## 2026 Golf Tournament Rules

### 1. Tournament Format – Shotgun Start

- A shotgun start means all groups begin play at the same time, each from a different assigned hole on the course.
- A horn, siren, or announcement will signal the official start of play.
- Groups must be on their assigned tee box and ready to play before the signal.

### 2. Starting Holes & Order of Play

- Each team or foursome is assigned a starting hole prior to the tournament.
- After completing the starting hole, groups continue playing in natural numerical order until all 18 holes are completed.
  - Example: A group starting on Hole 12 plays 12–18, then 1–11.

### 3. Group Size

- Groups are typically four players (foursomes).
- If registration exceeds 72 players (18 foursomes), we will place two groups on the same hole; for the two par-5 holes only (designated as “A” and “B” groups).

### 4. Format and Rules of Play

- This will be a scramble-style game
- Play will follow USGA Rules of Golf, except where modified by local or tournament-specific rules.
- Tournament rules supersede standard rules where applicable (e.g., mulligans, gimmies, or preferred lies).
  - Preferred Lies (Lift, Clean, and Place within one club length in fairways)
  - Gimmies within a specified distance on the green (e.g., within 6 inches or putter length)
  - Mulligans permitted if purchased as part of the package (max of two per golfer)

### 5. Pace of Play

- Shotgun tournaments rely on steady pace to keep the entire field moving.
- Groups should:
  - Be ready to play when it's their turn
  - Limit ball searches
  - Keep up with the group ahead
- Tournament officials may:
  - Ask slow groups to speed up
  - Direct groups to pick up and move ahead if necessary

### 6. Scoring

- Scorecards are provided and should be completed clearly and accurately.
- At least two players must verify scores before submission.
- Scorecards must be returned immediately after finishing the final hole.
- In scramble events, only one score per hole is recorded for the team.



## 2026 Golf Tournament Rules

### 7. Score Resolution & Ties

- The tournament committee's decision is final on all rules and scoring disputes.
- Ties are typically broken using:
  - Matching scorecards
  - Back-nine score comparison

### 8. Completion of Play

- All groups are expected to finish their round unless directed otherwise by tournament officials.
- Because all groups start simultaneously, most players finish at roughly the same time, allowing for:
  - Awards ceremony
  - Lunch or dinner
  - Raffles, auctions, or prizes

### 9. Sportsmanship & Etiquette

- Players are expected to:
  - Observe proper golf etiquette
  - Show courtesy to fellow players, volunteers, and course staff
  - Have fun and support the fundraising purpose of the event

### 10. Weather Policy

- Play continues unless suspended by the tournament committee or course staff.
- In the event of suspension or cancellation, prizes may be awarded based on completed holes.
- If the event is cancelled: a full refund will be available by request if the group completes fewer than 6 holes. A 50% refund will be given if fewer than 14 holes are completed. Refunds are given in the form of a raincheck for a round of golf on a future date.

### 11. Dress Code

- Proper golf attire is required on the courses, driving range, and practice range at all times. Men must wear a collared shirt and women a shirt with a finished collar at all times. Shorts must be 17" minimum from top of waist to bottom of hem (Bermuda length). Tank tops, t-shirts, blue jeans, bathing suit, gym shorts, mesh shirts, cut-offs, halter tops, short-shorts and tennis attire are not allowed.
- The Amelia River Club is a spikeless facility. The use of alternative spikes is required.

### 12. Food and Beverage Policy

- Due to state law, no outside food and/or beverage may be brought in or removed from The Amelia River Club premises.
