

Kosse's generosity, I was able to join over 60 young men from the dioceses of Crookston, Madison, Milwaukee, Lacrosse, and Winona-Rochester as they came to visit the Immaculate Heart of Mary Seminary at St. Mary's University in Winona, MN. The agenda included praying the Liturgy of the Hours as a community, Holy Hours with **Eucharistic Adoration and Confessions**, Official Admissions presentations and tours, meals at the university cafeteria, meals in the seminary dining room, watching the Vikings in the rec room,





open gym, an SMU basketball game, SMU club hockey game, Vocation stories with Q and A, and of course the opportunity to attend classes with the seminarians. It was a full weekend and very encouraging to see so many young men pursuing virtue and holiness and seriously considering that God may be calling them to the Holy Priesthood. Please continue to pray for our seminarians to joyfully give their YES to the Lord and His People.

Parish Directory: members of both parish councils will meet with me in January to finalize the plan to create the new parish directory. The goal is to begin taking photos on June 1st. As a part of this project, there will be a deliberate effort to evangelize our parishioners and update our parish records by contacting every registered parishioner. St. Catherine: In light of the challenges to coordinate consistent Adorers for Solemn Exposition during the week, there will be Solemn Exposition in the main church for one hour before Mass at St. Catherine's on Tuesdays (barring funerals, etc).

On Thursday, November 20th I will have met with the Diocesan College of Consultors to request approval for our Doyle Hall Kitchen Remodel Project. As of right this writing, we are still short of our fundraising goal. In consultation with the Finance Council, I have decided to move forward with this project and use the unrestricted earnings from an endowment fund that we have to make up the difference. I expect construction to begin in the first week of Advent.

St. Leo: As I announced two weeks ago, Nicole Henrichs has agreed to become the full-time Faith Formation Director for both St. Catherine and St. Leo Parishes. She has begun integrating with the St. Leo Faith Formation Program and she will be keeping office hours at St. Leo's on Tuesdays and Fridays.

ST. LEO'S FIRST RECONCILIATION: Due to a scheduling conflict, we have rescheduled the Sacrament of First Reconciliation at St. Leo. It will now be held Wednesday, January 21. Students will come to Wednesday class at their normal time with their parent/trusted adult to do the learning stations with their First Reconciliation to follow.

BECOME (GS CERTIFIED: The Catechesis of the Good Shepherd is a Montessori-based religious formation program for children. CGS is currently offered at St Catherine for ages 3 through kindergarten and will soon also be offered at St Leo. It seeks to create and facilitate a sacred, "hands-on" space for children called an atrium, in which both the children and their catechists can hear, ponder, and celebrate the most essential mysteries of the Catholic faith as revealed in the Scriptures and the Liturgy. Training for Catechesis of the Good Shepherd atrium training for "level 1 part a" is going to be offered next summer in Lakefield, MN. This is a fantastic opportunity for anyone interested in learning the CGS program and growing personally in their faith. Training for "part a" will be Fri - Sun June 5-7 and June 12-14. Each "part a" and "part b" consist of a 6 day training, part b will be next fall (hoping for 3 - two day weekends). It would be amazing if we could have a few more folks trained in our CGS program, which would allow us to grow the program and possibly expand it to older grades! THE MANTLE: The Mantle is a new monthly gathering for 9th -12th grade youth aimed at helping to form and strengthen personal prayer through instruction, testimony, small group mentorship, and prayer. The Mantle seeks to build and reinforce a diocesan community of high school teens across parish boundaries, one that encourages Christ-centered friendship and a true living of the faith in day-to-day life. We have seen great conversion and connection through Steubenville, Camp Summit, Totus Tuus and other programs; The Mantle aims to keep that fire burning throughout the school year. We will meet one Sunday afternoon each month at St. Peter and Paul's in Blue Earth. High school students who have a desire to make prayer a part of their daily life, who want virtuous friendships, and who can actively engage in sharing their faith with others are encouraged to come and participate. Students who participate will be asked to commit to daily prayer and to attending weekly Mass.
