FROM THE DESK OF FR. JOSHUA

Next week and the following week are the Solemnity of the Nativity of the Lord (Christmas, December 25th) and the Solemnity of Mary, The Holy Mother of God (January 1st). These are Holy Days of Obligation for all Catholics. See the liturgical schedule for the Mass times and locations.

This past week I finally was able to conduct training with our Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion. This training was for the parishioners that assist myself and Deacon Kevin with distributing Holy Communion during Mass as well as all of the parishioners that volunteer to bring Holy Communion to Catholics that are not able to attend Mass in person.

As a reminder, Catholics who are not physically or medically capable of attending Mass in person are dispensed from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass. God does not command the impossible. It is a very good and holy desire to attend Sunday Mass to worship God and pray with the community of Faith, but it is not required for salvation if a person is physically incapable of being present. Also, the Church requires Catholics to receive the Eucharist in Holy Communion once per year during the Easter Season. All Catholics are encouraged to receive Holy Communion frequently, but it is not a requirement to receive Holy Communion to fulfill the Sunday obligation. The Sunday obligation is fulfilled by attending/assisting/praying at the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. Receiving Holy Communion is highly encouraged for all who are properly disposed, but it is not a requirement to meet the obligation.

I am very grateful to all our parishioners who volunteer to bring Holy Communion to Catholics who are unable to attend Mass. This is a very holy

act of charity and generosity and brings great merit to their souls and the souls that they minister to. If you are interested in becoming an Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion to bring Holy Communion to the sick, elderly, and/or homebound please give your name and contact information to the parish office and I will contact you when we do another training. I know that not everyone was able to attend the training this week and I will schedule another training after the new year.

St. Leo: As I am sure you have seen, the Stations of the Cross have been moved to a more prominent location in the church. I made the decision to move them to the new location so that when we have the devotion of the Stations of the Cross as a community, particularly during Lent, everyone will be able to see them while sitting in the pews. In the previous location, they could not be seen because there is a wall behind the sanctuary that blocked the view for multiple stations.

St. Catherine: As I am sure you have seen, I decided to move the video monitor that was obstructing the view of the statue of the Sacred Heart in the front entryway of the church. Due to the new location of the monitor, which would obscure the painting of Our Lady Undoer of Knots I decided to move the painting of Our Lady to the wall above the drinking fountains where previously the collection of Fr. Tom Jennings' crosses were. If any parishioner would like to personally have one of the crosses in remembrance of Fr. Tom Jennings, they may have one. The crosses are in the parish office.

As always, you are in my prayers during this holy season as we patiently await the birth of Our Lord and Savior. I know I am in yours. -Fr. Joshua

IGLESIA CATOLICA DE SAN LEO

DEL ESCRITORIO DEL PR. JOSHUA...

La próxima semana y la siguiente son la Solemnidad de la Natividad del Señor (Navidad, 25 de diciembre) y la Solemnidad de María, Santa Madre de Dios (1 de enero). Son días de precepto para todos los católicos. Consulten el calendario litúrgico para conocer los horarios y lugares de las misas.

La semana pasada por fin pude impartir formación a nuestros ministros extraordinarios de la Sagrada Comunión. Esta formación estaba dirigida a los feligreses que nos ayudan al diácono Kevin y a mí a distribuir la Sagrada Comunión durante la misa, así como a todos los feligreses que se ofrecen como voluntarios para llevar la Sagrada Comunión a los católicos que no pueden asistir a misa en persona.

Como recordatorio, los católicos que no pueden asistir físicamente o por motivos médicos a la misa en persona están dispensados de la obligación de asistir a la misa dominical. Dios no exige lo imposible. Es un deseo muy bueno y santo asistir a la misa dominical para adorar a Dios y rezar con la comunidad de fe, pero no es necesario para la salvación si una persona es físicamente incapaz de estar presente. Además, la Iglesia exige a los católicos que reciban la Eucaristía en la Santa Comunión una vez al año durante el tiempo de Pascua. Se anima a todos los católicos a recibir la Sagrada Comunión con frecuencia, pero no es un requisito para cumplir con la obligación dominical. La obligación dominical se cumple asistiendo/participando/orando en el Santo Sacrificio de la Misa, y se recomienda encarecidamente recibir la Sagrada Comunión a todos los que estén debidamente dispuestos, pero no es un requisito para cumplir con la obligación.

Estoy muy agradecido a todos nuestros feligreses que se ofrecen como voluntarios para llevar la Sagrada Comunión a los católicos que no pueden asistir a misa. Se trata de un acto muy santo de caridad y generosidad que

aporta un gran mérito a sus almas y a las almas a las que atienden. Si está interesado en convertirse en ministro extraordinario de la Sagrada Comunión para llevarla a los enfermos, ancianos y/o personas confinadas en sus hogares, por favor dé su nombre e información de contacto a la oficina parroquial y me pondré en contacto con usted cuando hagamos otra formación. Sé que no todos pudieron asistir a la formación esta semana y programaré otra después de Año Nuevo.

San Leo: Como seguramente habrán visto, las Estaciones del Vía Crucis se han trasladado a un lugar más destacado de la iglesia. Tomé la decisión de trasladarlas a la nueva ubicación para que, cuando realicemos la devoción del Vía Crucis como comunidad, especialmente durante la Cuaresma, todos puedan verlas mientras están sentados en los bancos. En la ubicación anterior, no se podían ver porque hay una pared detrás del santuario que bloqueaba la vista de varias estaciones.

Santa Catalina: Como seguramente habrán visto, he decidido mover el monitor de vídeo que obstaculizaba la vista de la estatua del Sagrado Corazón en la entrada principal de la iglesia. Debido a la nueva ubicación del monitor, que ocultaría el cuadro de Nuestra Señora Desatadora de Nudos, he decidido trasladar el cuadro de Nuestra Señora a la pared situada encima de las fuentes de agua potable, donde antes se encontraba la colección de cruces del padre Tom Jennings. Si algún feligrés desea quedarse con una de las cruces en recuerdo del padre Tom Jennings, puede hacerlo. Las cruces se encuentran en la oficina parroquial.

Como siempre, los tengo presentes en mis oraciones durante esta temporada sagrada, mientras esperamos pacientemente el nacimiento de Nuestro Señor y Salvador. Sé que ustedes también me tienen presente en las suyas.

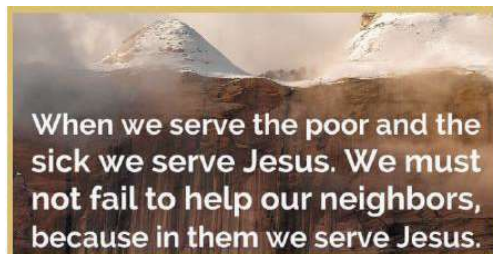

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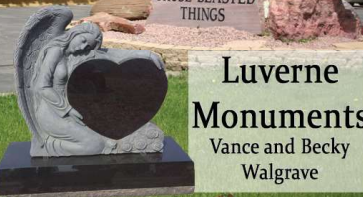
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
