestra próxima reunión del consejo. Esto facilitará nuestro trabajo como Consejo y, al extenderlo a todos los feligreses, pudimos conocer a nuestros hermanos y hermanas de una manera más profunda y personal.

Se propuso que en todas las Misas, la ofrenda de la Preciosa Sangre se convirtiera en una práctica regular. Una vez finalizadas las regulaciones por la pandemia, se les dio a las parroquias la opción, a discreción del párroco, de que volviera a recibir la Preciosa Sangre. La Misa dominical de las 10:00 a. m. inició esta práctica, pero después de varios meses, se suspendió debido a la falta de ministros extraordinarios disponibles en las Misas en inglés. Las Misas en español cuentan con muchos más voluntarios activos que podrían servir en esta función. La Arquidiócesis recomendó que haya suficientes ministros ofreciendo la sagrada comunión bajo ambas especies para evitar que las Misas se prolonguen innecesariamente. Se decidió que yo (el P. Clary) reclutaré y capacitaré a más ministros Eucarísticos para el primer domingo de Adviento y para que sirvan en las Misas en inglés. Llegamos al consenso de que cualquier reintroducción debería hacerse en ocasiones especiales y luego gradualmente para las Misas dominicales. Dado que la temporada de resfriados, gripe y COVID pronto regresará, este podría no ser el momento adecuado. (Como nota al pie, por favor quédese en casa y no vaya a la iglesia si se siente enfermo). Si está enfermo, no está cometiendo un pecado al faltar a Misa.

Se conversó sobre la escuela y la situación financiera de la parroquia. Ambas juntas se reunirán en las próximas semanas para compartir detalles sobre su trabajo.

Varios miembros solicitaron que los feligreses compraran o donaran flores frescas para realzar la belleza de nuestros espacios sagrados. Un par de feligreses están dispuestos a participar en este proyecto, pero aún faltan detalles, como quién se encargará del mantenimiento de los arreglos y cuál sería su presupuesto.

La próxima reunión será el lunes 3 de noviembre a las 6:30 p.m. en el Salón Murray y está abierta a todos los feligreses para que observen nuestro trabajo o nos planteen alguna inquietud. Agradezco la orientación y los consejos que me han brindado hasta el momento.

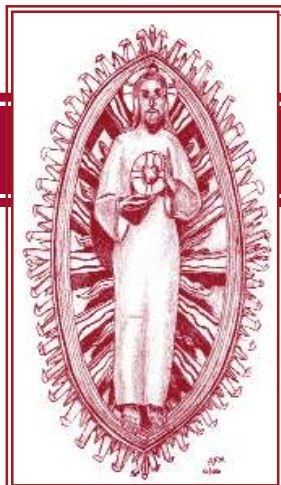

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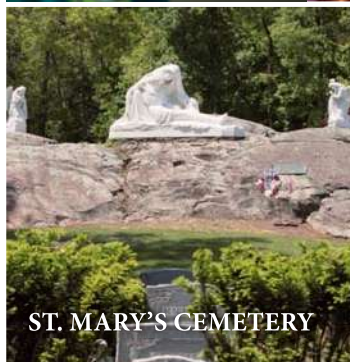
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ST. MARY'S CEMETERY
