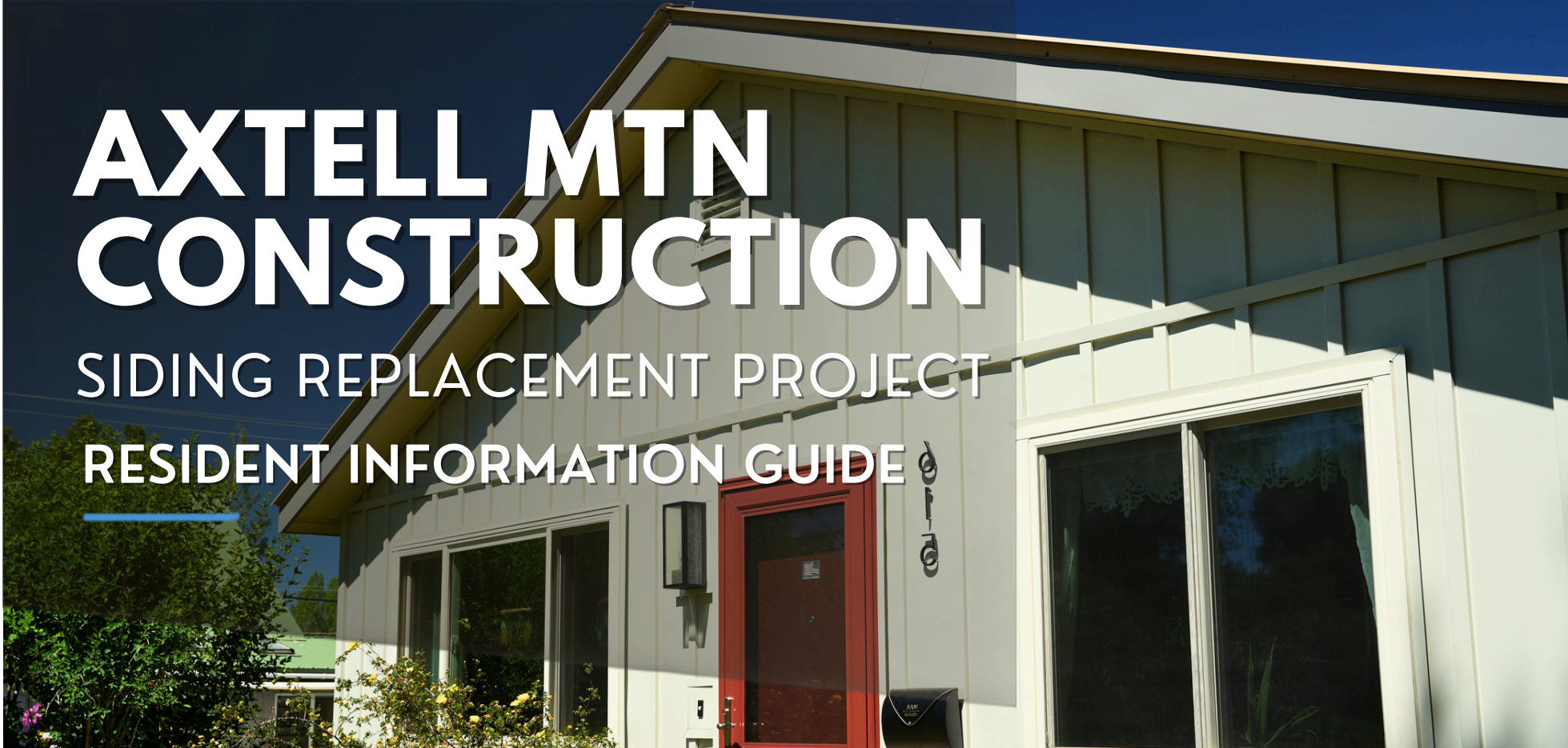

SCOPE OF WORK

Axtell has been contracted to remove the aging siding and replace it with a new water-tight metal-siding system. This type of siding is most suitable for the demanding climate conditions of Western, Colorado.

WHAT TO EXPECT

PROJECT TIMELINE

Our goal is to complete your new siding efficiently and with as little disruption as possible. Timelines may change due to weather or other conditions; otherwise, we aim to complete your project on-time.



1 TEAR-OFF

Remove existing siding system and inspect wall sheathing. Zip Board sheathing system is installed immediately following tear-off.



2 ROLL-OUT

At this point your metal siding panels may be manufactured and stacked on site - **typically utilizing driveway space**



3 INSTALLATION

Install new zip system, insulation if requested, siding system and flashing.



4 DETAILS & FINISH WORK

Complete flashing, and final siding details per prior agreement and necessity.



5 CLEANUP & PROJECT CLOSE

Final cleanup, magnetic sweep and inspection.

Final billing following

Ground & overhead debris may be present throughout project and one season following

BEFORE, DURING & AFTER



BEFORE WE ARRIVE

- Move vehicles and trailers from work areas.
- Remove or secure items on balconies and patios.
- Close windows and doors during tear-off.
- Secure pets during noisy work periods.
- A port-o-potty and trash trailer will be present on property during project



DURING CONSTRUCTION

- **Overhead hazards may exist throughout project and one season following completion**
- Expect noise from equipment and installation.
- Debris will fall during tear-off. **Please use caution.**
- Keep children and pets away from work areas.
- We do our best to mitigate construction debris however some may end up on the ground for a limited time



AFTER COMPLETION

- We complete a final cleanup and magnetic sweep.
- Additional sweeps are completed as needed.
- If you find significant debris following project completion, please let us know.
- Warranty information will be provided at project close.
