

My friends in Christ,

A while back, a parishioner whom I have known for a long time, asked, "Hey were you extra hungry today? I saw you looking around the altar for more Communion." I have had the question asked other ways. You may have seen me "surveying" the corporal (the white cloth that the Eucharist is kept upon) for fragments of the Blessed

Sacrament and upon finding any, picking up consuming them. This might seem curious to visitors of other denominations or religious beliefs.

Back in 2023, I was working as a Chaplain, bringing Holy Communion to the sick and hospitalized. Many days I would come to our tabernacle and take upwards of 40 pieces of the Blessed Sacrament. One day in November of that year, while attempting to give communion to a patient who was in isolation for a serious bacterial infection, the pix (the small container that Eucharistic Minister uses to carry Holy Communion) containing about 15 hosts, slipped from my gloved hand and fell to the floor. The pix broke open and all of the Eucharist fell on the floor under the patient's bed. I have often times picked up a host that has fallen on the floor at church and at other locations. Due to the nature of this hospital room, I knew the hosts could not be distributed to other patients or consumed by me, nor could they be returned to the Parish. Knowing the protocol for properly and reverently disposing of the Blessed Sacrament I drove quickly home. I, literally wept as I carefully dissolved all of the hosts and buried them as indicated by the Church rubrics (rules). I have been a Catholic my whole life, receiving all 7 Sacraments, but I don't believe I ever felt such a deep, agonizing ache, as I did destroying His sacred Body.

I have always known and had the belief what the Catechism of the Catholic Church states:

1324 The Eucharist is "the source and summit of the Christian life." The other sacraments, and indeed all ecclesiastical ministries and works..., are bound up with the Eucharist and are oriented toward it. For in the blessed Eucharist is contained the whole spiritual good of the Church, namely Christ himself..."

After the event I described, I had a new appreciation of His sacrifice, His gift to us in giving us His body. With that in mind, I offer a quick review of the proper way to receive His Body for this week's The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ:

In the United States,...the Bishops determined that:

- "[t]he norm... is that Holy Communion is to be received standing,...and that a bow is the act of reverence made by those receiving...
- Those who receive Communion may receive either in the hand or on the tongue (and) if Communion is received in the hand, the hands should first of all be clean. If one is right handed the left hand should rest upon the right. The host will then be laid in the palm of the left hand and then taken by the right hand to the mouth. If one is left-handed this is reversed.
- It is not appropriate to reach out with the fingers and take the host from the person distributing.
- The person distributing Communion says audibly to each person approaching, <u>"The Body of Christ."</u> This formula should not be altered, as it is a proclamation which calls for a response of faith on the part of the one who receives. The communicant should audibly respond, <u>"Amen,"</u> indicating by that response his or her belief that this small wafer of bread, (the wine in this chalice) are in reality the body and blood of Christ the Lord.

May the Lord who not only loved us enough to die for us, but gave us the gift of His body and blood so we always had Him with us, continue to bless us with His peace, love and charity.


