Message of the Week



Today's readings carry a powerful message: **God's love is for everyone.** He does not exclude anyone who comes to Him with faith and a sincere heart.

In the first reading, the prophet Isaiah announces that God's house will be **"a house of prayer for all peoples."** At a time when many believed that God's blessings belonged only to Israel, Isaiah looked forward to the day when people from every nation would be welcomed into God's family.

The Gospel beautifully illustrates this promise. A Canaanite woman, a foreigner, approaches Jesus, begging Him to heal her daughter. At first, Jesus seems to ignore her and even tests her faith. But she refuses to give up. With remarkable humility and confidence, she replies, "Even the dogs eat the scraps that fall from their masters' table." Jesus is deeply moved by her faith and says, "Woman, great is your faith! Let it be done for you as you wish." Her daughter is healed instantly.

This woman teaches us two important lessons. First, **never give up in prayer.** There may be moments when God seems silent, but silence is not absence. God sometimes strengthens our faith through perseverance. Second, **true faith is marked by humility.** She did not demand a miracle as a right; she trusted completely in the mercy of Jesus.

St. Paul, in the second reading, reminds us that God's gifts and His call are irrevocable. God's mercy reaches beyond every boundary of race, culture, and background. We are all invited to share in His saving love.

As we gather around the Eucharistic table today, we are reminded that there is room for everyone in God's family. The same Lord who welcomed the Canaanite woman welcomes each one of us with our weaknesses, struggles, and hopes.

May we imitate her persistent faith. Let us never lose hope when our prayers seem unanswered. And may we also become people who welcome others without prejudice, reflecting the inclusive love of Christ.

May our faith be humble, persistent, and open to all, just as God's heart is open to all. Amen.

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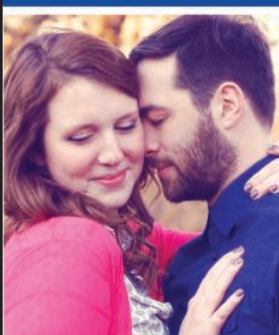
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
