

FROM THE DESK OF FR. JOSHUA ...

As you read this, I will be at the Immaculate Heart of Mary (IHM) Seminary in Winona with several young men from our parish. IHM is the seminary for the Diocese of Winona-Rochester that is located on the campus of St. Mary's University in Winona. This is a minor (undergraduate) seminary where the men study philosophy and other coursework prior to moving on to major theology studies. They live in separate housing from the rest of the students and have additional classes and conferences with the seminary formation staff as well as daily liturgies in the chapel.

As we continue marching through the purification of Lent toward the Cross, I will be offering additional opportunities for the Sacrament of Penance (also known as Confession/Reconciliation). Pamphlets about how to prepare for Confession and Examinations of Conscience can be found in the gathering space near the bulletin boards. Also, on a practical note, for both parishes, the wooden block with the Act of Contrition is no longer in use. If the door to the confessional is open, that means there is no one inside and you can come in. If the door is closed, that means there is someone inside confessing their sins and receiving the Lord's Mercy.

As many people have noticed at St. Catherine, the old confessional that was gathering dust in the corner has been restored and will begin being used this week. Please continue to pray for me to catch "big fish" in the confessional.

DEL ESCRITORIO DEL PR. JOSHUA...

Mientras leen esto, estaré en el Seminario del Inmaculado Corazón de María (IHM) en Winona con varios jóvenes de nuestra parroquia. El IHM es el seminario de la Diócesis de Winona-Rochester, ubicado en el campus de la Universidad St. Mary's en Winona. Se trata de un seminario menor (de grado) en el que los jóvenes estudian filosofía y otras materias antes de pasar a los estudios superiores de teología. Viven en alojamientos separados del resto de los estudiantes y tienen clases y conferencias adicionales con el personal de formación del seminario, así como liturgias diarias en la capilla.

A medida que continuamos avanzando en la purificación de la Cuaresma hacia la Cruz, ofreceré oportunidades adicionales para el Sacramento de la Penitencia (también conocido como Confesión/Reconciliación). En el área de reunión, cerca de los tableros de anuncios, se pueden encontrar folletos sobre cómo prepararse para la Confesión y los Exámenes de Conciencia. Además, en cuanto a aspectos prácticos, en ambas parroquias ya no se utiliza el bloque de madera con el Acto de Contrición. Si la puerta del confesionario está abierta, significa que no hay nadie dentro y que pueden entrar. Si la puerta está cerrada, significa que hay alguien dentro confesando sus pecados y recibiendo la misericordia del Señor. Como muchos han notado en Santa Catalina, el antiguo confesionario que

acumulaba polvo en un rincón ha sido restaurado y comenzará a utilizarse esta semana. Por favor, sigan rezando por mí para que pueda pescar «peces gordos» en el confesionario.


OFFERTORY ENVELOPES: If you have not picked up your envelopes, please stop at the office as we have taken them off the tables in the concourse area.

REGISTRATION FOR STEUBENVILLE CONFERENCE 2026 IS NOW OPEN: Steubenville is a three day Youth Conference for Catholic students currently in grades 8 - 12 that is held in Rochester, MN. This year the conference will be July 10 -12, 2026. In addition to three days of amazing speakers, teens will have opportunities for worship, adoration, and confession, while enjoying fellowship with hundreds of other teens who share the same Catholic faith. 


