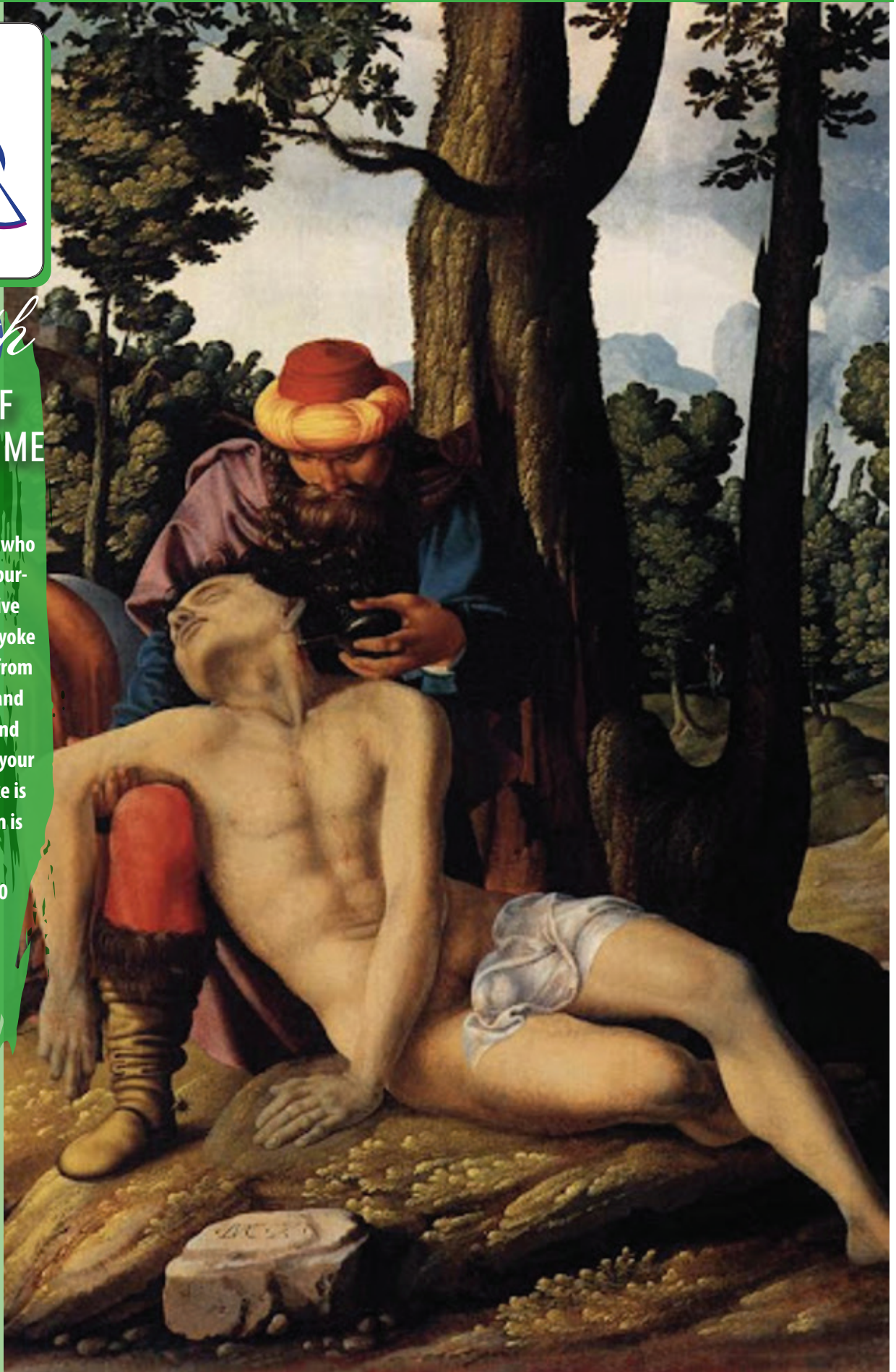

FROM THE DESK OF FR. JOSHUA ...

Mass Intentions: "Pray, that my sacrifice and yours may be acceptable to God the Almighty Father." These words are spoken every Sunday at the beginning of the Liturgy of the Eucharist once the altar has been prepared. "My sacrifice and yours" refers to the spiritual sacrifices we are each able to make on account of our Baptism—the priesthood of the baptized—as well as the physical offering of bread and wine that will become the Body and Blood of Christ.

Our spiritual sacrifices take many forms. They are all placed on the altar along with the bread and wine to be offered to God. Each of us is able to make a spiritual sacrifice. Our sacrifices can be generic or specific, or you may just offer yourself and your praise. However you make your sacrifice, the purpose is to unite yourself more closely to God and the Communion of Saints, and for the salvation of souls.

Priests, however, have an opportunity to offer spiritual sacrifices, or intentions, that are united to the sacrifice we make at the altar while in the person of Christ. These are the Mass intentions that you see in the bulletin each week and it is a privilege for us to offer up these intentions. I often hear people refer to a Mass being offered for the specific person that is listed in the bulletin. This is, however, only partly true. The Sacrifice of the Mass is offered for the Church. The Mass intention, either a specific person or group of persons, is actually the priest's personal prayer intention. You also get to pray for that person and for whoever else you wish!

The Church asks for a stipend or offering for each Mass intention. In the Diocese of Winona-Rochester the Bishop has decreed that the amount for a Mass stipend is not to exceed ten dollars (see also: canon 948). This is part of a priest's salary and places an obligation on priests to offer a Mass for that intention within one year of receiving the intention (c. 945 §2). If a priest/parish receives too many mass intentions than can be completed in one year, the Mass intentions (and

stipends) are transferred to another priest within the diocese, usually a priest working as a teacher or seminary formator. They could also be given to a senior priest or the bishop. Regardless of which priest offers the Mass for the intention, the documentation of who has offered the Mass stipend for an intention and which priest has completed the sacrifice for that intention is kept on record for inspection by the bishop annually (c. 958 §2). Concelebrating priests also offer intentions with or without a stipend donated by parishioners, even if they're not listed in the bulletin. A priest can only accept one stipend for one Mass (c. 949).

It is good to offer Mass intentions, to pray for the deceased and the living. An intention is no less important, however, if it is not stated by a concelebrating priest or when a priest offers Mass without a congregation. However it happens, you and I both are able to offer our sacrifices to our Almighty Father for the salvation of souls and our own growth in holiness.

Formed.org Coming Soon: Recently, the decision was made to purchase a subscription to digital catechetical resources and other religious content for use by all parishioners. This will be made available for parishioners to use at home and/or be used as a part of Faith Formation content.

DEL ESCRITORIO DEL PR. JOSHUA...

Intenciones de la misa: «Oremos para que mi sacrificio y el de ustedes sean aceptables ante Dios, el Padre Todopoderoso». Estas palabras se pronuncian cada domingo al inicio de la Liturgia de la Eucaristía, una vez que se ha preparado el altar. «Mi sacrificio y el de ustedes» se refiere a los sacrificios espirituales que cada uno de nosotros puede hacer en virtud de nuestro bautismo —el sacerdocio de los bautizados—, así como a la ofrenda material de pan y vino que se convertirá en el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo.

Nuestros sacrificios espirituales toman muchas formas. Todos ellos se colocan sobre el altar junto con el pan y el vino para ser ofrecidos a Dios. Cada uno de nosotros puede hacer un sacrificio espiritual. Nuestros sacrificios pueden ser genéricos o específicos, o simplemente puedes ofrecerte a ti mismo y tu alabanza. Sea cual sea la forma en que hagas tu sacrificio, el propósito es unirse más estrechamente a Dios y a la Comunión de los Santos, y por la salvación de las almas.

Los sacerdotes, sin embargo, tienen la oportunidad de ofrecer sacrificios espirituales, o intenciones, que se unen al sacrificio que realizamos en el altar en la persona de Cristo. Estas son las intenciones de la misa que ven cada semana en el boletín, y para nosotros es un privilegio ofrecer estas intenciones. A menudo escucho a la gente referirse a que se ofrece una misa por la persona específica que aparece en el boletín. Sin embargo, esto es cierto solo en parte. El sacrificio de la misa se ofrece por la Iglesia. La intención de

la misa, ya sea por una persona específica o un grupo de personas, es en realidad la intención de oración personal del sacerdote. ¡Tú también puedes orar por esa persona y por quien más desees!

La Iglesia solicita un estipendio u ofrenda por cada intención de misa. En la Diócesis de Winona-Rochester, el obispo ha decretado que el monto del estipendio por una misa no debe exceder los diez dólares (véase también: canon 948). Esto forma parte del salario del sacerdote y le impone la obligación de celebrar una misa por esa intención dentro del plazo de un año a partir de la recepción de la intención (c. 945 §2). Si un sacerdote o una parroquia recibe más intenciones de misa de las que pueden cumplirse en un año, las intenciones (y los estipendios) se transfieren a otro sacerdote dentro de la diócesis, por lo general un sacerdote que se dedica a la enseñanza o a la formación en el seminario. También podrían asignarse a un sacerdote de mayor edad o al obispo. Independientemente de qué sacerdote celebre la misa por la intención, la documentación sobre quién ha ofrecido el estipendio de la misa por una intención y qué sacerdote ha celebrado el sacrificio por esa intención se mantiene en los registros para que el obispo la revise anualmente (c. 958 §2). Los sacerdotes concelebrantes también ofrecen intenciones con o sin un estipendio donado por los feligreses, incluso si no figuran en el boletín. Un sacerdote solo puede aceptar un estipendio por una misa (c. 949).

Rev. Msgr. Gerald Kosse (50 years a priest) was born in Caledonia to Clemens and Mary (Wilkes) Kosse. He studied philosophy at Immaculate Heart of Mary Seminary in Winona and completed his theology degree at St. Paul Seminary in St. Paul. On May 21, 1976, he was ordained to the priesthood at the Cathedral of the Sacred Heart in Winona by the Most Rev. Loras Watters. Monsignor Kosse's assignments as parochial vicar were at Sacred Heart in Waseca, St. Francis of Assisi in Rochester, St. Augustine in Austin, St. John in Rochester, St. Stanislaus Kostka in Winona, and the Cathedral of the Sacred Heart in Winona. As pastor, he served at Our Lady of Mount Carmel in Easton, St. John the Baptist in Minnesota Lake, St. Adrian in Adrian, Our Lady of Good Counsel in Wilmont, St. Leo in Pipestone, St. Joseph in Jasper, St. Martin in Woodstock, and St. Catherine in Luverne. Other assignments include parochial administrator for St. Columban in Preston, St. Lawrence O'Toole in Fountain, Our Lady of Mount Carmel in Easton, St. John the Baptist in Minnesota Lake; diocesan tribunal assistant; priest moderator for St. Anthony in Lismore, and St. Killian in St. Killian; dean of the Worthington Deanery; area moderator of the Worthington Area Council of Catholic Women; chaplain for Courage and EnCourage for the Diocese of Winona; member of the Clergy Personnel Committee; and spiritual advisor for the Diocese of Winona-Rochester Council of Catholic Women. In 2012, he was named Chaplain to His Holiness. On July 1, 2025, Monsignor Kosse joined the ranks of senior priests in the diocese.
