

Leadership Council August 17, 2025

Members present at the Leadership meeting were Pastor Tony Coffman, Malon Burtz, Donna Duffy, Diane Durrin, Vanessa Goodell, Mitch Miller, Dan Patmore, Mick Rowe, Lori Schaeffer, Clint Vanneman, Clint Woods, and Judy Mills.

The opening prayer was given by Clint Vanneman.

A motion to approve the minutes of the previous meeting was made by Lori Schaeffer and seconded by Mick Rowe; the motion was carried.

Mitch Miller moved to approve the treasurer's report, which was seconded by Vanessa Goodell and motion was carried.

A journal documenting recent activities was provided by Pastor Tony.

The GPS program is scheduled to begin on September 10 and will be held from 6:00 pm to 7:00 pm. All volunteers must complete the Child Safety Training. Should the Child Safety Policy receive approval, all volunteers must read and sign the policy document. The live nativity event is set for December 7; the specific time will be announced at a later date.

Confirmation will begin on September 10th. Pastor Tony acknowledged Diane Durrin's curriculum, noting that it has been shared with other churches.

No Outreach meeting was held this month. The August 13 potluck in the park had low attendance of 25 due to hot, windy weather.

No meetings were held for Cares or the SPR Committees.

The Worship Committee worked on the 2026 budget. Church decorating is set for November 23 after worship. "Sounds of Christmas" is planned for December 3, and there will be two Christmas Eve services.

The Finance Committee will meet following the submission of budget requests. The Scholarship certificate of deposit is scheduled to mature in May 2026, while the Missions certificate of deposit will reach maturity in October 2025.

The Trustees Committee provided a list of ongoing tasks and is currently putting up a new highway sign. They found a company that will replace the windows in the choir room. Tony volunteered to refinish the baptismal stand.

The AV Committee fixed the microphones; basement audio is now working.

Missions Sunday is scheduled for September 14th. The event will encourage the congregation to raise more than \$10,000 in support of Texas flood victims. The missions committee will match donations on a one-to-one basis, up to a total of \$10,000.

The charge conference is scheduled for October 19 during the worship service, with Darla attending. Lori Schaeffer moved, and Dan Patmore seconded, to approve the Child Safety Policy. Kim DeMers' pre-GPS will be supervised by Vanessa Goodell, and parents must check in their children.

Mick Rowe made a motion to adjourn the meeting, which was seconded by Diane Durrin. The motion was approved, and the meeting concluded at 11:25 AM.

Pastor Tony Coffman led the closing prayer. The next meeting is set for September 21, 2025.

Pastor's Corner

September 2025 Church in the Flood

Last month, in August, I posted the thoughts of a Pastor named Scott Reece called, "God in the Flood". His words reminded us that even in a tragedy like the catastrophic flooding that took place on July 4th in South Texas, God was there. If you have not read that, you should. You can find that in the church or on our website.

As of the end of August, here is what we know.

Deaths = 138 confirmed
Missing = 2
Total Damage and Economic Loss = \$18-22 Billion
Residential Building Loss = \$1.1 Billion

How much is a billion? In time, one million seconds equals 11.5 days. A billion seconds equals more than 32 years.

Whole communities, including one where a Global Methodist Church existed, were wiped from the map, never to be rebuilt. These places already suffered severe poverty, and the people who survived will simply move on and relocate.

As I pondered this, I believe the next question that we have to ask ourselves is, "Where is the Church in the flood?" Of course, the church in and around South Texas is very active in doing what it can to help those who were affected by this event. But the church is bigger than just those in South Texas. The church is the Body and Bride of Christ, and we are all part of that body.

Paul, in calling the church to be in unity, says this in his letter to the Ephesians.

Make every effort to keep yourselves united in the Spirit, binding yourselves together with peace. For there is one body and one Spirit, just as you have been called to one glorious hope for the future. There is one Lord, one faith, one baptism, one God and Father of all, who is over all, in all, and living through all.

(Ephesians 4:3-6, NLT)

Saying this, how can our church help? How can Winner Methodist Church help those who are still suffering two months later?

I talked with a leader in the MidTexas Conference of the GMC. The stories ripped at my heart. The Global Methodist Church had four churches in the affected counties; now there are three. These churches (the people) are going door-to-door in the towns and cities asking what immediate assistance people need. They are getting answers that range from towels and bedding to assistance paying for funerals. They need more financial help so that they can pass that on to the needy in the communities.

What can we do? On Sunday, August 31st, our Winner Methodist Church Missions Committee challenged our congregation to give. Our Missions Committee issued a giving challenge, agreeing to match, dollar-for-dollar, the first \$10,000.00 raised by the church. All of the raised funds, including the Missions Committee match, will be sent to the MidTexas GMC Conference to give out to their communities as they find the needs. With your help, South Dakota dollars will serve the deep needs of the people in South Texas, and Christ will be glorified by your generosity.

Last year, in raising funds to provide clean drinking water to preschool children in South Africa, Winner Methodist Church proved to be a loving and generous church to people we will never meet. I'm so thankful to be part of a church that believes in this kind of giving. Let's step up again and, by our love for Christ, help others with our gifts and offerings.
