FROM THE DESK OF FR. JOSHUA

Thank you to all of the parishioners who sent me Christmas cards and generous gifts. It is very humbling for me to receive so much mail after only being in the parishes a short while. You are true instruments of the Lord's kindness. Thank you.

Daily Mass Schedule Changes: Beginning on Thursday, January 15th, Confessions will be at 4:30 PM with Mass at 5:15 PM at **St. Leo's** and on Friday Confessions will be at 11:00 AM with Mass at 12:00 PM at **St. Catherine's**. Moving forward, this change will allow me to be in Pipestone in the evenings on Thursdays to meet with parishioners and others that I am not able to meet on Wednesdays or Fridays. The Tuesday and Wednesday Confession, Adoration, and Mass schedules will remain the same.

I will be instituting the First Friday devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus on the first Friday of every month (starting February 6th). This will consist in a holy hour in the main Church with Eucharistic Adoration and Benediction after Mass at St. Catherine's. It will include the Litany of the Sacred Heart and the Act of Reparation to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. This devotion is very appropriate for us this year because the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops has decided to consecrate our country

to the Sacred Heart of Jesus on the 250th anniversary of our country. This devotion was given by Our Lord Jesus to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque, a religious sister of the order of the Visitation of Our Lady in Burgundy, France in 1673 with the specific purpose to make reparation for sins against the Blessed Sacrament.

Lastly, I would like to ask you all to continue to pray for me and for the priests and seminarians of our diocese. Recently, a pastor of two parishes in our diocese was granted a personal leave of absence for an undetermined period of time. As I write this, I am packing for another trip to Ohio for Army Reserve duty and I will be gone again later this month to support my soldiers at a memorial ceremony for a soldier who died in December. "The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few; pray therefore the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into his harvest." (Mt 9:37-38 and Lk 10:2) There is no substitute for the Sacraments and the need is great. Please implore the Lord in His Mercy to raise up many holy men from among our parishes and our families to give their lives in service to God and His Holy Church. Know that you are in my prayers. I know I am in yours.

Gracias a todos los feligreses que me enviaron tarjetas navideñas y generosos regalos. Me siento muy honrado por haber recibido tanto correo después de llevar tan poco tiempo en las parroquias. Sois verdaderos instrumentos de la bondad del Señor. Gracias.

Cambios en el horario diario de misa: A partir del jueves 15 de enero, las confesiones serán a las 4:30 p. m. y la misa a las 5:15 p. m. en St. Leo's, y los viernes las confesiones serán a las 11:00 a. m. y la misa a las 12:00 p. m. en St. Catherine's. En adelante, este cambio me permitirá estar en Pipestone los jueves por la tarde para reunirme con los feligreses y otras personas con las que no puedo reunirme los miércoles o los viernes. Los horarios de confesión, adoración y misa de los martes y miércoles seguirán siendo los mismos.

Instituiré la devoción del primer viernes al Sagrado Corazón de Jesús el primer viernes de cada mes (a partir del 6 de febrero). Consistirá en una hora santa en la iglesia principal con adoración eucarística y bendición después de la misa en Santa Catalina. Incluirá la letanía del Sagrado Corazón y el acto de reparación al Sagrado Corazón de Jesús. Esta devoción es muy apropiada para nosotros este año porque la Conferencia de Obispos Católicos de los Estados Unidos ha decidido consagrar nuestro país al Sagrado

Corazón de Jesús en el 250 aniversario de nuestra nación. Esta devoción fue dada por Nuestro Señor Jesús a Santa Margarita María Alacoque, una religiosa de la orden de la Visitación de Nuestra Señora en Borgoña, Francia, en 1673, con el propósito específico de reparar los pecados contra el Santísimo Sacramento.

Por último, me gustaría pedirles a todos que sigan rezando por mí y por los sacerdotes y seminaristas de nuestra diócesis. Recientemente, a un párroco de dos parroquias de nuestra diócesis se le concedió una licencia personal por un período de tiempo indeterminado. Mientras escribo esto, estoy haciendo las maletas para otro viaje a Ohio para cumplir con mi servicio en la Reserva del Ejército y volveré a ausentarme a finales de este mes para apoyar a mis soldados en una ceremonia conmemorativa por un soldado que falleció en diciembre. «La mies es mucha, pero los obreros pocos; rogad, pues, al Señor de la mies que envíe obreros a su mies» (Mt 9, 37-38 y Lc 10, 2). No hay sustituto para los sacramentos y la necesidad es grande. Imploren al Señor en su misericordia que levante a muchos hombres santos de entre nuestras parroquias y nuestras familias para que den su vida al servicio de Dios y de su Santa Iglesia. Sepan que están en mis oraciones. Sé que yo estoy en las suyas. -P. Joshua

This cost covers the retreat itself, food and lodging. You would be responsible for your own transportation to and from Jackson.

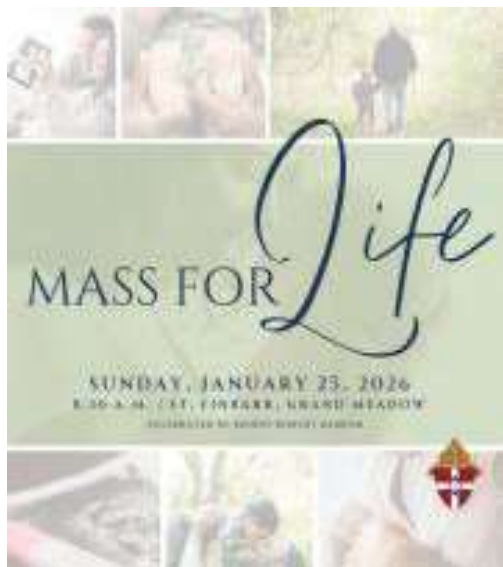
