





December is **Seasonal Affective Disorder** (SAD) Awareness Month to raise awareness about SAD, a type of depression linked to biochemical imbalance in the brain due to changes in seasons, especially the reduced sunlight and colder weather of fall and winter. Seniors are particularly vulnerable to symptoms of SAD.

SAD symptoms include:

- Tiredness Lack of interest in normal activities/hobbies
- Withdraw inward
- Cravings for high-carb foods or increased appetite/weight gain
- Irritability

Ways to reduce SAD symptoms:

- Exercise; even short walks can help (check with your physician first)
- Have your Vitamin D levels checked. Levels too low can impact the amount of serotonin and dopamine that lead to feelings of depression.
- Regular sleep schedule
- Medication
- Other forms of therapy

The Pastor's Corner

Today's feast is called the Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph. It is, to my knowledge, the only place where the Church speaks of the family in this order: the child, the mother, and the father. In general, we always follow the reverse order: father, mother, and child. The notion of "family" as a nuclear unit is a modern concept. The Holy Family, of course, is far from a "typical" family. Therefore, we need to consider the principles of the Holy Family as models for every Christian family. It is essential for families to be present and available to each other. A happy household feels included and able to share strengths for the welfare and benefit of all. Family encompasses

interaction, relationships, safety, and trust. When a family develops Christian characteristics, each member plays an active role where prayerful dialogue and spiritual activities take place. Families become holy when Christ Jesus is present and invited into their everyday lives. We know the saying, "a family who prays together stays together." Similarly, Jesus becomes truly present when all members live in the Christian spirit of sacrifice, marked by mutual understanding, support, and respect in all conversations and actions.

My brothers and sisters, the Church allows us to celebrate Jesus, Mary, and Joseph as models for our families. Through this sacred feast, the Church encourages us to view the Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph as a vital source of inspiration. Each family, like the family of Jesus, is called to holiness. Jesus Christ instituted two sacraments that are pivotal to this call: the sacrament of priesthood and the sacrament of marriage. Through the sacrament of priesthood, Jesus sanctifies the priest and his parish. Similarly, by the sacrament of marriage, Jesus sanctifies not only the spouses but also the entire family. On the Feast of the only perfect family to have ever existed, all parents are invited to examine how well they are fulfilling the responsibility God has placed upon them. As they heard during their marriage ceremony: "children are a gift from God to you." Children bring joy to their parents and provide comfort in their old age, but above all, they are a gift for which parents are accountable before God, as they must ultimately return His children to Him.

Let us pray for the grace to care for one another in our families, for each member of the parish family, and for all families of the universal Church. May God bless all your families in the New Year.


