#### ATTENDING STUEBENVILLE




This group of students travel to Rochester for Steubenville this past weekend and they had a blast! Meeting other young adult sharing their

#### **ST. MARY MAGDALENE**

St. Mary Magdalene is a central figure in the Gospels and is known as "the Apostle to the Apostles." She came from Magdala, a fishing village on the Sea of Galilee, and became a follower of Christ after he cast out seven demons from her. From then on, Mary Magdalene supported the Apostles throughout their ministry.

#### Road to Sainthood:

After the Sabbath, Mary Magdalene returned to an empty tomb and became the first witness of Christ's Resurrection. She ran and brought the good news to the Apostles, becoming the first to announce the rising of Christ to new life. The Apostles went on to proclaim to the world this truth they learned from her.

In 2016, Pope Francis elevated the status of her liturgical celebration to a feast in order to stress her importance as a disciple and evangelizer. She followed Jesus to His crucifixion and stood beside His mother and St. John at the foot of the cross.

#### Mary Magdalene in the Bible:

Mary was a faithful witness to Jesus. Consider this passage from Scripture in the holy Gospel according to John:

Jesus said to her, "Woman, why are you weeping? Whom are you looking for?" She thought it was the gardener and said to him, "Sir, if you carried him away, tell me where you laid him, and I will take him." Jesus said to her, "Mary!" She turned and said to him in Hebrew, "Rabbouni," which means Teacher. Jesus said to her, "Stop holding on to me, for I have not yet ascended to the Father. But go to my brothers and tell them, 'I am going to my Father and your Father, to my God and your God."" Mary of Magdala went and announced to the disciples, "I have seen the Lord," and what he told her.
