GRAVE COSTS

\$800.00 per casket and/or cremation grave
\$400.00 of the \$800.00 goes to the Permanent Care
\$800.00 per grave for two (2) cremations in one (1) grave
\$500.00 of the \$800.00 goes to the Permanent Care

Internment Fee

There is an extra \$300 internment fee
due at the time of burial.

SPECIAL RULES & GUIDELINES

The scattering of ashes of a cremated person is not allowed on Saint Leo Cemetery. The ashes of a cremated person must be buried in a grave of their own and be placed in a cremation vault.

There must also be a 4" lip at the base of the gravestone. No gravestone may be placed in the cemetery without the permission of St. Leo Cemetery Board. The gravestone and its care is the responsibility of the family.

No shrubs or trees may be planted on St. Leo Cemetery grounds without the expressed approval of the Cemetery Board. Flowers and other articles must be attached to the grave stone base. All artificial flowers must be removed two weeks after Memorial Day. All flowers, figurines, luminaries, and other articles must be removed by September 30. Final maintenance of the cemetery and the graves depend on the Cemetery Board Members.
