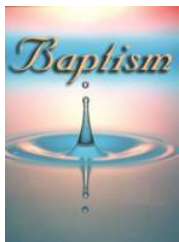

The Pastor's Corner

Dear Parishioners,

Brothers and sisters, today we gather with hearts united by a shared longing for true happiness and a faith that sustains us. But even more beautifully, it is the Lord Himself who draws us together, watching over us with a gaze full of love. A gaze that does not see our mistakes or our weaknesses as the world does, but invites us to trust Him, to follow Him, and to walk courageously on the path He sets before us. In His presence, we are reminded that no struggle is too great, and no heart is too small to be held in His mercy.

This Sunday's readings call us to **humility**, not as a matter of simple courtesy or good manners, but as the very path that leads to God. Saint Paul reminds us that Jesus "humbled Himself... even to death on a cross. That is why God highly exalted Him." Christ shows us that the way to the Father is through humble service and surrender.

To help us understand humility, we can look to what we observe in nature. Rivers flow toward the sea because the sea lies lower than the rivers. It is precisely the sea's ability to be low that allows it to receive all that water. In a similar way, our relationship with God depends on our humility. God is like this river, ready to fill us with His love, but this can only happen if we remain at the right level. If we cling to pride and feelings of superiority, nothing can flow.

The Book of Sirach teaches that humility makes us more effective and more loved, while pride can corrupt even the best intentions. In the Letter to the Hebrews, we are reminded that when Christ came, He did so without thunder or fire, but in quiet humility, bringing us into a new relationship with God.

Jesus gave us the perfect example of humility. He is God made man. He was born in the humblest conditions, lived among the fishermen of Galilee, welcomed tax collectors, notorious sinners, and lepers. In every circumstance, He was a model of humility. He only allowed His disciples to call Him "Master and Lord" after washing their feet, a task usually reserved for a servant. As disciples of Christ, we are invited to follow the same path each day as our Master, to be humble which is a way for us to follow him.

In the Gospel, Jesus observes guests seeking the best seats at a banquet. He uses the occasion to teach: *"Go and take the lowest place, and you will be invited to move higher."* The Kingdom of God belongs to those who let go of ambition and superiority, and who welcome the poor, the excluded, and those who cannot repay us.

This is the same song of praise Mary proclaimed in her Magnificat: *"He lifts up the lowly; He casts down the proud."* True greatness is found in humble and selfless love—love that seeks no reward but will be richly repaid in the resurrection.

Let us turn to God who came not to be served, but to serve to ask him to show us the joy of giving our lives for those we love, so that we may all share in the happiness of Your Kingdom.

Let us pray this week for hearts that are simple, humble, and open to God, and to one another.
