






Sexual abuse is a crime that must be reported, investigated and responded to so that victims are protected and those who commit abuse are removed from ministry.

THE DIOCESE OF CAMDEN



Recently, while scrolling on my phone, I came across a clip of Sebastian Maniscalco, a comedian whose humor, rooted in our shared Italian heritage, often brings back vivid memories of my own upbringing. He has a knack for recounting personal anecdotes, particularly about his childhood. In one particular clip, Maniscalco humorously compared and contrasted the

concept of having "company" over, especially unannounced. For those unfamiliar, "company" refers to someone dropping by for a visit. I can still hear my mom or grandmother saying, "Frankie, go to the Lou's (corner grocery) and get an Entenmann's, we have company coming over." Maniscalco described how, in "the old days," we generally looked forward to these visits. They were occasions to gather with extended family or neighbors, always accompanied by plenty of food and drink – a true display of hospitality.

These thoughts and childhood memories were beautifully reinforced when I reviewed the readings for the Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time, Cycle C. The reading from Genesis presents Abraham as a remarkable example of hospitality. He welcomed three strangers into his home, unaware they were angels. This story profoundly teaches us to be welcoming to others, even those we don't know. In the Old Testament, hospitality meant welcoming strangers and showing kindness to those in need. More than just a nice gesture, hospitality is a spiritual practice. By opening our homes and hearts to others, we demonstrate our faith and openness to God. It's not solely about grand gestures, but also about countless small moments of kindness and generosity.

Our Gospel reading finds Jesus visiting the home of his friends, Martha, Mary, and their brother, Lazarus. Here, they have "company," and Martha takes on the role of providing the proverbial "Entenmanns"—offering food, drink, and hospitality to their guests. However, Martha, ever the busy and worried one, becomes stressed by her tasks. This leads to her frustration with Mary for not helping. Jesus gently reminds Martha that her service should not distract her from what is truly important. Mary's choice to sit and listen to Jesus highlights the profound value of being present with Christ. Martha's story teaches us that our service must always be rooted in spirituality. Without this spiritual foundation, service can become overwhelming and lose its true purpose. Jesus' words encourage Martha—and us—to reflect on our priorities. This story compels us to be aware of Christ's presence in our daily lives. It teaches that being a true follower isn't just about doing tasks; it's equally about listening and being with Christ. The dynamic between Martha and Mary illustrates the value of spiritual nourishment and the essential balance between serving others and taking time for reflection.

I pray we can draw from both Martha's earnest desire to serve and Mary's essential need to be close to Jesus.
