



The Pastor's Corner An old story from the Eastern tradition tells of some who knew only one prayer: the Our Father. From time to time, a learned theologian would visit to teach them how to pray more "properly." One day, as he approached their island by boat, he saw two of these monks walking across the water toward him. They said, "Father, could you remind us of the words: 'Our Father, who art in heaven'? We do not know how to pray."

This story reminds us that the Our Father is both the simplest prayer and the deepest expression of the Christian life. At first, it may seem simple,

even abstract, but within it lies everything that touches the human heart: our hunger, our need for mercy, our longing for God, and even our fears.

Most of us first learn to pray by repeating words handed down to us: Our Fathers, Hail Marys, Glorias. We pray the rosary. We turn to prayers found in books, poems, or songs because they express what we feel more beautifully than we can ourselves. Often, we do not know how to speak to God.

Jesus' disciples felt the same. Seeing Him pray, they asked, "Lord, teach us to pray" (Luke 11:1). In response, Jesus gave them the Our Father. Luke's version, which we hear in today's Gospel, is shorter than Matthew's, yet its five petitions bring us to the heart of what Jesus wanted us to ask: that God's name be hallowed, His kingdom come, our daily needs met, our sins forgiven, and our hearts softened to forgive others.

The first lines of the prayer turn our attention away from ourselves and help us to focus God: "Father, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come."

Yet, in our own prayers, we often begin with our needs—our health, our struggles, our family, our fears, our hopes. This is natural. Before God, we come as we are: fragile, burdened, and in need. Jesus' prayer reminds us that there is no shame in coming to him just as we are to worship and to praise. Prayer is the place where we bring our whole selves before God and trust Him with our needs.

Matthew's version adds: "Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven." At the heart of the prayer is the desire for God's name to be known, for His kingdom and His presence to fill the world. Even in a culture that chases after idols—celebrities, wealth, and distractions—our deepest longing remains for God alone. Prayer calls us back to that truth.

When we persevere in prayer, we find it changes us. Prayer re-centers us, draws us out of our anxieties, and heals our hearts. We speak to a God who is at once near and present to us in faith, yet veiled in mystery.

Finally, Jesus teaches us to bring to God two basic needs: our daily sustenance and His mercy. "Give us each day our daily bread, and forgive us our sins, for we ourselves forgive everyone in debt to us." But forgiveness does not come easily. Our world is quick to excuse itself and blame others. Jesus calls us to something greater: to receive mercy and to offer it, even when it costs us.

My brothers and sisters, the Our Father is not simply a text to memorize; it is a way of life. It teaches us humility, trust, and mercy. It invites us to approach God as children before a loving Father, and to let His kingdom, not our worries, define our lives.

May God bless you and I hope your summer is going well.
