

INJECTION INSTRUCTIONS AT SPINE & NERVE DIAGNOSTIC CENTER (SNDC)

You have been scheduled for a procedure with Spine & Nerve Diagnostic Center. It may be necessary to discontinue any <u>blood thinning medications</u> for the amount of time noted on the next page (which includes aspirin and anti-inflammatory medications). We request that you discuss this with your prescribing physician.

IF YOU ARE TAKING <u>BLOOD THINNERS</u>, did your SNDC provider ask you to <u>stop or continue</u> prior to the procedure? If it was not discussed, please call us.

PLEASE CALL US IF YOU HAVE AN <u>ALLERGY TO IODINE</u>, <u>CONTRAST, OR SHELLFISH</u>.

PLEASE <u>CALL US</u> IF YOU ARE TAKING <u>ANTIBIOTICS</u> FOR AN INFECTION, but do not stop taking the antibiotics!

PLEASE CALL US IF THERE IS ANY CHANCE YOU MAY BE PREGNANT.



SPINAL INJECTION MEDICATION GUIDELINES

IF YOU ARE TAKING BLOOD THINNERS, did your provider ask you to stop or continue prior to the procedure? If it was not discussed, please call us.

Medications that thin blood may increase your risk of bleeding. This can increase the risk of a hematoma (blood clot) at the injection site. For that reason, it is important to stop taking medications with blood thinning properties prior to certain injections. The following are guidelines as to when to stop certain medications, if indicated. If the medication is not on the below list, it is okay to take them. Please read through the list carefully. Your procedure may be cancelled if you have not stopped the medications at the appropriate time intervals.

OBTAIN PERMISSION FROM YOUR PRESCRIBING PHYSICIAN TO TEMPORARILY STOP BLOOD THINNERS.

POST INJECTION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Please resume your regular medications as soon as you get home.
- 2. Do not soak in a tub, pool, or hot tub for 24 hours following the procedure.
- 3. If you have a band-aid at the injection site, please remove it in a few hours.
- 4. If you are diabetic, please monitor your blood sugars carefully. Blood sugars may elevate temporarily due to the steroid. If your blood sugar is significantly increased please notify us or your primary care physician for instructions.

Following your procedure you may experience some of the following symptoms:

- If you received steroids during the procedure you may not experience immediate relief of your symptoms. It takes the steroid 3-7 days to reach full effect. Possible side effects may include facial flushing, insomnia, temporary weight gain, mood changes, and elevated blood sugar in diabetics.
- After the numbing wears off, it is normal to have a slight increase in your usual symptoms for 24-48 hours following your procedure which may be relieved by a mild pain reliever such as Tylenol, take your prescribed medications, and use an ice pack or heat (according to your own preferences).
- Soreness and some bruising at the injection site is expected for a few days and may be relieved with the use of your normal pain medications as prescribed by your physician, and an icepack applied to the injection site.
- Numbness/weakness in the affected extremity (arm or leg). If your extremity is
 weak or numb, do not move around until the strength in your arm or legs returns.
 If you have to walk (home or to the bathroom), have someone assist you. Have
 someone stay with you until you are able to be up and about.

If you received sedation with this procedure:

- Do not drive, operate machinery, consume alcohol or make important decisions until the day following your procedure.
- Refrain from heavy physical activity and activities requiring balance for 24 hours.
- Take clear fluids first. If stomach remains settled, regular food may be started. Avoid spicy or fatty food for 24 hours.

If you develop any of the following symptoms seek immediate medical attention or call your Spine & Nerve Diagnostic Center provider. Please contact our on duty physician after 4pm and weekends at 916-732-2600:

- Temperature over 101 degrees or any signs of a rash at the injection site (red, swollen, hot to the touch).
- Severe pain different from your usual pain that is not relieved by the medication.
- Loss of feeling or movement in the affected extremity (after initial numbness wears off).
- Severe bleeding, persistent vomiting or headache lasting longer than 3 days.

IN CASE OF EMERGENCY CALL 911

Please keep your follow up appointment with Spine & Nerve Diagnostic Center, or schedule an appointment if you do not already have one. Allow 2 weeks for the report to reach your physician. Please feel free to call us if you have any questions or concerns.



CANCELLATION AND NO SHOW POLICY

Office appointments require a minimum of 1 business day cancellation and procedure appointments require 2 business day cancellation notice. Without proper notification you will be subject to a no-show fee. Patients who no-show three (3) or more times in a year, may be dismissed from the practice and will be denied any future appointments.

Office Appointments – Minimum 1 business day cancellation Procedures (injections and nerve studies) – Minimum 2 business days cancellation

We understand that special unavoidable circumstances may cause you to cancel within 24 hours. Fees in this instance may be waived but only with management approval. Our practice firmly believes that good provider/patient relationship is based upon understanding and good communication.
