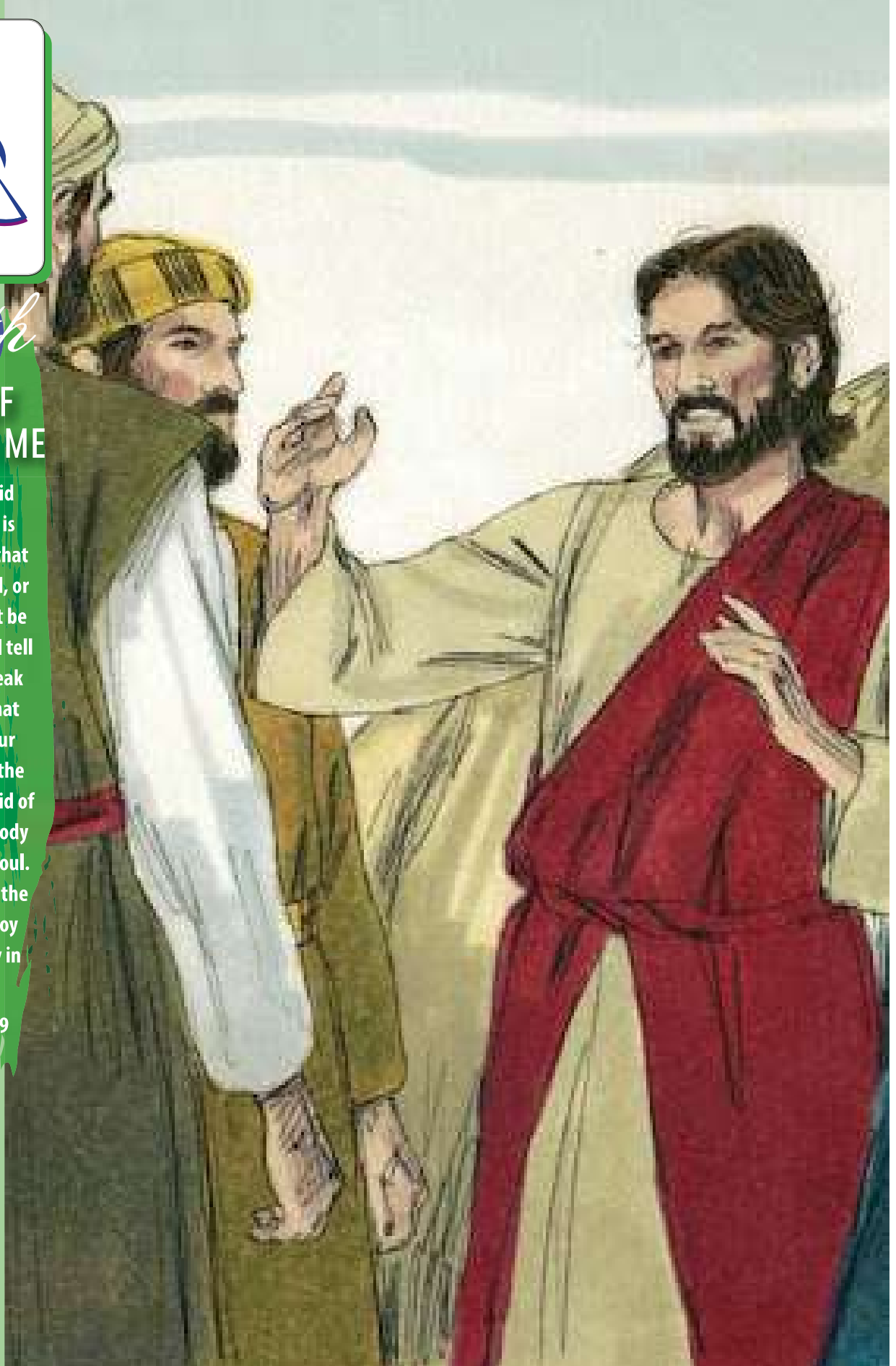

FROM THE DESK OF FR. JOSHUA ...

Funny Hat: Many people have asked me about the hat that I wear with my cassock. The hat is called a biretta. It is an optional piece of headgear for clergy. It has a long and convoluted history throughout the Church. In general, clerical headgear became a trend after the Roman practice of tonsure around the 7th century. In the Roman world, slaves were differentiated from their masters by having their heads shaved. At some point, the shaving of the head, either entirely or partially, was adopted as part of the ritual practice (tonsure) to enter the clerical state. It was a sign of death to self in order to be a slave of Jesus Christ. Practically speaking, especially in the northern hemisphere, this resulted in the heads of the clergy being cold, thus the need for head coverings. The first birettas were four pieces of fabric sewn together to cover the head. It took different shapes in different places throughout the Middle Ages. The biretta has different forms in Spain, France, Germany, and Italy. With the growth of the Church and in particular, the schools and universities, the biretta became associated with academia. Most of the university professors were clergy who wore the biretta. The cap that is used today at high school or college graduations is a derivative from the tradition of the biretta. In the Church, different ecclesiastical ranks and doctoral degrees are indicated by different materials and colors of the pom and piping on the biretta (black: priest, deacon, seminarian, black with a violet pom: monsignor, violet: bishop, scarlet red: cardinal, green pom: canon law, blue pom: philosophy, dark red pom: theology). The one that I wear is designed after the Roman fashion with the three peaks or horns on the right side and the black pom on top. The three horns represent the threefold "munera" (Latin for office) of the

priest: the prophetic office with the duty to teach and proclaim the Word of God, the priestly office with the duty to sanctify the Faithful and the world through administering the Sacraments and leading divine worship, and the kingly office to shepherd the flock and govern the Church community to guide it toward holiness.

Mass Buddies Wanted: One of the obstacles for people who have been away from the Sacraments or someone who is interested in Catholicism but does not know where to begin is that they don't necessarily know how to participate in the Mass. DEL ESCRITORIO DEL PR. JOSHUA...

Sombrero curioso: Mucha gente me ha preguntado por el sombrero que llevo con la sotana. Se llama birreta. Es un accesorio opcional para el clero. Tiene una historia larga y intrincada en el seno de la Iglesia. En general, los sombreros clericales se pusieron de moda tras la práctica romana de la tonsura, alrededor del siglo VII. En el mundo romano, a los esclavos se les diferenciaba de sus amos afeitándoles la cabeza. En algún momento, el afeitado de la cabeza, ya fuera total o parcial, se adoptó como parte de la práctica ritual (la tonsura) para acceder al estado clerical. Era un signo de muerte al yo para convertirse en esclavo de Jesucristo. En la práctica, sobre todo en el hemisferio norte, esto provocaba que el clero tuviera frío en la cabeza, de ahí la necesidad de cubrirse la cabeza. Las primeras birretas consistían en cuatro piezas de tela cosidas entre sí para cubrir la cabeza. A lo largo de la Edad Media adoptó diferentes formas según el lugar. La birreta presenta formas distintas en España, Francia, Alemania e Italia. Con el crecimiento de la Iglesia y, en particular, de las escuelas y universidades, la birreta pasó a asociarse con el mundo académico. La mayoría de los profesores universitarios eran clérigos que llevaban la birreta. El gorro que se utiliza hoy en día en las ceremonias de graduación de institutos y universidades deriva de la tradición de la birreta. En la Iglesia, los distintos rangos eclesiásticos y títulos de doctorado se indican mediante diferentes materiales y colores de la borla y el ribete de la birreta (negro: sacerdote, diácono, seminarista; negro con borla violeta: monseñor; violeta: obispo; rojo escarlata: cardenal; borla verde: derecho canónico; borla azul: filosofía; borla rojo oscuro: teología). La que yo llevo está diseñada al estilo romano, con tres picos o cuernos en el lado derecho y el pompón negro en la parte superior. Los tres cuernos representan los tres «munera» (término latino que significa «oficio») del sacerdote: el oficio profético,

co, con el deber de enseñar y proclamar la Palabra de Dios; el oficio sacerdotal, con el deber de santificar a los fieles y al mundo mediante la administración de los sacramentos y la dirección del culto divino; y el oficio real, de pastorear el rebaño y gobernar la comunidad eclesial para guiarla hacia la santidad.

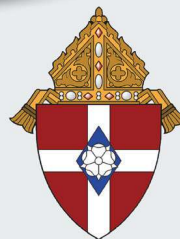
