



FROM THE DESK OF FR. JOSHUA

This weekend there was a Wedding and Baptism on Saturday at St. Leo's, then after the Masses on Sunday the first session of the Order of Christian Initiation for Adults will begin, and Sunday evening one of our students will receive the Sacrament of Confirmation at St. Mary's Parish in Worthington. On Monday, September 29th through Thursday October 2nd, I will be in Okiboji, IA attending the Diocese of Winona-Rochester Priest Convocation. This is an annual requirement for all active diocesan priests to be with the bishop and all the priests of the diocese to spend time together in prayer, conduct priest business, and cultivate priestly fraternity. This year +Bishop Barron is the Keynote speaker, and he will be giving the priests presentations on the Mass and Prayer. We will also be discussing the outcomes of the Diocesan Synod on Evangelization and Vocations. Monsignor Kosse and I will both be attending and thus there will be **no daily Masses or Confessions from 29 September through 2 October.**

There will be a "Come and See" (John 1:39) weekend at Immaculate Heart of Mary Seminary in Winona November 15th-17th. This is intended for any young man who is interested in experiencing what a day in the life of a seminarian is like, similar to a college visit. Seminarians take classes at Saint Mary's University and live in the IHM Seminary dorms. If you are a young man who is interested in learning more about what seminary life is like, please contact me at the parish office. We are also looking for parishioners to volunteer to assist with transportation for this event.

I met with many parishioners from St. Catherine's who are devoted to spending time with our Blessed Lord in Eucharistic Adoration. There is a new schedule for Adoration at St. Catherine's (see the announcement from Jen Huisman in this bulletin). I would like to do more Eucharistic Adoration at St. Leo's as well. If you are interested in spending more time with Jesus in Adoration at St. Leo's please leave your name and contact information at

the St. Leo Parish Office.

The Pastoral Councils have formed a joint committee and have begun to gather information and create potential plans to publish an updated Parish Pictorial Directory. The most recent directory that we have is from 2013 and so we are long overdue. More to follow in the coming weeks.

After much effort and preparation, the St. Catherine's Finance Council is announcing plans to renovate the Doyle Hall kitchen this weekend. A majority of the funds have already been raised but there is still an outstanding balance that the parish will need to raise in order to begin this building project. The Diocese of Winona-Rochester requires that any parish expenditure over the \$25,000 be approved by the Diocesan College of Consultors which consists in the Diocesan Finance Officer, Diocesan Risk Management Officer, Bishop, Vicar General, and other diocesan leaders to ensure that our parish is exercising prudent and responsible stewardship of our resources. The College of Consultors' next meeting is November 20th. Pending our parish raising the requisite amount, and approval from the College of Consultors, work could begin as early as the end of November, but more likely it would begin after Christmas. This will impact all activities (Faith Formation, funeral lunches, pickleball, etc) in Doyle Hall for four to six weeks.

On a personal note, I am grateful for your patience with me as I learn to be your shepherd. If you would like to speak with me personally, **please do not come into the Sacristy before Mass.** I am working with the parish staff to be more organized to respond to requests in a reasonable manner. That being said, I am only one man, and there are very many of you spread across a significant quantity of time and space. If I do not respond to you quickly, please be patient, and if it is an urgent matter, please persevere in trying to reach me. Know that you are in my prayers, I know that I am in yours. *-Fr. We will take a second collection at each Sunday Mass during the month of October with our goal to be able to present our plan to the Consulters Meeting in early November. With approval of the plan, we hope work will begin during the winter months and that Doyle Hall will be available for Lent and Easter celebrations.
