

FROM THE DESK OF FR. JOSHUA

Spanish Mass: After a prayerful discernment and in consultation with the Diocesan Director of Hispanic Ministry, I have decided to discontinue offering regular Sunday Mass in Spanish at St. Leo Parish in Pipestone. While my current schedule is demanding due to my responsibilities with two parishes and the military, the primary reason for this decision is to support the spiritual growth of our children and young people. Since Faith Formation is taught in English, I believe it is fundamental for our youth to experience the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass in the same language in which they are learning their faith. If there are parishioners willing to help me with planning the liturgy, I will offer the Mass in Spanish at Easter, Christmas, and on the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe. I will offer Baptisms in Spanish by special request. There will continue to be Spanish Mis-salettes available for use during Masses at both St. Catherine and St. Leo Parishes.

Diocesan Priest Retreat: This week all the priests of the Diocese of Winona-Rochester will be on retreat with

+Bishop Barron. There will be no Confessions or Masses from 9 to 13 February. Msgr. Kosse will be gone as well. 


