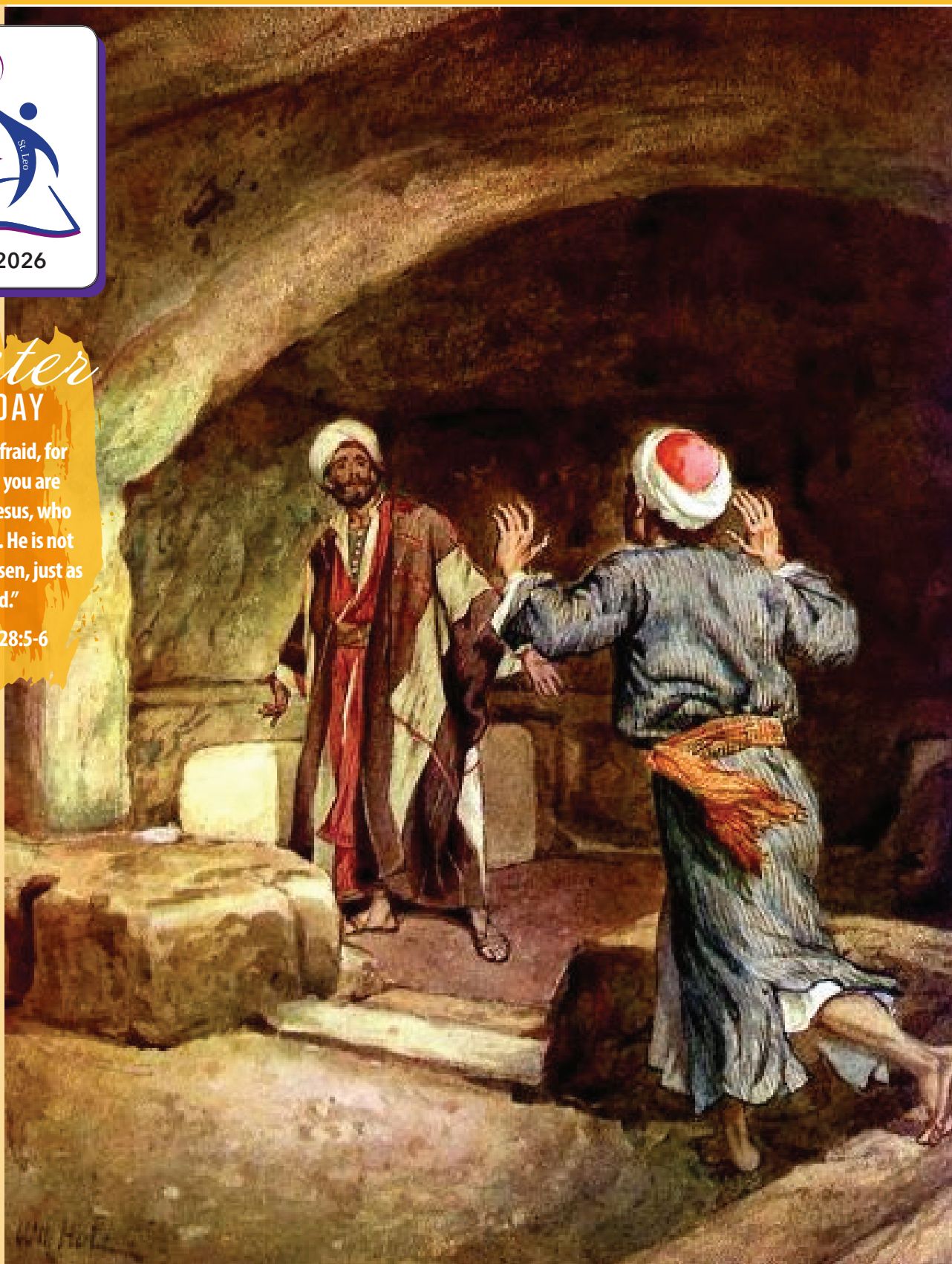

Divine Mercy Sunday: In the year 2000, Pope Saint John Paul II declared the second Sunday in the Easter Season to henceforth be known as Divine Mercy Sunday throughout the universal Church. This was declared in conjunction with the Canonization Mass of St. Faustina Kowalska who received private revelations from Jesus in the 1930s instructing her to promote devotion to Divine Mercy on

the first Sunday after Easter. This devotion includes a plenary indulgence (under the usual conditions: receiving Holy Communion, Sacramental Confession, and prayers for the intentions of the Holy Father). A plenary indulgence is a spiritual task or event that the Church has declared for the benefit of the faithful to remove ALL temporal punishment due to sin. This means that a person who completes the conditions for the plenary indulgence, should they die, would not have any temporal punishment to atone for in Purgatory, but would instead go straight to heaven. This year, **St. Ann's Catholic Parish in Slayton, MN will be hosting a Divine Mercy Holy Hour with Confessions available starting at 2 PM on Sunday, April 12th.** I will be there to assist with confessions.

The Holy Hour will consist of: Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament at 2pm with confessions available until 3pm. The Chaplet of Divine Mercy will be prayed at 3pm followed with Benediction. All are welcome to attend. The Promise - Our Lord Jesus said, "The soul that will go to Confessions and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day all the divine floodgates throughout which graces flow are opened. Let no soul fear to draw near to Me, even though its sins be as scarlet. . . Mankind will not have peace until it turns to the Fount of My Mercy." ~Saint Faustina, Diary, 699

Domingo de la Divina Misericordia: En el año 2000, el papa San Juan Pablo II declaró que el segundo domingo del tiempo pascual se conocería en adelante como Domingo de la Divina Misericordia en toda la Iglesia universal. Esta declaración se realizó con motivo de la misa de canonización de Santa Faustina Kowalska, quien recibió revelaciones privadas de Jesús en la década de 1930 en las que se le indicaba que promoviera la devoción a la Divina Misericordia

el primer domingo después de Pascua. Esta devoción incluye una indulgencia plenaria (bajo las condiciones habituales: recibir la Sagrada Comunión, la confesión sacramental y oraciones por las intenciones del Santo Padre). Una indulgencia plenaria es una tarea o evento espiritual que la Iglesia ha declarado en beneficio de los fieles para eliminar TODO castigo temporal debido al pecado. Esto significa que una persona que cumpla con las condiciones para la indulgencia plenaria, en caso de fallecer, no tendría ningún castigo temporal que expiar en el Purgatorio, sino que iría directamente al cielo. Este año, **la Parroquia Católica de Santa Ana en Slayton, Minnesota, organizará una Hora Santa de la Divina Misericordia con confesiones disponibles a partir de las 2 p. m. del domingo 12 de abril.** Estaré allí para ayudar con las confesiones.

La Hora Santa consistirá en: Exposición del Santísimo Sacramento a las 2 p. m., con confesiones disponibles hasta las 3 p. m. A las 3 p. m. se rezará el Rosario de la Divina Misericordia, seguido de la Bendición. Todos están invitados a participar. La promesa: Nuestro Señor Jesús dijo: «El alma que se confiese y reciba la Sagrada Comunión obtendrá el perdón completo de los pecados y del castigo». En ese día se abren todas las compuertas divinas por las que fluyen las gracias. Que ninguna alma tema acercarse a Mí, aunque sus pecados sean como la grana. . . La humanidad no tendrá paz hasta que se vuelva a la Fuente de Mi Misericordia». ~Santa Faustina, Diario, 699

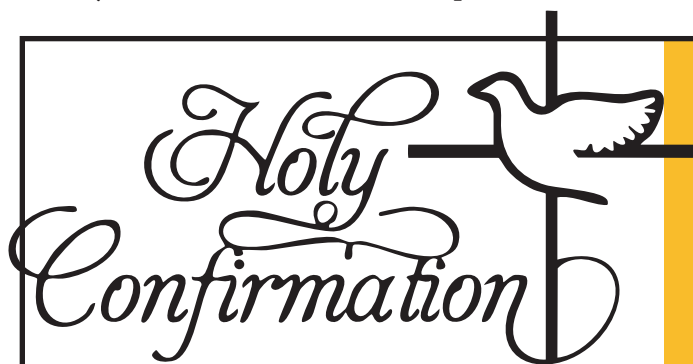

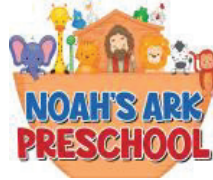
