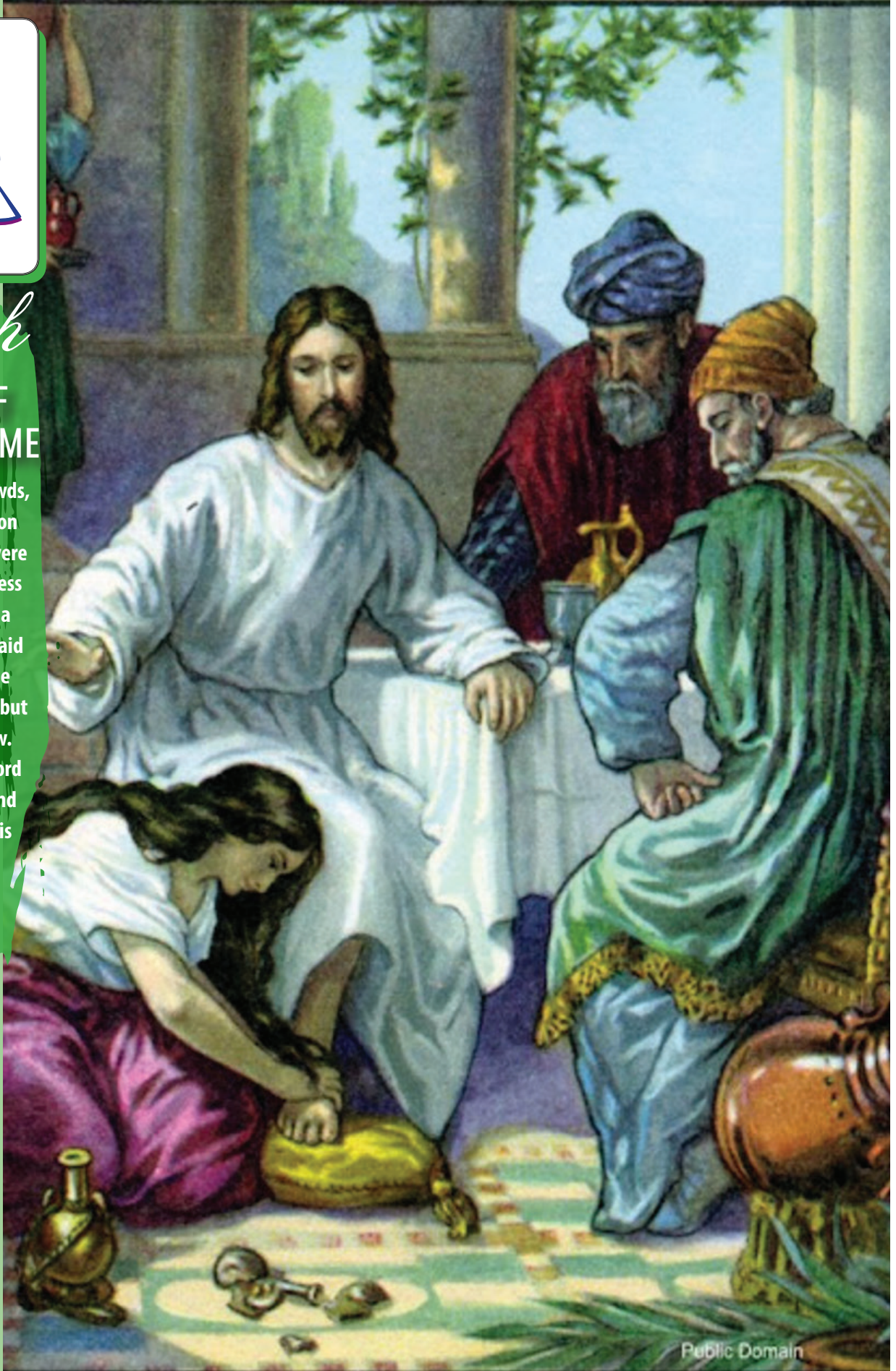

# FROM THE DESK OF FR. JOSHUA ...

**Called and Sent:** On June 4th and 5th, members of the parish staff and I attended the diocesan gathering to hear from +Bishop Barron and other diocesan and parish leaders about the implementation of the Diocesan Synod on Evangelization and Vocations. +Bishop Barron's top five priorities for implementation are: 1. Create a prayer for vocations 2. Restore Sacred Art and Music 3. Increase frequent, consistent, and regionally accessible opportunities for Eucharistic Adoration (Solemn Exposition) 4. Walk with One (Evangelization initiative to walk with one person to answer Jesus' call who longs to be with them) 5. Personally invite men to consider the priesthood. I have already been working with the staff to act on these priorities at our parishes, and we will continue to do so in the coming days. I encourage all parishioners to explore the new diocesan website, specifically the Synod Implementation SMART Goals and the resources available to us for implementing these directives. **New Priest Assignments:** On June 5th, +Bishop Barron consecrated the hands of three priests of Jesus Christ, and he has assigned them to work in the Lord's vineyard in our diocese beginning June 15th. Fr. Riley Becher is assigned as the Parochial Vicar at St. Mary's Parish in Worthington. Fr. Cullen Gallagher is assigned as the Parochial Vicar at Resurrection Parish in Rochester as well as the Assistant Priest Chaplain for Lourdes High School in Rochester. Fr. Adam Worm is assigned as the Parochial Vicar at St. Charles Borromeo Parish in St. Charles and Holy Redeemer Parish in Eyota as well as the Priest Chaplain at Lourdes High School in Rochester.



**Seminarians:** This week we will be welcoming Juan Galvez, one of our diocesan seminarians, to our parishes. He just finished his first (propaedeutic) year at Immaculate Heart of Mary Seminary in Winona. He will be with us through the first week of August. His home parish is St. Francis of Assisi in Rochester. Please give him a warm welcome to St. Catherine's and St. Leo's. Also, five new men have been accepted as seminarians for

our diocese. They will begin their formation next month. This is very encouraging and truly an answer to the prayers of the Faithful. Please offer a prayer of thanksgiving for their 'YES' to enter seminary and "wrestle with the Lord" (Gen 32:25) to discern their vocation.

**Marriage Preparation Mentor Couples Wanted:** The Office of Life, Marriage, and Family will be hosting training for couples to be trained to become mentor couples for in-home Marriage Preparation. In-Home Marriage Prep is the best way to prepare couples for marriage for several reasons: 1) it is inexpensive 2) it strengthens the marriage of the "mentor couples" 3) it is convenient because the engaged couple comes to the home of the mentor couple 4) it is personal (getting to the heart of the needs of each engaged couple) 5) it forms a relationship that can last into the first years of marriage and beyond 6) it can be a catalyst of retaining the engaged couples to remain members of the parish! If you are interested, please let me know ([pastor@stsc.org](mailto:pastor@stsc.org)). We are currently looking at scheduling the training on a Saturday in late summer/Fall.

**Music Ministry Training:** The Diocese of Winona-Rochester Office of Divine Worship has encouraged parishes to take advantage of this free resource: [CatholicMusician.org](http://CatholicMusician.org). This online formation platform from The Vigil Project offers practical resources, training, and spiritual formation to support music ministry in the Church.

**St. Leo:** The construction project to build the maintenance shed is underway. Please be mindful when walking near the construction area on the east side of the school. Also, you may have noticed that several sections of the sidewalk were also replaced when they poured the concrete for the shed and the east entrance. This was in large part due to the generosity of our parishioners and the cooperation of the City of Pipestone. Thank you for your generosity, which contributes to the maintenance and upkeep of our facilities.

**St. Catherine:** The painting in the gathering space and school is ongoing. The walls will not be bare permanently and there are plans to put artwork and other historical photos on the walls. Please be patient while the redecorating is ongoing.
