MINUTES FROM PREVIOUS MEETING: Motion to approve minutes by Mitch Miller and seconded by Lori Schaeffer; motion carried.

TREASURERS REPORT: Motion to approve Treasurers report made by Judy Mills and seconded by Diane Durrin; motion carried.

PASTOR'S REPORT-Pastor Tony: Pastor Tony provided journal with some of his activities. Pastor Tony commented on the Active Shooter in Church Seminar he attended.

CHRISTIAN EDUCATION-Vanessa: Signup has started for VBS. Begindergarten students must have a parent present. All helpers will need to have completed a background check.

CONFIRMATION-Diane: Taking a break.

OUTREACH/HOSPITALITY-Liz:

CARES-Liz: Fourth of July items have been delivered to the assisted living facilities.

STAFF/PARISH RELATIONS- Mick: No meeting. **WORSHIP MINISTRY- Bobbi:** No meeting.

FINANCE-Pastor Lori: The church has two CDs at Bankwest: Missions \$10,000; scholarship \$12,000.

FUNERAL-Liz: May funeral was for Alice Hartford.

TRUSTEES-Dan: List provided of Trustees works including completion of temporary fence at parsonage, rugs for the church, ceiling fan installed at parsonage, two sump pumps purchased, AV and door projects begun, Bible racks on end of pews installed. Still working on holes in parking lot and sidewalk, weed spraying, shelves in storeroom, walls in men's bathroom, extend outside drain, put up highway sign, find someone to replace windows, air conditioner in MYF, choir and kids' room. The upstairs women's bathroom has a leak.

AUDIO/VISUAL-Dan: Internet upgrade complete.

MISSIONS-Mitch: Put together and delivered 19 food boxes to needy families in the area. Five-year commitment to Blessman International on feeding children; Received thank you from Rotary Club for backpack donation. Fuller Bike Adventure will be here July 1st; showers, dinner and breakfast will be provided. The bike group is riding to fund homes for displaced people. The Missions Committee will be requesting assistance from the congregation in completing chemo bags.

OLD BUSINESS: Discussed wedding policy, few changes to grammar made. If someone is to open the church and remain, they will be paid with a gift card. Motion to approve wedding policy with corrections by Mitch Miller and seconded by Dan Patmore; motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS: Pastor Tony presented the Child Safety Policy; he thanked everyone for their hard work on the project. The Administrative Council is to review the policy and return in July with any discussion. Kim DeMers discussed having a preschool program in the church. This would be for 3–5-year-olds. The child must be potty trained. If the child is not potty trained the parent could remain with the child. Discussion on CDs at Bankwest. Motion made by Diane Durrin and seconded by Clint Woods to let the scholarship CD renew for 6 months and then use it for senior scholarships; motion carried. For the next few months, we will try having the blue bucket in the back of the church. Tony will refer to the blue bucket with the benediction.

Pastor's Corner

July 2025 Independence

Someone said to me this week, "Have a happy 4th." I know what they meant, but I thought to myself, "Self, there's no U.S. Holiday called, 'July 4th'." The U.S. holiday on July 4th is Independence Day.

Independence Day is our remembrance of the signing of our nation's Declaration of Independence, a document which was adopted by the Continental Congress on July 4, 1776. The Declaration of Independence declared the intent of the 13 American colonies to be independent of the rule of the British King.

Our country remains fiercely independent, even considering all of our political division. The more divided we get, the more independent we think we are. Americans are growing ever more distrustful of authority and government, more independent in thought and behavior, and ever more vocal about being independent from the requirements of religion.

Many of us still believe as most of our nation's forefathers did; that our nation was a blessing given to the world by God, founded not necessarily as a Christian nation, but certainly built upon Biblical principles for our laws and practices. But though our national Independence was God's gift to us, he never intended our independence to be a separation from him.

In fact, Jesus's plan for his church is the exact opposite of independent. The Father wants us to be completely and utterly dependent on him. Listen to some of what the Bible says about our being dependent on our Creator.

Proverbs 3:5

Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not lead on your own understanding.

Isaiah 26:4

Trust in the LORD forever, for the LORD GOD is an enduring protector.

Psalm 118:8-9
