FROM THE DESK OF FR. JOSHUA ...

Totus Tuus: This week St. Leo's will be hosting four young missionaries who will be working with our kids. Totus Tuus is Latin for "Totally Yours" and it was the motto of Pope St. John Paul II. This phrase was first made popular by St. Louis De Montfort in his work "True Devotion to Mary." This rightly ordered devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mother is what leads everyone who embraces it to a deeper personal encounter with Our Lord Jesus. Mary leads us to right relationship with Jesus in every aspect of life. From the opening miracle of Jesus' public ministry at the wedding at Cana: "Do whatever He tells you." – Mary to the servants (John 2: 5) The Daily Mass Schedule is adjusted to prioritize Totus Tuus during the week. There will be no daily Mass at St. Catherine while Totus Tuus is at St. Leo and vice versa the week the missionaries are at St. Catherine. Please watch the bulletin for updates.

St. Leo: The construction project to build the maintenance shed is underway. Please be mindful when walking near the construction area on the east side of the school. Thank you for your generosity, which contributes to the maintenance and upkeep of our facilities.

St. Catherine: As you may have seen on facebook, there were some walls that were removed from two of the classrooms. The reason that they were removed was because I deemed them a safety hazard. This was discovered when we tried to remove the bulletin board from the wall, and the whole wall moved. The walls were not necessary or essential to the function of the classrooms, and based on the fact that kids like to climb on top of these walls, I decided to have them removed. Thank you to all of the volunteers who assisted with the demolition and removal. Also, as a part of the redecorating, the classrooms and office spaces are being re-organized to better suit the needs of the parish. The re-organization will specifically address the needs for classroom space for Faith Formation, consolidated space for the Mission Sewing Center, and private space for the pastor's office to conduct pastoral counseling.

Totus Tuus: Esta semana, la parroquia de San León acogerá a cuatro jóvenes misioneros que trabajarán con nuestros niños. «Totus Tuus» significa en latín «Totalmente tuyo» y fue el lema del papa San Juan Pablo II. Esta frase la popularizó por primera vez San Luis de Montfort en su obra «La verdadera devoción a María». Esta devoción, debidamente ordenada, a la Santísima Virgen María es la que conduce a todos los que la abrazan a un encuentro personal más profundo con Nuestro Señor Jesús. María nos guía hacia una relación correcta con Jesús en todos los aspectos de la vida. Desde el milagro inicial del ministerio público de Jesús en las bodas de Caná: «Haced lo que Él os diga». – María a los sirvientes (Juan 2, 5). El horario diario de misas se ha ajustado para dar prioridad a Totus Tuus durante la semana. No habrá misa diaria en Santa Catalina mientras Totus Tuus esté en San León, y viceversa la semana en que los misioneros estén en Santa Catalina. St. Catherine: Como habrán visto en Facebook, se han derribado algunas paredes de dos de las aulas. La razón por la que se han eliminado es que las consideré un riesgo para la seguridad. Esto se descubrió cuando intentamos quitar el tablón de anuncios de la pared y toda la pared se movió. Las paredes no eran necesarias ni esenciales para el funcionamiento de las aulas y, dado que a los niños les gusta trepar por ellas, decidí que se retirarían. Gracias a todos los voluntarios que ayudaron con la demolición y la retirada. Además, como parte de la remodelación, se están reorganizando las aulas y los espacios de oficinas para adaptarlos mejor a las necesidades de la parroquia. La reorganización abordará específicamente las necesidades de espacio en las aulas para la formación en la fe, un espacio consolidado para el Centro de Costura Misionero y un espacio privado para el despacho del párroco donde llevar a cabo el asesoramiento pastoral.
