✠ From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Parishioners of Sacred Heart,

Here are the highlights of the most recent Parish Pastoral Council meeting held on Monday, December 1st.

As the Christmas season approaches there was a concern that I. C. E. is going to be concentrating their efforts on houses of worship to apprehend congregants that fit their criteria for arrest. All parishes have been instructed not to interfere with the work of law enforcement officials. Sacred Heart has made "know your rights" cards and flyers in Spanish, Haitian Creole and English to instruct parishioners what can be done in the event of an interaction with authorities at one's home. The priests have been addressing this from the pulpit and in their conversations with parishioners. The Council also decided to devote an equal amount of discussion and pastoral responses to all other pro-life issues such as care for the unborn, the death penalty and physician assisted suicide.

International crises affecting our brothers and sisters in Nigeria and Haiti among others were discussed including the history behind these conflicts. Having these parts of our world and church community prayed for regularly at Mass would be ongoing. A list of local food resources for those suffering from food insecurity was presented for approval and they will be available at the entrances of the churches and continually updated. The Roslindale Food Pantry is in need of assistance every other Tuesday to help unload and sort donated items. We have not decided to rejoin the Greater Boston Interfaith Organization as of yet. A representative from the GBIO should be invited to a future council meeting to answer more in depth questions. Both the Pastoral and Finance Councils have been invited to a meeting with Archbishop Henning on January 31st. Along with other councils from the area, we will hear what his vision and expectations are for these important advisory groups to the Pastor and for the good of the parish.

A suggestion for all congregants to wear name tags periodically was tabled until the next meeting on January 5th.

Remember that our meetings are open to all parishioners and if you have a matter you would like to have discussed, please let me, Father Succes or another member know. I am grateful for the work that they do and for their honesty and candor.

Saint John of the Cross

A Doctor of the Church, John is also one of its great mystics and poets. Born Juan de Yepes de Alvarez in Spain, he was raised by his mother and entered a Carmelite monastery in 1563. He was ordained in 1567. Finding the Carmelites very lax, he joined with St. Teresa of Avila to reform the order. In 1568, he entered the first reformed house for men, taking the name John of the Cross. He encountered severe opposition and was even imprisoned for nine months in a monastery cell, where he began writing poems. The Dark Night of the Soul is his most famous work. Only after his death was John recognized as co-founder of the Discalced Carmelites. He is the patron saint of mystics and poets.

Del Escritorio del Párroco ✠

Queridos Parroquianos del Sagrado Corazón,

A continuación, se presentan los aspectos más destacados de la última reunión del Consejo Pastoral Parroquial, celebrada el lunes 1 de diciembre.

Con la llegada de la Navidad, existía la preocupación de que el Servicio de Inmigración y Control de Aduanas (ICE) concentrara sus esfuerzos en los lugares de culto para detener a los feligreses que cumplan con los criterios de arresto. Se ha instruido a todas las parroquias a no interferir con la labor de las fuerzas del orden. El Sagrado Corazón ha elaborado tarjetas y folletos de "conozca sus derechos" en español, criollo haitiano e inglés para instruir a los feligreses sobre qué pueden hacer en caso de interacción con las autoridades en su domicilio. Los sacerdotes han abordado este tema desde el púlpito y en sus conversaciones con los feligreses. El Consejo también decidió dedicar la misma cantidad de tiempo a la discusión y a las respuestas pastorales a todos los demás temas provista, como la atención a los no nacidos, la pena de muerte y el suicidio asistido por un médico.

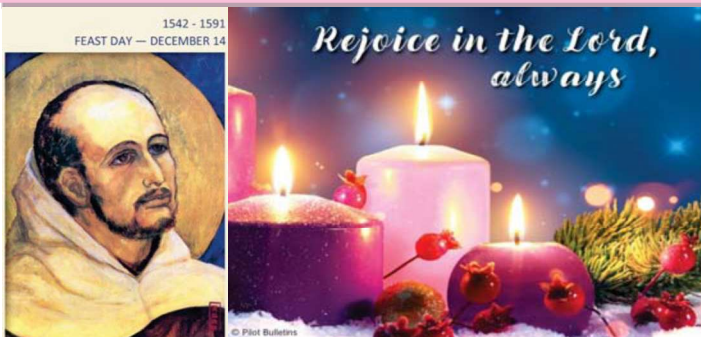
Se discutieron las crisis internacionales que afectan a nuestros hermanos y hermanas en Nigeria y Haití, entre otros, incluyendo la historia detrás de estos conflictos. Se continuará orando por estas partes de nuestro mundo y nuestra comunidad eclesial regularmente durante la misa. Se presentó para aprobación una lista de recursos alimentarios locales para quienes sufren inseguridad alimentaria, la cual estará disponible en las entradas de las iglesias y se actualizará continuamente. La Despensa de Alimentos de Roslindale necesita ayuda cada dos meses para ayudar a descargar y clasificar los artículos donados. Aún no hemos decidido volver a unimos a la Organización Interreligiosa del Gran Boston. Se invitará a un representante de la GBIO a una futura reunión del consejo para responder preguntas más detalladas. Tanto el Consejo Pastoral como el de Finanzas han sido invitados a una reunión con el Arzobispo Henning el 31 de enero. Junto con otros consejos de la zona, escucharemos su visión y expectativas para estos importantes grupos asesores del párroco y para el bien de la parroquia.

Se pospuso la sugerencia de que todos los feligreses usaran etiquetas con su nombre periódicamente hasta la próxima reunión del 5 de enero.

Recuerden que nuestras reuniones están abiertas a todos los feligreses y, si tienen algún tema que les gustaría tratar, por favor, háganmelo saber a mí, al Padre Succes o a otro miembro. Les agradezco su trabajo y su honestidad y franqueza.

GAUDETE SUNDAY

What is special about the Third Sunday of Advent? For much of the Church's history, this Sunday had a special name: "Gaudete" Sunday. The traditions surrounding this Sunday go back as far as the fourth or fifth century, as does the season of Advent itself. Advent, our preparation for Christmas, was originally a forty-day penitential season like Lent. In fact, since it used to begin on November 12 (just after the Memorial of St. Martin of Tours), it was called "St. Martin's Lent." "Gaudete Sunday" was the Advent counterpart to "Laetare Sunday," which marks the midpoint in Lent.

On Gaudete Sunday, the season of Advent shifts its focus. For the first two weeks of Advent, the focus can be summed up in the phrase, "The Lord is coming." But beginning with Gaudete Sunday, the summary might be, "The Lord is near." This shift is

marked by a lighter mood and a heightened sense of joyous anticipation. Liturgically, the colors lighten as well. The priest usually wears rose-colored vestments, a hue seen only on Gaudete Sunday and Laetare Sunday. On this day, we light the third candle of the Advent wreath, which is also rose-colored, or if you prefer, pink.

The word "Gaudete" is Latin for "Rejoice." In times when the focus of our anticipation is often on the negative and fearful, this celebration is a reminder that God who loves us is still in charge and that we await his coming not with fear, but with tremendous joy. Today's Second Reading, from the First Letter of St. Paul to the Thessalonians, reflects this joy: "Brothers and sisters: Rejoice always. Pray without ceasing. In all circumstances give thanks, for this is the will of God for you in Christ Jesus."

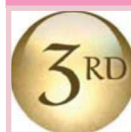

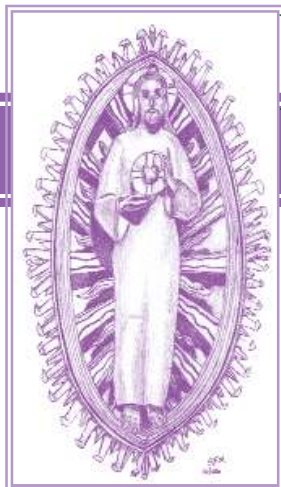

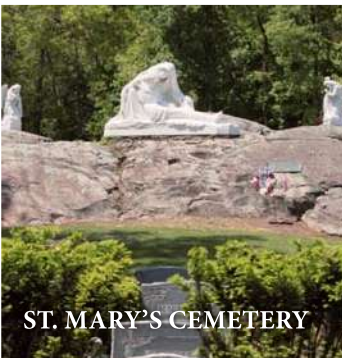
