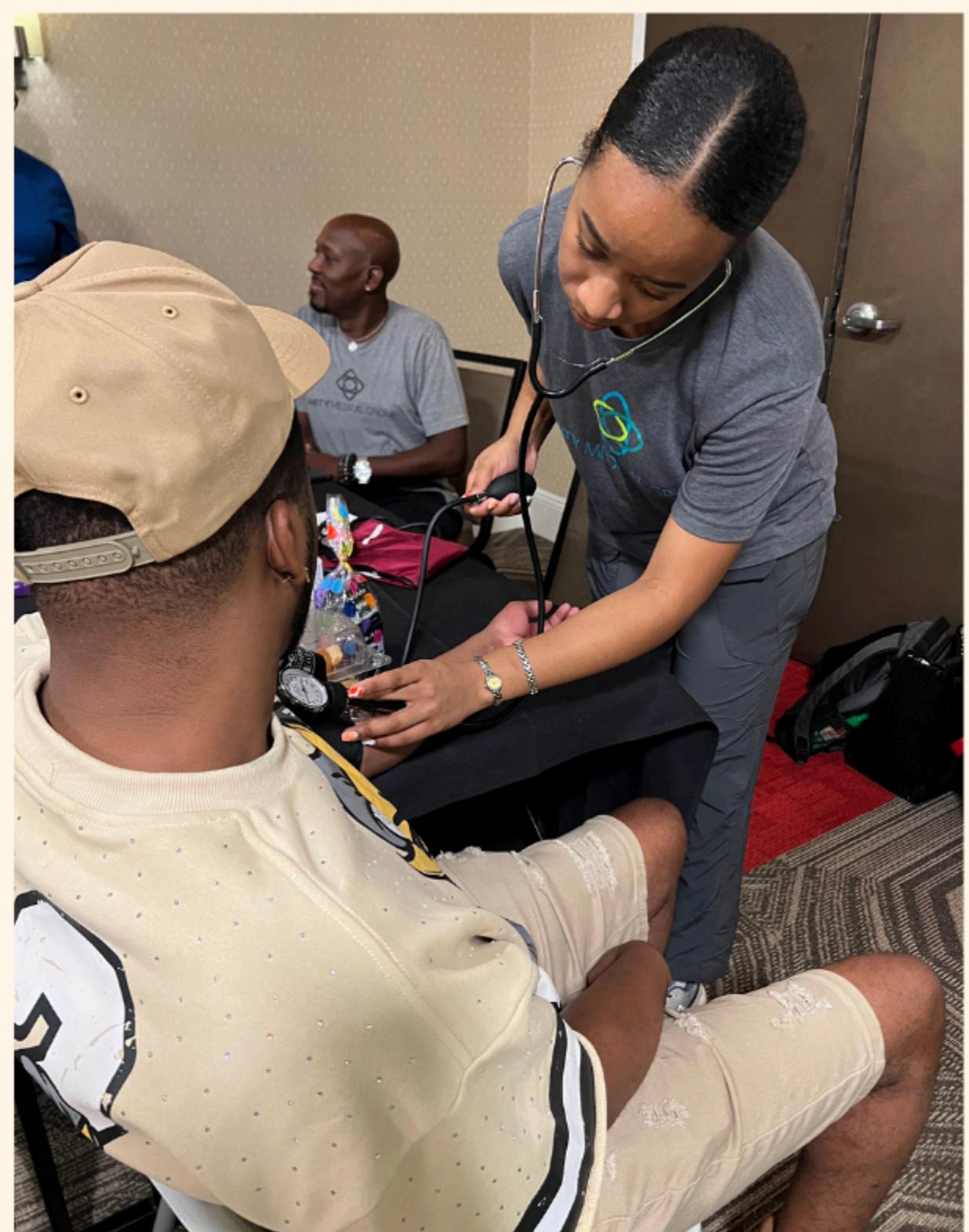


## 2025 REVIEW

This past year, with the support of our wonderful partners, we were able to participate in 29 community events and host 5 public health screenings. We celebrated our 10 year anniversary and held a back to school event, providing free health screenings and vaccinations to over 60 patients through a collaborative effort with our partners and the health department.



In 2025, we saw 11,400 patients across our clinics. Through our United Way grant, 264 new patients have received full coverage for appointments, labs, vaccinations, and up to \$500 per month for prescriptions through Avant Pharmacy and Wellness Center. With support from our partners, we reached around 880 through outreach events, serving patients of diverse backgrounds.
