3. Discuss and take action on the budget for fiscal year January 1, 2027 to December 31, 2027.
4. Discuss and take action to perform a record vote on the adoption of the District's 2027 proposed 2026 ad valorem tax rate of \$0.10 per \$100 valuation.
5. Adopt an Order Levying Taxes.
6. Authorize the appropriate District offices and officials to take all necessary action to implement and file the Order with the County Tax Assessor/Collector.
7. Acknowledge and approve posting of statement regarding adopted tax rate to District's website.
8. Adjournment.

The Board may recess the open session and reconvene in executive session at any anytime between the meeting's opening and adjournment, regarding any subject on this agenda pursuant to provisions of the Texas Government Code, including consultation with legal counsel (Chapter 551.071); discussion of personnel matters (Chapter 551.074); deliberation regarding real property (Chapter 551.072); deliberation regarding gifts and donations (Chapter 551.073); deliberation regarding economic development (Chapter 551.087); and, deliberation regarding the deployment, or specific occasions for implementation of security personnel or devices (Chapter 551.076). Final action, if any, will be taken in open session.

This agenda has been reviewed and approved by the district's legal counsel as compliant with the Texas Open Meetings Act. This paragraph is included on the agenda and constitutes a written opinion by the attorney that the subjects listed on this agenda may be legally discussed in the closed portion of the meeting considering available opinions of a court of record and opinions of the Texas Attorney General known to the attorney. The members of the boards, commissions and/or committees may be permitted to participate in discussions on the same items listed on the agenda, if recognized to do so by the presiding officer, but no action will be taken by those in attendance unless such item and action is specifically provided for on an agenda for that body, board, commission or committee subject to the Texas Open Meetings Act.
