## ✠ From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Parishioners of Sacred Heart,

It has been said to me many times over the years that “an attitude of gratitude” is one of the key components of a spiritually healthy life. One of the reasons is that it is this flip side of the sin of envy. Sometimes when we look at an other’s life and see how much they have or what they have accomplished we can become trapped with destructive thoughts and attitudes which could even harm a deep relationship. Author Gore Vidal once quipped that “Envy is the central fact of American life” and “Every time a friend succeeds, I die a little.” (Granted, Mr. Vidal had no use for organized religion or belief in God but throughout his lengthy career he had a way with words). One way out is to prepare a gratitude list of those people, circumstances and realities that you have and can be traced to the grace of God. As followers of the Lord it is ingrained within us to engage in because it is the source and summit of our lives. Another name for the Mass is “Eucharist” which is rooted in the Greek word meaning “to give thanks.”

Many of you will be gathering around the Thanksgiving Table this week with family and friends in your home or you may be traveling. Keep within you the grace of the Lord who has blessed you with gifts beyond what you can ask or imagine. And as the mystic Meister Eckhart wrote many centuries ago that if the only prayer someone said to God was “Thank you” that would suffice.

The U. S. Bishops have prepared a lovely prayer for us to make part of this national holiday:

*“Lord we thank you for the goodness of you people and for the spirit of justice that fills this nation. We thank you for the beauty and fullness of the land and the challenge of the cities. We thank you for our work and rest, for one another and for our homes. We thank you Lord: accept our thanksgiving on this day.”*

Queridos Parroquianos del Sagrado Corazón,

A lo largo de los años, me han dicho muchas veces que la gratitud es uno de los pilares de una vida espiritualmente sana. Una de las razones es que representa la otra cara de la moneda del pecado de la envidia. A veces, al observar la vida de otra persona y ver todo lo que tiene o ha logrado, podemos caer en pensamientos y actitudes destructivas que incluso podrían dañar una relación profunda. El autor Gore Vidal comentó en una ocasión que «la envidia es el hecho central de la vida estadounidense» y «cada vez que un amigo triunfa, muero un poco». (Ciertamente, el Sr. Vidal no era partidario de la religión organizada ni creía en Dios, pero a lo largo de su dilatada carrera demostró una gran elocuencia). Una solución es elaborar una lista de gratitud con aquellas personas, circunstancias y realidades que poseemos y que se deben a la gracia de Dios. Como seguidores del Señor, llevamos dentro la responsabilidad de practicarla, pues es la fuente y la culminación de nuestras vidas. Otro nombre para la Misa es «Eucaristía», que proviene del griego y significa «dar gracias».

Muchos de ustedes se reunirán esta semana alrededor de la mesa de Acción de Gracias con familiares y amigos en sus hogares, o tal vez estén de viaje. Mantengan dentro de ustedes la gracia del Señor, quien los ha bendecido con dones que superan todo lo que pueden pedir o imaginar. Y como escribió el místico Meister Eckhart hace muchos siglos, si la única oración que alguien le dirigiera a Dios fuera «Gracias», sería suficiente.

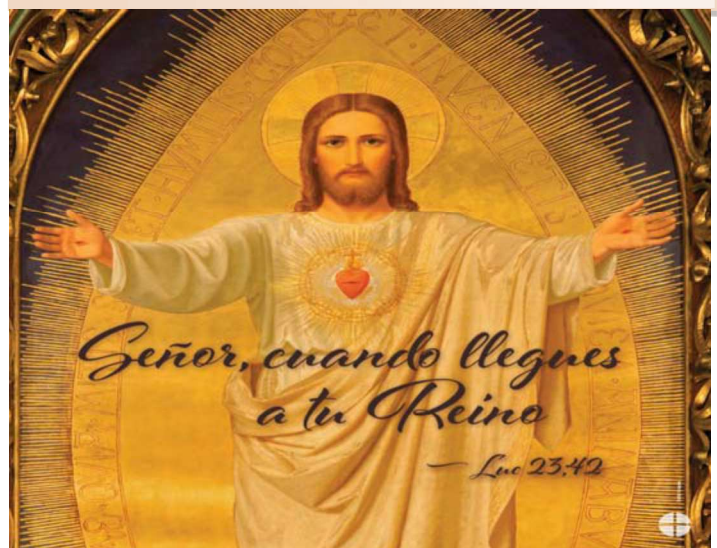
Los obispos de Estados Unidos han preparado una hermosa oración para que la incluyamos en esta festividad nacional:

Fr. Walter Ciszek, a Jesuit priest being promoted for sainthood, spent years in Russia as a political prisoner. In one of his books, "He Leadeth Me," he writes, "There is a tremendous truth contained in the realization that when God became man, He became a working man—not a king nor chieftain, not a warrior or statesmen, nor a great leader of nations." We celebrate Christ the King, not as a political figure or world leader, but as the King of the Cross where the work of salvation takes place. It is a work of love.

Subjects follow their king into battle. We follow Christ into battle with sin and with death. First, He shows us how to live in love as God intends as He teaches, preaches, heals and forgives. Then, through His death, He destroys the power of sin and evil over us and asks us to pick up the cross and follow Him. We honor Him as the crucified King who suffers for our sins and gives us the hope of eternal life.

We serve the Lord and we follow Him. His kingship is one of service, love and humility. He invites rather than commands; he leads rather than directs. He is the Lord, the Savior, the Anointed and the Son of God. He is the victor, ruler and redeemer! But mostly, He is Jesus, our Brother, our King of love and of life.

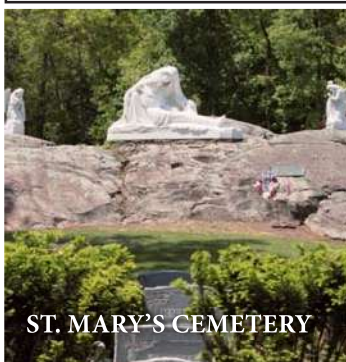
