Global Monetary Inc. (“Company,” “we,” “us,” or “our”) is a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Delaware, United States of America, with its principal registered office located in Dover, Delaware. We own and operate the website www.globalmonetaryinc.com (the “Website”) as well as the associated StableForge AI autonomous treasury agent platform, including all related services, tools, features, dashboards, mobile-responsive interfaces, and AI-driven functionalities (collectively referred to as the “Service” or “StableForge”).

This Accessibility Statement explains our commitment to ensuring that the Service is accessible to the widest possible audience, including individuals with disabilities such as visual, auditory, motor, and cognitive impairments. We believe that digital accessibility is not only a legal requirement but a fundamental part of providing an inclusive, equitable, and user-friendly experience for all our users worldwide. - Screen Reader Compatibility: Proper semantic HTML structure, ARIA labels, live regions for dynamic content (such as real-time spread updates and trade execution confirmations), and compatibility with popular screen readers like JAWS, NVDA, VoiceOver, and TalkBack.
- Color and Contrast: High contrast ratios (at least 4.5:1 for normal text and 3:1 for large text) throughout the interface, with a dark-mode option that maintains accessibility standards.
- Text Alternatives: Alternative text for all images, icons, and charts; descriptive labels for data visualizations and performance graphs.
- Resizable Text: Support for text enlargement without loss of content or functionality.
- Clear Language and Structure: Simple, consistent navigation, predictable page layouts, and readable fonts with adjustable spacing.
- Error Identification and Recovery: Clear error messages, form validation that identifies issues inline, and guidance for correcting mistakes during account setup or API configuration.
- Mobile and Touch Accessibility: Fully responsive design that works seamlessly with mobile screen readers, voice commands, and assistive technologies on iOS and Android devices.

These features ensure that users can fully interact with StableForge — from viewing live arbitrage opportunities to receiving Telegram-style alerts — regardless of their abilities.

4. Known Limitations and Ongoing Improvements
