

FROM THE DESK OF FR. JOSHUA

Last week the phone system was upgraded for both parishes. Please be patient as we continue to refine our communications processes. One of the changes is that now the pastor has a direct number that is the same for both parishes. My direct phone number is (507) 283-3663.

If you or a loved one becomes sick enough to be admitted to the hospital, please call me promptly for the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick. I cannot give the Sacraments to people that I do not know about. Previously, the Sacrament known as "Last Rites" was reserved specifically for those who were imminently going to die. Since the reforms of the Second Vatican Council, the new rite of the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is not restricted to only those about to die, but for anyone who is seriously ill or in need of physical and/or spiritual healing.

I encourage everyone to participate in the prayers and traditions of the Church during the penitential season of Lent. I will be praying the Roman Stations of the Cross on Fridays at each parish in conjunction with the Knights of Columbus Fish Fry Dinners. Stations will begin at 5:15

PM. See the Liturgical Schedule for the exact dates.

There will also be additional opportunities for the Sacrament of Confession during Lent. The Lenten Penance Services will be March 18th at St. Catherine's and March 25th at St. Leo's. I will also be adding additional confession times in the evenings, watch the liturgical schedule for exact dates.

March 6th will be the next First Friday. The First Friday Devotion consists of Solemn Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament for one hour and the praying of the Litany of the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Act of Reparation for sins against the Blessed Sacrament. I encourage any Catholic who is interested in growing in their faith to come and participate in this very edifying devotion.

There is also an interest in expanding the number of hours of Eucharistic Adoration at St. Leo's. If you are interested and/or willing to commit to "watch for an hour" with the Lord, please see the sign-up sheet in the gathering space of St. Leo's and/or contact Ann Full.

La semana pasada se actualizó el sistema telefónico de ambas parroquias. Les pedimos paciencia mientras seguimos perfeccionando nuestros procesos de comunicación. Si usted o un ser querido se enferman lo suficiente como para ser ingresados en el hospital, por favor llámeme de inmediato para recibir el Sacramento de la Unción de los Enfermos. No puedo administrar los sacramentos a personas que no conozco. Anteriormente, el sacramento conocido como «últimos ritos» estaba reservado específicamente para aquellos que estaban a punto de morir. Desde las reformas del Concilio Vaticano II, el nuevo rito del sacramento de la Unción de los Enfermos no se limita solo a aquellos que están a punto de morir, sino a cualquier persona que esté gravemente enferma o necesite curación física y/o espiritual.

Animo a todos a participar en las oraciones y tradiciones de la Iglesia durante el tiempo penitencial de Cuaresma. Rezaré el Vía Crucis romano los viernes en cada parroquia, junto con las cenas de pescado frito de los Caballeros de Colón. El Vía Crucis comenzará a las 5:15 p.

m. Consulte el calendario litúrgico para conocer las fechas exactas.

También habrá oportunidades adicionales para el sacramento de la confesión durante la Cuaresma. Habrá servicios de penitencia cuaresmal el 18 de marzo en St. Catherine's y el 25 en St. Leo's. También añadiré horarios adicionales para la confesión por las tardes; consulte el calendario litúrgico para conocer las fechas exactas.

El 6 de marzo será el próximo primer viernes. La devoción del primer viernes consiste en la exposición solemne del Santísimo Sacramento durante una hora y la recitación de la letanía del Sagrado Corazón de Jesús y el acto de reparación por los pecados contra el Santísimo Sacramento. Animo a todos los católicos interesados en crecer en su fe a que vengan y participen en esta devoción tan edificante.

También hay interés en ampliar el número de horas de adoración eucarística en St. Leo's. Every Friday of the year, and not only the Fri-days in Lent, is a special day of penance as stipulated in the Code of Canon Law: "The penitential days and times in the universal Church are every Friday of the whole year and the season of Lent" (Canon 1250).

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION: Just a reminder that Fr. Joshua is in the confessional Wednesdays from 11:30 AM—12:00 PM and Thursday afternoons from 4:30-5:00 PM (prior to 5:15 PM Mass). The candles will be lit outside the confessional to signify that Fr. is in. Please take the Act of Contrition plaque from the door into the confessional with you to indicate to others that the confessional is occupied and replace it back in the slot upon exiting.







REGISTRATION FOR STEUBENVILLE CONFERENCE 2026 IS NOW OPEN: Steubenville is a three day Youth Conference for Catholics students currently in grades 8 – 12 that is held in Rochester, MN. This year the conference will be July 10 -12, 2026. In addition to three days of amazing speakers, teens will have opportunities for worship, adoration, and confession, while enjoying fellowship with hundreds of other teens who share the same Catholic faith. Cost per person is \$500 (if registered by May 1) and includes: Transportation to and from Conference, Conference Registration/Admission, Hotel for 2 Nights (Fri & Sat), Continental Breakfast at the Hotel, Meals during Conference, Conference T-shirt. We are working on getting fundraising and scholarship opportunities in place to help offset this cost for participants. 


