# FROM THE DESK OF FR. JOSHUA

This week will mark the 53rd anniversary of the Supreme Court decision Roe vs. Wade (1973). This decision resulted in children having no recourse to the law when they are murdered in the womb by their mothers. Since 1973, over 60 million children in utero have been slain in the United States. **On Thursday, January 22nd, all dioceses in the United States** shall observe “a day of prayer for the full restoration of the legal guarantee of the right to life and of penance for violations to the dignity of the human person committed through acts of abortions (General Instruction for the Roman Missal, no. 373). I ask that all parishioners of St. Catherine and St. Leo parishes observe this directive by offering this prayer on Thursday:

*O Jesus, you came that we might have life—and have it in abundance. Together with the Father and the Holy Spirit, you form us in our mothers' wombs and call us to love you for all eternity.*

*As your most precious gift of human life is attacked, draw us ever closer to your Real Presence in the Eucharist. Dispel the darkness of the culture of death, for you are the light that shines in the darkness, and the darkness cannot overcome it.*

*By the power of your Eucharistic Presence, help us to de-*

*fend the life of every human person at every stage. Transform our hearts to protect and cherish all whose lives are most vulnerable.*

*For you are God, forever and ever. Amen. (USCCB, 2024)*

## **DEL ESCRITORIO DEL PR. JOSHUA...**

Esta semana se cumplirá el 53.<sup>o</sup> aniversario de la sentencia del Tribunal Supremo en el caso Roe contra Wade (1973). Esta sentencia tuvo como consecuencia que los niños no tuvieran recurso alguno ante la ley cuando eran asesinados en el útero por sus madres. Desde 1973, más de 60 millones de niños han sido asesinados en el útero en Estados Unidos. **El jueves 22 de enero, todas las diócesis de Estados Unidos observarán** «un día de oración por la plena restauración de la garantía legal del derecho a la vida y de penitencia por las violaciones a la dignidad de la persona humana cometidas a través de actos de aborto» (Instrucción General del Misal Romano, n.<sup>o</sup> 373). Pido a todos los feligreses de las parroquias de Santa Catalina y San León que observen esta directiva ofreciendo esta oración el jueves:

*Oh Jesús, tú viniste para que tuviéramos vida, y la tuviéramos en abundancia. Junto con el Padre y el Espíritu Santo, tú nos formas en el seno de nuestras madres y nos llamas a amarte por toda la eternidad.*

*Cuando tu don más preciado, la vida humana, es atacado, acércanos cada vez más a tu presencia real en la Eucaristía. Dispela las tinieblas de la cultura de la muerte, porque tú eres la luz que brilla en las tinieblas, y las tinieblas no pueden vencerla.*

*Por el poder de tu Presencia Eucarística, ayúdanos a de-*

*fender la vida de cada persona humana en todas las etapas. Transforma nuestros corazones para proteger y apreciar a todos aquellos cuyas vidas son más vulnerables.*

*Porque tú eres Dios, por los siglos de los siglos. Amén. (USCCB, 2024)*


