

# 5 TIPS TO NEWLY ESTABLISHED LOCS

**Trust the PROCESS!**



## 1. LOC MANUPLIATION

Tight styles, braiding tight and putting up in a ponytail/ bun can cause the hair to become weak as it is maturing.

## 2. SPRITZING WITH WATER

Spritzing with water is defeating the purpose of the hair to loc. The water is loosening the hair when the hair needs to tighten up to loc resulting in excessive slippage within your loc.

## 3. LIGHT OILS

Refrain from using heavy oils such as coconut oil, olive oil, castor oil etc. These are heavy oils and will cause build up in the loc over time. Light oils can be used focusing on application to the scalp and not on the loc.

## 4. WASHING HAIR

Braid and band as possible, use low pressure running water, and clarifying shampoo. Avoid conditioning or moisturizing shampoos until your loc starts to mature or advised by your Locician. If your locs begin to feel "crunchy" try incorporating a moisturizing shampoo to your wash regiment.



## 5. SEPERATION

Separating your locs daily and after each wash is a MUST. Doing this will help keep the locs from marrying at the root. This will also make it easier on the Locician and yourself during regularly scheduled maintenance services.
