19th Sunday in Ordinary Time

We are all too familiar with the two groups in which disciples will be separated on judgment day: the sheep on the right and the goats on the left, the blessed and the accursed, the faithful and the unfaithful. But what is this extra teaching that Jesus gives here on those who will receive “a light beating?” Luke 12:48

Passages like this lead one to the conclusion that beside heaven and hell there is an in-between state of remedial punishment. Catholic teaching calls it purgatory, a state of temporary, remedial punishment for believers who die in venial sin. They cannot be admitted to heaven directly because they have guilt and yet they cannot be consigned to everlasting punishment in hell because their sin is not mortal (1 John 5:16-17).

Many Protestant Christians have a problem with the doctrine of purgatory. One reason for this is that the Reformation Bible does not include some of the books in the Catholic Bible, such as 2 Maccabaeus, which clearly support this doctrine. But the doctrine of purgatory makes sense, especially in the light of biblical passages, such as today's gospel, that provide a third alternative to outright blessing and outright condemnation. The doctrine of purgatory satisfies God's mercy as well as God's justice. It is good news to the struggling brother and sister who never quite seems to make it to the Christian ideals we all aim at. It is a great source of hope for us to know that even if we die in the imperfect, struggling state we may receive “a light beating” but we will still be admitted to the eternal happiness of heaven by and by.
