SERVICE OPPORTUNITY

Watermark Missions will be leading a disaster rebuild mission trip to Spencer, Iowa from Tuesday, September 16 to Friday, September 26. The Spencer community suffered significant damage as a part of the June 2025 flooding event across Northern Iowa and Southern Minnesota. There are still 141 active cases in need of help with rebuilding - things like framing, putting in cabinets, insulating, sheet rocking, mudding, taping, rebuilding outside steps, replacing flooring and outside doors etc. Watermark Missions is looking for additional volunteers to help with the rebuilds. Prior construction experience is helpful but is not necessary. Food and overnight accommodations will be provided at a local church at no cost to the volunteers. Volunteers must be 18 vears old or older and are asked to make a minimum commitment of 2 days, but are welcome to stay as many days as they are able to.
