Saint Cecilia

Cecilia has been honored as a martyr since about 545. According to a written legend, The Passion of Saint Cecilia, she was a Roman Christian of the patrician class betrothed to the pagan Valerian. The Cecilia Passion has her singing to God in her heart on her wedding day. Cecilia tells Valerian she has made a vow of virginity and persuades him to convert to Christianity and enter into a celibate marriage. His brother, Tiburtius, also becomes a Christian. The brothers are later martyred. When Cecilia refuses to perform an idolatrous act, she too is martyred. Cecilia is the patron of musicians.

Santa Cecilia

Cecilia es honrada como mártir desde el año 545. De acuerdo a la reseña escrita La Pasión de Santa Cecilia, ella fue una cristiana romana proveniente de una familia senatorial y fue la prometida de Valeriano, un joven pagano. La Pasión de Cecilia cuenta que en el día de su boda, en su corazón, ella le cantó a Dios. Cecilia le dice a Valeriano que ella había hecho un juramento de virginidad y lo persuade a convertirse al cristianismo e inician un matrimonio célibe. El hermano de Valeriano, Tiburcio, también se convierte al cristianismo. Más adelante, los dos hermanos fueron martirizados. Cuando Cecilia rehúsa realizar un acto de idolatría, ella también es martirizada. Cecilia es la patrona de los músicos.

As we grow up, we all have those learning moments when things don't go so well or we experience a disappointment or rejection that brings us to tears—and usually to some adult for comfort. Is there a person alive in America who in these moments has not heard, “It's not the end of the world”? In movies, books and our own imagination, we've seen the end of the world a million times. But when does the world really end?

Jesus talks about the end of the world in the Gospels. He knows the Apostles are concerned about it, but He tells them that only the Father knows the day and the hour. In Luke, He describes a scene of great struggle and chaos, events that have occurred time and again in the history of the world. There are TV evangelists who use the Book of Revelation mistakenly to describe something that is to take place soon.

The end of the world is not an event that takes place in history. It is the fulfillment of time when all that we have done is brought to perfection and lifted up to God as our offering to Him. Eternal life begins now, so we are not living in fear of it, but in preparation for it. We need to remain steadfast and confident. God will not abandon us; He will perfect us. All creation will be renewed and restored through Him and with Him and in Him. As the angel says, “Fear not!” God knows what He is doing.

A medida que crecemos, todos tenemos esos momentos de aprendizaje en los que las cosas no salen bien o experimentamos una decepción o un rechazo que nos hace llorar, y generalmente buscamos consuelo en algún adulto. ¿Acaso existe alguien en Estados Unidos que en esos momentos no haya escuchado: «No es el fin del mundo»? En películas, libros y nuestra propia imaginación, hemos visto el fin del mundo millones de veces. Pero ¿cuándo termina realmente el mundo?

Jesús habla del fin del mundo en los Evangelios. Sabe que a los apóstoles les preocupa, pero les dice que solo el Padre sabe el día y la hora. En Lucas, describe una escena de gran lucha y caos, eventos que se han repetido una y otra vez en la historia del mundo. Hay telepredicadores que utilizan erróneamente el Libro del Apocalipsis para describir algo que ocurrirá pronto.

El fin del mundo no es un evento histórico. Es la culminación de los tiempos, cuando todo lo que hemos hecho alcanza la perfección y es elevado a Dios como nuestra ofrenda. La vida eterna comienza ahora, por lo que no vivimos con temor, sino preparándonos para ella. Debemos permanecer firmes y confiados. Dios no nos abandonará; nos perfeccionará. Toda la creación será renovada y restaurada por medio de Él, con Él y en Él. Como dice el ángel: «¡No teman!». Dios sabe lo que hace.

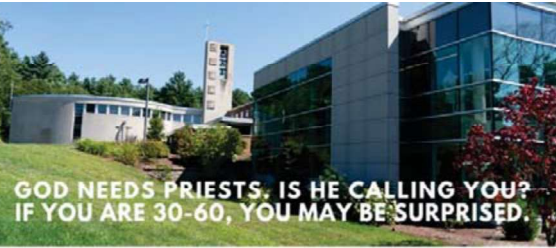

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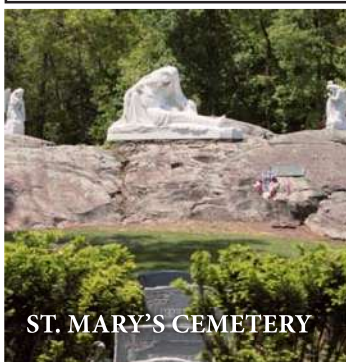
