

Dear Graduating Students and Parents:

Congratulations on reaching your senior year, the year of your graduation!! As we prepare for your graduation, we want to ensure that you are aware of the regulations and requirements for participation in the NSHS graduation ceremony. Please review the following contract, sign to indicate your agreement and return to the office or Ms. Cami Christensen, by 5/05/2026. If you have any questions, please don't hesitate to contact C. Christensen or administration, Principal Straatman or Vice-Principal Holder.

Graduation Participation Contract:

1. I understand that in order to participate in the graduation ceremony, I must successfully complete all requirements, courses and credits , for graduation by 5/15/26 at 3:00pm.
2. I will attend all practices and events from 5/18/2026 to 5/22/2026 to prepare for the ceremony. I will arrive on time, prepared to participate and dressed appropriately.
3. I understand that I am required to conduct myself in a manner that is expected of me. I will remember that I am representing North Sanpete High School and my family and my actions will reflect that.
4. I will conduct myself in a respectful and dignified manner during the graduation ceremony and will follow all instructions given by Ms. C. Christensen. I understand that any behavior considered a safe school violation and/or cause damage to school property will not be tolerated and will be my responsibility. Depending on my actions, I may receive a fine of a minimum \$100.00.
5. I understand that any behavior deemed inappropriate, disrespectful or disruptive during the graduation ceremony may result in my removal from the event, disciplinary action and/or possible legal action. Absolutely no flags of any kind will be allowed during the graduation process.
6. I will return all school property, such as textbooks, library books and equipment, pay any outstanding fees or fines, and clear ALL activity restrictions prior to 5/22/26 at 9:00am.
7. I understand that if I fail to meet any of the above requirements or violate any school policies or rules, I may be deemed ineligible to participate in the ceremony and Senior Graduation Party.
8. I acknowledge that if I fail to follow ANY of the above stipulations and fail to comply with what is asked of me, depending on my actions, I may receive a fine of a minimum of \$100.00, as stated above in #4.
9. I understand that my "plus 1" to the Senior Graduation Party can NOT be on activity restriction.
10. I understand that this contract must be returned to the office or Ms. C. Christensen, in order to participate in graduation.
11. I understand and agree to the NSHS dress code policy listed below.

North Sanpete High School Graduation Dress Code Policy:

Purpose:

To maintain a respectful and unified graduation ceremony while honoring students' legal rights regarding military, religious, and cultural attire.

Standard Attire:

Students must wear the school-approved cap and gown unless they receive an approved exception.

Approved Exceptions:

- Military Uniforms:

Students who have completed basic training may wear their full dress uniform in place of cap and gown, in accordance with 10 U.S. Code § 772. Uniforms must meet military regulations and cannot be altered or combined with graduation regalia.

- Religious Attire:

Students may wear religious garments or head coverings with or instead of the cap and gown, in line with Title VII and Utah Code § 53G-4-414.

- Cultural/Tribal Regalia:

Students may wear items of cultural or tribal significance per Utah Code § 53G-4-412.

Request Process:

Students must submit written requests for exceptions 30 days before graduation. Final decisions rest with administration to ensure compliance with legal and ceremonial standards.
