

FROM THE DESK OF FR. JOSHUA

The new liturgical year has begun with the season of Advent. The term Advent comes from the Latin word advenire: 'ad' which means 'to' and 'venire' which means 'come.' Advent is a time when we anticipate the coming of the Lord. Specifically, we remember the centuries before Jesus was born. All of creation anticipated with bated breath the coming of the Savior. The mystery of the Incarnation, the supreme act of God coming to dwell among his creatures, began at the Annunciation in Mary's womb and manifested fully in the birth of the Christ Child at Christmas. While it is difficult for us in the Year of Our Lord 2025 to imagine a world where Jesus has not been born, we can increase our love, devotion, and gratitude for the gift of Jesus by remembering the time before He walked among us and gave us His very self.

Advent Penance Services: On Wednesday, December 3rd, at St. Leo's Adoration and Confessions will begin at 11 AM, Mass will be at 12 PM, and the St. Catherine Advent Penance Service will be from 3:30-5:00 PM and 6:30-8:00 PM. On Wednesday, December 17th, St. Leo's Adoration and Confessions will begin at 2 PM, Mass will be at 3 PM, and the St. Leo's Advent Penance Service will begin at 5:30 PM and go until 7:30 PM. Monsignors Kosse and Colletti will be assisting with Confessions.

I will be away for Army Reserve Duty 6-7 December. Msgr. Kosse will be offering the Masses while I am gone, including the anticipatory Mass for the Immaculate Conception at 6 PM on Sunday December 7th at St. Leo's.

Both the St. Leo and the St. Catherine Finance Councils are looking for new members to serve on the Finance Councils for a term of three years. Candidates

should be "members of the Christian Faithful of outstanding integrity and honesty who are actively involved in the life of the parish. They are to be skilled in financial affairs or civil law as evidenced by their professional qualifications and testimonials and are to be capable of evaluating financial options while having the highest regard for Christian principles and values and the mission of the diocese and the parish" (Diocese of Winona-Rochester Statues for Parish Governance 16-21). Interested parishioners should speak with a current finance council member if they have questions and/or are interested in sharing their time and talents with the Church.

St. Catherine: On Friday the contents of the Doyle Hall Kitchen were removed in preparation for the remodel construction work to begin. All activities in the Doyle Hall are suspended until further notice.

With the season of Advent upon us also comes winter weather. Please be cautious when coming into the Church and watch for patches of ice. Our staff does their best to keep the walkways clear of ice and snow but caution is still warranted. If there is inclement weather on a weekend when the driving conditions are unsafe, especially for our parishioners who travel many miles on country roads to come to Mass, prudence dictates that you should not endanger yourself to come to Mass. If the winter weather advisory advises against driving during Mass times, rural parishioners are dispensed from their obligation to attend Sunday Mass. This is not to be abused, but for those who truly are at risk of ending up in the ditch during white-out conditions. *-Fr. Joshua*



BECOME (GS CERTIFIED: The Catechesis of the Good Shepherd is a Montessori-based religious formation program for children. CGS is currently offered at St Catherine for ages 3 through kindergarten and will soon also be offered at St Leo. It seeks to create and facilitate a sacred, "hands-on" space for children called an atrium, in which both the children and their catechists can hear, ponder, and celebrate the most essential mysteries of the Catholic faith as revealed in the Scriptures and the Liturgy. Training for Catechesis of the Good Shepherd atrium training for "level 1 part a" is going to be offered next summer in Lakefield, MN. This is a fantastic opportunity for anyone interested in learning the CGS program and growing personally in their faith. Training for "part a" will be Fri - Sun June 5-7 and June 12-14. Each "part a" and "part b" consist of a 6 day training, part b will be next fall (hoping for 3 - two day weekends). It would be amazing if we could have a few more folks trained in our CGS program, which would allow us to grow the program and possibly expand it to older grades! 
