Presently we have twenty-six some seminarians studying for our Diocese at different levels of their education. We are fortunate to have a College seminary in our own diocese, called the Immaculate Heart

of Mary Seminary. That is where the majority of us started our seminary training and education. It sits on the campus of St. Mary University, Winona, MN. It was started in the early part of the nineteenth century by then Bishop Patrick Heffron. He had the foresight of knowing the importance of having a seminary that would educate future priests for our diocese. After

studying at our college seminary, then the seminarians will go on to a School of Theology, a seminary sent to by our bishop. We have one in the Twin Cities called St. Paul Seminary. There are many other Schools of Theology in our country and throughout the world. May we pray for our seminarians and that more will hear the call from Jesus to "Come and follow Me!"


